Clean sweep!

Leafs, Leaflets claim conference crowns

Get out the brooms!! For the first time in school history, Geneseo's varsity and frosh-soph boys track swept conference titles in the same year, blowing away the field at the North Central Illinois Conference (N.C.I.C.) boys meet held Friday, May 10 in Rochelle.

The Leafs, expected to slug it out with Sterling for the varsity title, dusted off the Warriors and the rest of field for a resounding win, the second in a row and third in the last four years.

The Geneseo frosh-soph squad was expected to contend but was not a favorite. Instead, the Leaflets exceeded expectations and came up with the victory as well, downing second place Ottawa by 19.7 points.

Teams and scores in the varsity meet were Geneseo (160), Sterling (78), Dixon (55), Ottawa (53.5), Princeton (52.5), LaSalle-Peru (42), Mendota (31), Rochelle (28), Hall (24), Kewanee (21), Rock Falls (7) and Streator (6).

Leaf Coach Don Fredericks was elated with the performance of the Leafs and Leaflets.

"I thought it would come down to us and Sterling in the varsity meet but we just had so many kids come through with big performances. We've been building and building for something like this. I couldn't be happier with the results."

"Ottawa, I felt, would be hard to catch in the frosh-soph meet. They had several kids who could have been on the varsity. A number of our kids, however, performed better than they were seeded to do. It was a true team effort and something I'll remember for a long time," he said.

Both the Leafs and Leaflets displayed incredible balance by scoring in 16 of 18 events contested.

Seniors Adam Boardman and Mike VanDeVelde each claimed two individual wins for the Leafs. For the third consecutive year, Boardman captured both the 800 (1:57.7) and 1600 (4:28.2) meter runs. VanDeVelde blazed to a time of 22.5 seconds in the 200 and broke his own school record in the 400 with a time of 49.8 seconds.

Single wins were earned by Shane McKibbin in the 110 meter high hurdles (15.5 seconds) and Bryan Glass in the 3200 (9:50.1).

The lone relay win came from the 400 team of Chris Widowski, Ryan Verbeck, Ben Hahn and VanDeVelde (44.2 seconds).

Among second place finishers for the Leafs, the most surprising may have come from Darin Lavery. He was unseeded in both the long jump and triple jump entering the meet but soared to runner-up finishes in both.

Also nabbing seconds for the Leafs were McKibbin in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles, Andy Snook in the 3200, Josh Pierce in the 800 and Glass in the 1600.

Thirds were earned by VanDeVelde in

the 100, Hahn in the 400, the 800 relay team of Widowski, Nick Sable, Kevin Fuhr and Verbeck and the 1600 team of Hahn, Sable, Pierce and David Farmer. Hahn's third place time of 51.4 seconds in the 400 set a new sophomore school record.

In the frosh-soph meet, the Leaflets scored just three first place finishes but nabbed a host of high finishes to claim the team crown. Teams and scores were Geneseo (117.3), Ottawa (98), Dixon (71.3), Princeton (64), LaSalle-Peru (50), Sterling (48), Mendota (44), Streator (33), Rock Falls (19), Rochelle (7), Kewanee (6) and Hall (0).

Nabbing firsts for the Leaflets were Chad Sager in the pole vault (12'6"), Nate Durick in the triple jump (40'0") and Chad Pankey in the 3200 (10:28.1).

Seconds were earned by Seth Graham in the discus, Derek Wright in the triple jump and Eric Newton in the 110 meter high hurdles, 300 meter intermediate hurdles and 400.

Placing third for the Leaflets were Eric Misfeldt in the 800, Wright in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles, the 1600 relay team of Eric Anderson, Sager, Misfeldt and Newton and the 3200 team of Anderson, Phillip Smith, Andy Snyder and Ryan Carter.

The Leafs will next compete in the Class AA sectional meet Friday, May 17 in Sterling. Preliminaries will start at 3:30 p.m. with the finals slated for 6 p.m.

The Tuesday, May 14 Moline Frosh-Soph Invitational was rained out. A tentative make-up date of Monday, May 20 has been scheduled.

VanDeVelde sets new record to lift Leafs to NCIC meet victory

ROCHELLE - There may have been some discrepancy in the dual meet between Geneseo and Sterling but the Maple Leafs made up for the controversial loss in a big way at the NCIC varsity boys track meet last Friday.

The Leafs racked up 160 team points to easily outscore second place Sterling who finished with 78 points.

