9 Leafs advance

State finals set for May 25, 26

A season of hard work paid off for nine Geneseo athletes who advanced to the state meet from the Rock Island Sectional track meet held Friday, May 18.

Those who will be competing Friday and Saturday, May 25 and 26 in Charleston are individual qualifiers Bryan Glass, Adam Boardman, Mike VanDeVelde and Ben Mayes and relay qualifiers Ryan Verbeck, Chad Blunt, Jason VanVooren, Justin VanVooren and Josh Pierce. VanDeVelde, Mayes and Boardman will also run relays. It marks the most athletes Geneseo will send to the state meet in since Coach Don Fredericks has led the Leaf program.

Rock Island won its own sectional with 56-1/2 points followed by Moline (45), Galesburg (40-1/2), Geneseo and UT (26 each), Sterling (25), Dixon (13-1/2), Ottawa (12-1/2), Canton (11), Quincy and Macomb (10 each) and LaSalle-Peru and Rock Falls (three each).

"We just had an exceptional meet. Nearly everything went very well for us," noted Coach Fredericks.

Glass and Boardman, both juniors, were the two winners for the Leafs.

Glass and Moline's Cesar Lopez dueled down the stretch in the 3200 meter run and both were clocked at 9:40.6, but Glass was declared the winner.

"Bryan just ran a gutty race. Everybody, not just the Geneseo and Moline fans, were on their feet for this one. It was one of the most exciting races I've ever witnessed," said Coach Fredericks.

Boardman bettered his previous best time by two seconds with a 4:23.7 time in the 1600 meter run, the third best time in school history. Only Rich Werkheiser and Phil Walsh have faster times.

Mayes finished in a three-way tie with George Guy and Johnson for second place in the 100 meter dash to earn a trip to Charleston. All three were clocked at 11.0 seconds, behind only the 10.9 time of Cletis Dortch of Galesburg.

VanDeVelde was the other individual qualifier for the Leafs. His 50.0 time in the 400 meter dash broke his own school record but earned him just fourth place in the race. Only two athletes qualify from each event unless a set time is met. VanDeVelde's time is the qualifying standard.

Two relay teams also advanced. The 400 meter relay team of Verbeck, Blunt, VanDeVelde and Mayes was clocked at blistering 42.8 seconds to set a new Geneseo school record. Galesburg won the event with the same time.

The 3200 meter relay team of Justin

VanVooren, Jason VanVooren, Pierce and Boardman was clocked at 8:06.4 behind only Moline's time of 7:59.6.

Boardman ripped through the anchor leg of the race in 1:56 for the Leafs.

Scoring points for the Leafs were Jon McAvoy, who was fifth in the discus, Blunt and Shane McKibbin, who were fourth and fifth, respectively, in the 110 meter high hurdles, Mayes in the 200 and the 1600 meter relay team.

All of the Leaf qualifiers, except for Glass, will begin competition at state with preliminaries on Friday, May 25 at 9 a.m. There are no preliminaries in Glass's race, the 3200, which will be run Saturday, May 26 at 12:50 p.m.

Leafs qualify 10 thinclads to State Track and Field Finals

ROCK ISLAND - Ten members of the Geneseo High School boys track team will make their way to Charleston this weekend to compete in the Class AA Track and Field finals on the Eastern Illinois University campus.

The Leafs took fourth at the Rock Island Sectional meet Friday, May 18 with 26 team points. Rock Island captured their sixth title in the last seven years, with a total of 56 1/2 points. Moline took second with 45 and Galesburg third with 40 1/2.

The ten thinclads advanced in two relays and four individual events to represent J.D. Darnall High School.

Bryan Glass started out the Leaf rally with a gold medal finish in the 3200 meter run. Glass won the event at the tape with a winning time of 9:40.6, just a hair ahead of Moline's Cesar Lopez.

The 3200 relay squad of Jason VanVooren, Justin VanVooren, Josh Price and Adam Boardman placed second behind Moline with a qualifying time of 8:06.4.

Boardman returned later in the meet to win the 1600 meter run (4:27.3), advancing to the state finals along with second place runner Steve Ponce of Galesburg, who finished nearly six seconds behind Boardman.

Geneseo's 400 relay team of Ryan Verbeck, Mike VanDeVelde, Chad Blunt, and Ben Mayes, took second behind Galesburg with a qualifying time of 42.8.

VanDeVelde, a junior, will also represent the Maple Leafs in the open 400 meter dash. VanDeVelde crossed the finish line in fourth, put his time of 50.0 broke the needed qualifying time. Greg Heaton of Dixon took first in the event (49.5) followed by Alberto Furman of Moline (49.5), Gale VanRossem of Canton (49.5) and VanDeVelde.

