Leafs finish second in prestigious Rocky meet

Geneseo's varsity boys track team sent a strong message that it is a team to be reckoned with, finishing second in the Rock Island Invitational track meet held Friday, April 20 in Rock Island. It was the first year the Leafs have taken part in the event loaded with top teams from the northern third of Illinois.

"Going into the meet I was hoping for the top ten or maybe the top five. I never expected a second place finish. It was probably the best team performance I've ever been associated with and that includes the sectional titles that my teams won while I was at Crystal Lake South," said an ecstatic Coach Don Fredericks.

Defending state champion Rock Island won the meet with a total of 228 points. The Rocks were followed by Geneseo (154-1/2), Moline (153-1/2), Peoria Richwoods (147-1/2), Rockford East (138), UT (108-1/2), Lockport (108), Rockford Guilford (102-1/2), Galesburg (97-1/2), Rockford Auburn (79), Aurora East (69), Metamora (41), Alleman (7), Rockridge (6) and Aledo (4).

This meet is scored a bit differently than other meets to give an indication of the depth a team has.

Each team has one entrant in the relay events and three entrants in each of the individual events. The top performer from each team in single events are in the "A" events. The second best are in the "B", events while the third best are in the "C" events.

This keeps a certain team's third best performer in any event from having to compete against competitors which he would have little chance of scoring against. Points were awarded to the top six finishers in each event, with the relays having the most value and the "C" events having the least.

Adam Boardman and Jason Van-Vooren had the only first place finishes for the Lafs, both of them coming in the 1600 meter races.

Boardman was clocked in a speedy 4:25.1 in the "A" race while VanVooren took the "B" race in 4:35.8. Boardman's time was the state's top ten fastest this season, according to Coach Fredericks.

Nabbing seconds were Adam Stokes in the "C" pole vault and Mike VanDeVelde in the "A" 400.

VanDeVelde's time was not only a personal best but also the third best in school history.

Finishing third were Jon McAvoy in the "A" shot put, Glenn Klopp and Mark Chaney in "A" and "B" pole vault, respectively, Bryan Glass and Andy Snook in "A" and "B" 3200 run,

Ryan Verbeck in the "B" 100, Hahn in the "B" 400, VanDeVelde in the "B" 200 and the 400 meter relay team of Verbeck, VanDeVelde, Chad Blunt and Ben Mayes.

All of the third place finishes contributed a minimum of four points each to the Leaf's total and sprinkled among them were some that stood out. They included McAvoy's 44'9-1/2" effort in the shot, four feet further than his previous best; Glass's 9:49.4 in the 3200, the sixth best time in school history; the 9:52.5 by Snook which is a new freshman record and the number seven time in school history; and 43.69 second effort by the 400 relay team of Verbeck, VanDeVelde, Blunt and Mayes which was the fourth best time in school history.

The Leafs also had several outstanding efforts which earned fourth, fifth and sixth place finishes. Among them were an 11.7 second effort by Ben Hahn in the "B" 100 race, which set a freshman school record; the 15.3 second time turned in by Blunt, his personal best; and the 22.85 200 meter time by Mayes, the number seven time in school history.

"We gear our training toward the big meets in the season and this was a big meet. This team still has not reached its potential yet though and that is exciting," said Coach Fredericks.

The Leafs met the challenge of the Rock Island Invite and came through with flying colors but were quickly faced with another as a fired up Moline team, as well as Streator, visited Geneseo on Tuesday, April 24.

When the dust had settled, the Leafs emerged with 90 points to nip the second place Maroons, who had 85. Streator finished with 10.

"Moline came at us with everything they had but our kids were up to it. They picked up right where they had left off Friday," said Coach Fredericks:

Klopp, Mayes and Blunt were the standouts in this meet as each won two events in spectacular fashion.

Klopp cleared 13'6" in the pole vault, the height that he needs to clear to advance to the state meet. He also won the high jump and clinched the win over Moline with an effort of 5'8"

Mayes captured both short dashes, including a blazing 10.83 second effort in the 100. His time in the 200 was a very quick 23.27 seconds.

