

Rounding into form

Leaf tracksters trip Galesburg and Alleman

Seniors Shane McKibbon and Adam Boardman and sophomore Ben Hahn each won two events as the Geneseo varsity boys track team scored wins over Galesburg and Alleman Thursday, April 11 in Geneseo.

The Leafs amassed 89-1/2 points, the Silver Streaks had 64 and the Pioneers totalled 25-1/2 on the blustery, cold day.

McKibbon captured first place in both of the hurdles races. He was clocked at 15.73 seconds in the 110 meter high hurdles and 41.09 seconds in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles.

Boardman captured first in the 800 and 1600 meter events. His winning times were 2:01.9 and 4:30.5, respectively.

Hahn earned the top spot in the two short sprints. He was clocked at 11.62 seconds in the 100 and 23.81 seconds in the 200.

Andy Snook was the other individual winner for the Leafs, winning the 3200 meter run with a time of 10:19.7.

Also capturing first place was the

3200 meter relay team of Mitch Pray, Josh Pierce, Steve Miller and Bryan Glass, clocking 8:48.7.

Second place finishes were turned in by Andy Porter in the shot put, Shawn Wehrspann in the high jump, Tom Britton in the triple jump, Chris Widowski in the 100 and 200, Pierce in the 800, Hahn in the 400, David Farmer in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles, Snook in the 1600, the 800 relay team of Nick Sable, Wehrspann, Matt Jacocks and Widowski and the 1600 relay team of Sable, Darin Lavery, McKibbon and Farmer.

Earning thirds were Wade Murphy in the shot put, Jeremy Holke in the high jump, Mark Chaney in the pole vault, Lavery in the triple jump, Gary Martin in the 3200, Farmer in the 110 meter high hurdles and Glass in the 1600.

The Geneseo frosh-soph track team scored a resounding win in its meet. The Leaflets scored 114 points, Galesburg had 57 and Alleman had eight.

Jeremiah Shoemaker, Karl Taets, Eric Newton and Landon Neumann each won two events for Geneseo.

Shoemaker cleared 5'8" in the high jump and soared 16'6" in the long jump, Taets was clocked at 2:22.5 in the 800 and 5:10.6 in the 1600, Newton turned in efforts of 17.20 seconds in the 110 meter high hurdles and 43.42

seconds in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles and Neumann won the 100 in 12.26 seconds and the 200 in 25.08 seconds.

Single event winners for the Leaflets were Brady Rasmussen, who equalled his own freshman record height of 11'6" in the pole vault, Seth Graham, who tossed the discus 125'4-1/2", Derek Wright, who won the triple jump with a distance of 37'6-1/2" and Andy Snyder, who was clocked at 11:12.6 in the 3200.

The 3200 relay team of Andy Hebden, Eric Misfeldt, Eric Anderson and Chad Sager also earned first with a time of 9:50.5.

Placing second were Todd Gilbert in the high jump, Matt VanDeVoorde in the long jump, Nate Durick in the triple jump, Ryan Carter in the 3200, Wright in the 110 meter high hurdles and 300 meter intermediate hurdles, Anderson in the 800 and Ryan Egert in the 200.

Finishing third were Graham in the shot put, Eric Walker in the high jump, Sager in the pole vault and 400, Andy Verbeck in the long jump, Spiro Liras in the triple jump, Adam Radicic in the 3200, Egert in the 100, Scott Durian in the 800 and Snyder in the 1600.

The Leafs will face a major test on Friday, April 19 in the always tough Rock Island Invitational. Geneseo finished second in the meet a year ago.




