## Leafs, Mayes sprint past Princeton and Sherrard

Senior Ben Mayes captured both sprint events and ran the anchor leg on the winning 400 meter relay race to lead the Geneseo varsity boys track team to wins over Princeton and Sherrard Tuesday, April 3 in Geneseo.

Team scores were Geneseo--97, Sherrard--61 and Princeton--29.

Mayes was clocked in a blistering 11.09 seconds in the 100 meter dash, despite less than favorable weather conditions.

"It was only about 45 degrees and usually the top performances don't come in that type of weather. Ben just had an outstanding race," said Coach Don Fredericks.

Mayes also captured the 200 meter race in 23.33 seconds and teamed with Shawn Wehrspann, Kevin Fuhr and Chad Blunt to win the 400 meter relay in 45.88 seconds.

Blunt and Adam Boardman were other multiple winners for the Leafs.

Blunt captured the 110 high hurdles race with a time of 15.78 seconds. Boardman took first in a close 800 race in a time of 2:03.18 and also placed first in the 1600 with a time of 4:41.48.

Also nabbing first place finishes for the Leafs were Jason VanVooren in the 3200 (10:25.76), Mike VanDeVelde in the 400 (51.92), Shane McKibbin in

the 300 intermediate hurdles (42.73 seconds) and Glenn Klopp in the pole vault (12').

Earning second place finishes were Justin VanOpdorp in the 1600 and 3200, VanDeVelde in the long jump, McKibbin in the 110 high hurdles, Justin VanVooren in the 800, Klopp in the triple jump and high jump and Blunt in the 300 intermediate hurdles.

Placing third were Jon McAvoy in the discus, Ryan Kleinau in the 400, Mark Chaney in the pole vault and Fuhr in the 200.

The Geneseo sophomores picked up easy wins in the meet as they amassed 121-1/2 points to 48-1/2 for Princeton and 15 for Sherrard. The Leaflets won 15 of the 18 events contested.

Freshman sprinter Ben Hahn led the Geneseo effort as he contributed to four wins. He won the 100 (11.92), the 200 (24.59), the 400 (53.91) and teamed with Jeremy Mier, Matt Jacocks and Tom Britton to win the 400 meter relay (48.47).

Mier also had two other wins for the Leaflets as he won the 110 high hurdles in 18.54 seconds and teamed with Jeremy Holke, Jason Gibson and Andy Porter to win the 1600 relay in 3:52.61.

Josh Pierce placed first in both long distance races as he won the 1600 (4:58.55) and 3200 (10:43.55). Derek Wright won both the triple jump (38'

1/2") and the 300 intermediate hurdles (47.65).

Also capturing events for the Leaflets were Nate Culbertson in the discus (119' 1/4"), Tom Britton in the long jump (17'7"), Adam Stokes in the pole vault (10') and the 3200 relay team of Mitch Pray, Gibson, Scott Durian and Matt Lotz (9:40.47).

Finishing second were Snook in the 800 and 1600, Culbertson in the shot, Holke in the 400, Nick Sable in the long jump, Mier in the 300 intermediate hurdles, Chris Thompson in the pole vault and Pierce in the high jump.

Third place finishers were Jacocks in the 100, Garrin Woelke in the discus, Jim VanAcker in the shot, Gibson in the 400, Wright in the long jump, Landon Neumann in the 200 and Porter in the high jump.

The Leafs will compete in their first major outdoor meet of the year on Saturday, April 7 as the East Moline Kiwanis Relays will be held at the Soule Bowl. Defending state champion Rock Island and perennial power Rockford East are two of the teams slated to compete.

"This meet will give us a taste of what it will be like when the sectional meet comes around next month. Sometimes an athlete's performance really shoots up in a meet like this and that's what I'll be looking for Saturday," noted Coach Fredericks.

## VanDeVelde, Klopp capture firsts in Invite

GENESEO - Geneseo's varsity boys track team moved to 8-0 on the season after downing Sherrard and Princeton in a triangular meet on Tuesday, April 3.

Geneseo paced with a 97-point performance while Sherrard took second with 61 points and Princeton third with 20.