Mayes was also an individual qualifier after finishing the 100 meter dash in a three-way tie for second place (11.0) with George Guy and Demetrius Johnson, both of Rock Island. Cletis Dortch of Galesburg won the sprint event with 10.9.

Mayes took fifth in the 200 with 22.5 but did not advance to the state meet.

Other Geneseo placers who did not advance include senior Jon McAvoy in the discus (fifth, 140'7"), Chad Blunt in the 110 high hurdles (fourth, 14.9), Shane McKibbin in the 110 high hurdles (fifth, 15.2) and Geneseo's 1600 relay team (fifth, 3:33.3).

Coolidge hits prediction;

RI wins

Rock Island track coach John Coolidge might want to invest in a crystal ball and tea leaves soon. It appears he has a future in the prediction business.

Prior to his defending state champion Rocks winning their second straight Class AA sectional track title Friday at Rock Island Public Schools Stadium, Coolidge pondered what it would take for his crew to out-point a very tough field.

Coolidge predicted 56 points would take his team to a title, and We'll how about 56½.

The Rocks captured the crown with the winning 56-plus effort, holding off a tough Moline unit that finished second with 45. Galesburg grabbed third with 40½, while Geneseo and United Township gave solid efforts in finishing fourth and fifth respectively.

"You can go into my office and look at how I had it figured," Coolidge said of his prediction addition. "I had it figured we would need 56 points to hold off the rest of the field and we got 56½."

The Rocks, who grabbed their sixth title in the past seven years, did so without star sprinter Tim Newsone, ruled ineligible to run because of IHSA age limitations.

"We've fought through some adversity and the kids have stepped up and met a challenge," said Coolidge. "I was happy for them accepting the challenge. It was a great effort as a team."

The Rocks crowned sectional champions in the 110 high hurdles (Jarrin Williams, 14.4) and 800-meter relay (George Guy, Demetrius Johnson, Billy Mann and Tim Smith). R.J. Nunn blazed the Rock Island oval in 38.8 to take the 300 intermediate hurdles while setting a new sectional mark. Guy then sprinted to the 200 dash title in a 22.0 clocking.

Moline sectional title winners were led by strongman Joe Kerr, who tossed the shot 50-feet, ½-inch. The Maroons also grabbed the 3200 relay title with Carlos Rivera, Mike DeSmet, Bryan Spriet and Tauwon Taylor getting it done in 7:59.6. Taylor continued his super evening by

grabbing the 800 meter run in 1:57.4, while the Maroons' 1600 meter relay team of Albert Furman, Shawn Clay, Mike Shannon and Taylor, cruised to an impressive 3:22.8 win.

"We won what we thought we would win," said Moline coach Jeff Quick. "We got a solid effort from Joe Kerr in the shot, but we needed a little more in the field events. Overall, it was a solid job."

A fine Geneseo effort started with a win in the 3200 run by Bryan Glass. The gutsy Glass edged Moline's Cesar Lopez at the tape for the victory in 9:40.6.

The Leafs' Adam Boardman threw on a championship style run with a 4:23.7 number in the 1600 meter run. Boardman's nearest competitor was some six seconds behind at the tape.

UT junior standout Chris Roberson put on quite a show in capturing the triple jump in 44-1 fashion, then for good championship measure, Roberson took off with the high jump title at 6-9.

"Chris did an excellent job for us," said UT coach Jim Wessellman. "He hit 6-9 in the high jump, but

gave an excellent effort all they way up to 6-10½. I was impressed because we have a young squad and never once backed down."

Rock Island also qualified its 400 meter relay team (Johnson, Guy, Tony Pulliam, Tim Smith), and its 1600 unit of Nunn, Terrance Parks, Pulliam and Williams. Nunn also makes the state trip in the 110 hurdles, while Paul Grissom (triple jump), Guy and Johnson in the 200 and 400 and Williams in the 300 hurdles all advance.

Moline will also send Taylor in the long jump, Furman in the 400, Dave Krauel in the 800 and Lopez in the 3200.

Geneseo sends its 3200 relay unit of Jason VanVooren, Josh Price, Justin VanVooren and Boardman to state, while the Leafs' 400 meter relay squad of Ryan Verbeck, Mike VanDeVelde, Chad Blunt and Ben Mayes make a state trip. Mayes also heads to state in the 100 and 200.

UT's Ken Wyatt made a date at state by qualifying in the 110 and 300 hurdles for next weekend's state finals in Charleston.