Blunt won both hurdles races in outstanding times. He was clocked at 15.15 seconds in the 110 high hurdles and 41.72 in the 300 intermediate hurdles.

Also nabbing firsts in the meet were Glass in the 3200 and the 400 meter

realy team of Verbeck, VanDeVelde, Blunt and Mayes which was clocked at 43.91 seconds.

Second place finishes were turned in by McAvoy in the discus, Darin Lavery in the triple jump, Chaney in the polc vault, Shane McKibbon in the 110 and 300 meter hurdle races, Verbeck in the 100, VanDeVelde in the 200 and 400, Boardman in the 800 and 1600, the 800 relay team of Chad Loucks, Hahn, Shawn Wehrspann and Verbeck, the 1600 relay team of Michael Bell, Lavery, McKibbon and Blunt and the 3200 relay team of Bell, Micah Miller, Justin VanOpdorp and Gary Martin.

Earning thirds were Stokes in the pole vault, Lavery in the long jump and Jason VanVooren in the 800.

The sophomores were in action in the triangular meet and amassed 100.5 points top both Moline (63.5) and Streator (2).

Eight different athletes contributed individual wins for the Leaflets in the meet.

They were Pierce in the high jump (5'6"), Dave Farmer in the 110 meter high hurdles (16.01 seconds), Steve Pardoe in the pole vault (10'6"), Tom Britton in the triple jump (38'5"), Matt Jacocks in the long jump (17'7-1/2"), Jeremy Mier in the 300 intermediate hurdles (45.28 seconds), Nate Culbertson in the shot (42") and Garrin Woelke in the discus (112'9-1/2").

Also winning were the 400 relay team of Jacocks, Farmer, Mier and Britton (47.78 seconds), the 800 relay team of Alan Sand, Chris Thompson, Nick Sable and Dave Roets and the 3200 relay team of Miller, Mitch Pray, Matt Lotz and Chris Walters.

Second place finishes were earned by Mier in the 110 high hurdles, Britton in the 100 and 200, Chad Sager in the pole vault, Andy Porter in the 400, Culbertson in the discus and Pray in the 1600.

Placing third were Porter in the high jump and shot put, Jacocks in the 100, Randy Carton in the pole vault, Sable in the triple jump, Culbertson in the 400 and Farmer in the 300 intermediate burdles

The double wins by both the varsity and frosh-soph teams puts both of them with 12-0 records on the season. Only a Tuesday, May 1 dual meet with the Sterling Golden Warriors stand between the Leafs and Leaflets and an undefeated dual meet season.

"Sterling traditionally has good track teams and this year is no exception. It should be a good meet for the public to come out and see," said Coach Fredericks.

Leafs finish second in their first-ever RI Invite

ROCK ISLAND - Running for the first time in the Rock Island Invitational was quite an experience for Geneseo's varsity boys track team and a successful one at that.

After competing in the Dixon Relays for a number of years, the Leafs made a change and entered in the tougher invitational and came out with an overall second place team finish.

Rock Island was its own meet with a total of 228 points. Geneseo edged out Moline by one point, 154 1/2 to 153 1/2. Other teams competing (in their order of finish) included Peoria Richwoods, Rockford East, UTHS, Lockport, Rockford Guilford, Galesburg, Rockford Auburn, Aurora East, Metamora, Alleman, Rockridge and Aldeo.

Adam Boardman and Jason Van-Vooren topped the finishes for the Maple Leafs in the 1600. Boardman won the Class A race in a time of 4:25.1 while VanVooren captured first in the Class B race in 4:35.0.

Junior Mike VanDeVelde took second in the open 400 with a time of :50.8 just behind the winning time of :50.3.

Glenn Klopp placed third in the pole vault with 12'6" and senior Jon McAvoy took third in the shot put with a distance of 44'9 1/2".