Ren Mayes and Adam Boardman each recorded a pair of individual wins. Mayes won the 100 (11.09) and

200 (23.33) while Boardman was victorious in both the 800 (2:03.2) and 1600 (4:41.5).

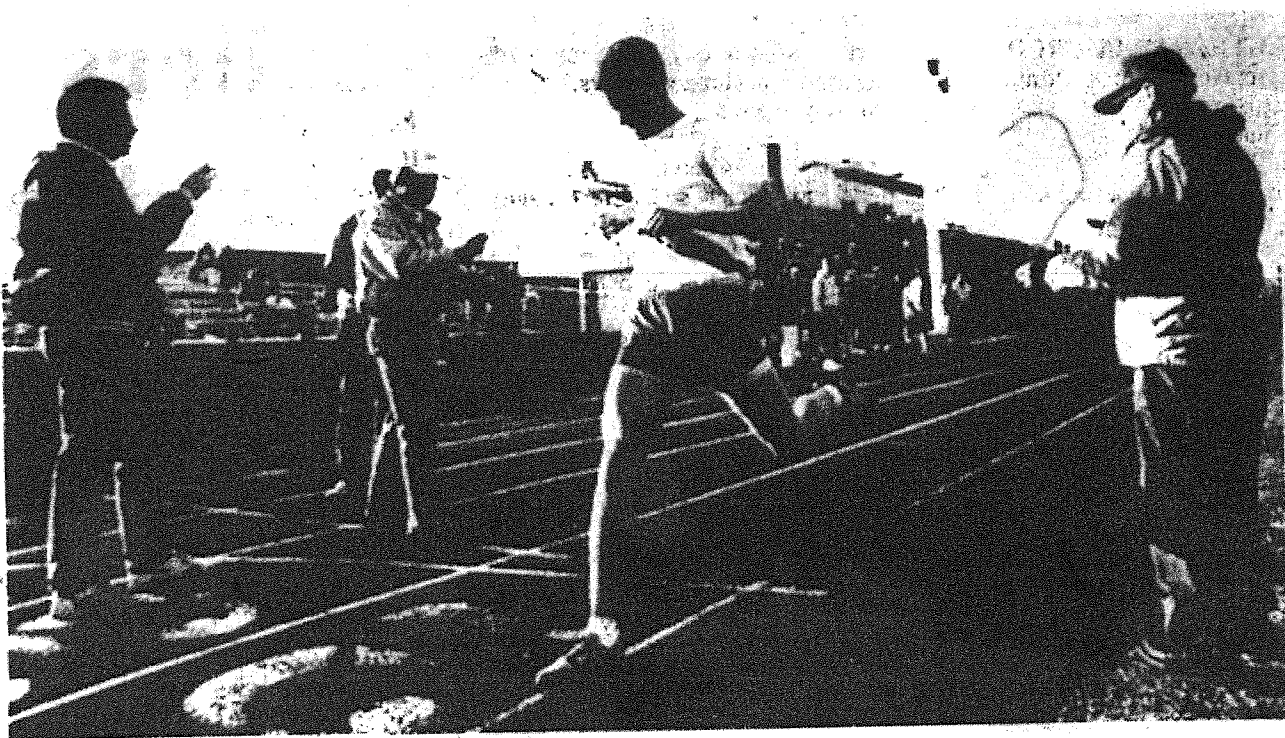
Other Geneseo first placefinishes included Jason VanVooren in the 3200 run, Blunt in the 110 high hurdles, Mike VanDeVelde in the 400, Shane McKibbin in the 300 low hurdles and Glenn Klopp in the pole vault.

On Saturday, April 7, Geneseo took fifth place in the East Moline Kiwanis Invitational. Rock Island and Moline

tied for first place in the 12-team invite with 91 points each. Rockford East took third with 50 points followed by United Township with 47 and Geneseo with 39.

Junior Mike VanDeVelde and senior Glenn Klopp captured first place in their respective events. VanDeVelde took first in the open 400 with a winning time of 51.0. Klopp cleared 13'0" in the pole vault for first.