Dixon placed third in the 12-team meet with 55 points while Ottawa pulled in fourth with 53 1/2. Princeton took fourth with 52 1/2 followed by LaSalle-Peru (42), Mendota (31), Rochelle (28), Hall (24), Kewanee (21), Rock Falls(7), and Streator (6).

Senior sprinter Mike VanDeVelde captured three first place finishes and a third, and in the course of the evening set a new school record.

VanDeVelde won the 400 meter

dash in a record-setting time of :49.8, and took the gold in the 200 with a personal best mark of :22.5. He also ran on the winning 400 relay team, and took the bronze in the 100 (:11.4).

Adam Boardman was a double winner with victories in the 800 (1:57.7) and 1600 (4:28.2) for the third consecutive year. Bryan Glass was a winner in the 3200 (9:50.1) while teammate Andy Snook placed second (9:53.1) to help Geneseo sweep the distance races. Josh Pierce ran second to Boardman in the 800 with a time of 1:59.6.

Darin Lavery helped out in the field events, taking second in both the long and triple jumps. Lavery soared 41'2" in the triple and 19'8 3/4" in the long jump.

The Geneseo 800 relay squad of Chris Widowski, Kevin Fuhr, Nick

Sable and Ryan Verbeck finished third (1:34.3) as did the 1600 four-some of Sable, David Farmer, Pierce and Ben Hahn (3:30.6). Hahn also picked up points for third place in the 300 intermediate hurdles (:51.4) and the 400 (:51.4).

ROCHELLE — Geneseo ran away and hid from the field in successfully defending its North Central Illinois Conference boys track meet title here Friday night.

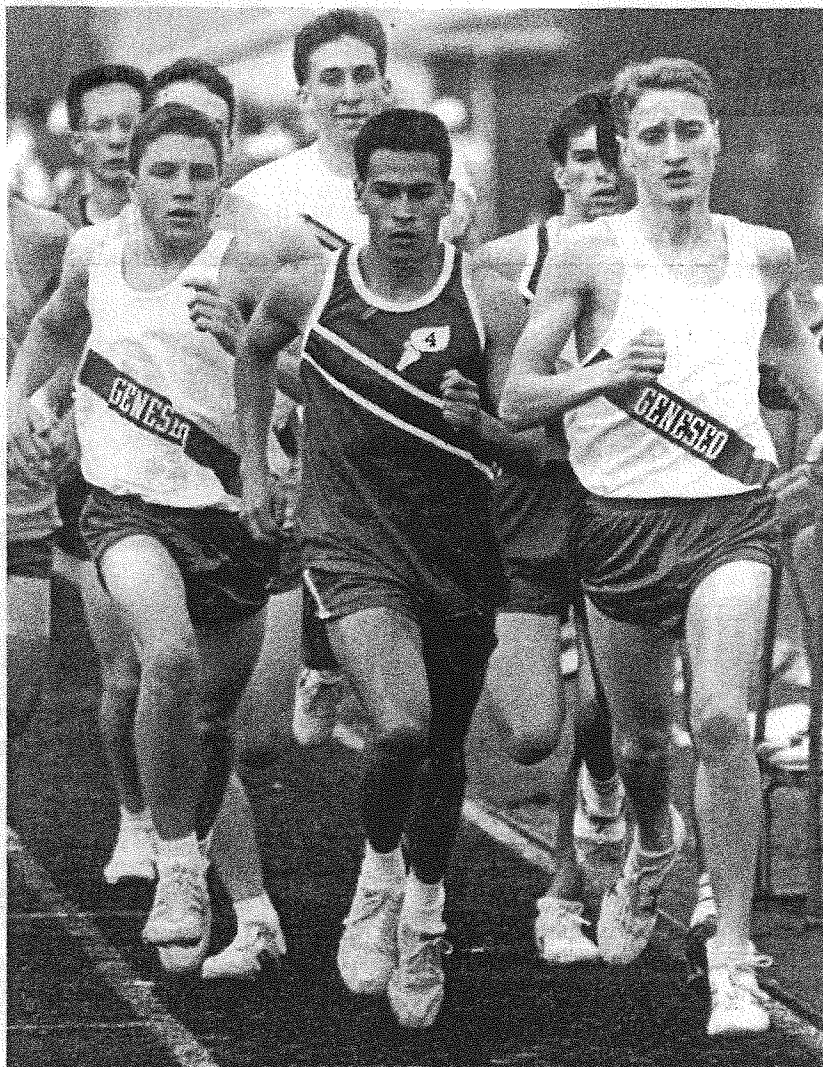
The Maple Leafs amassed a whopping 160 points to easily outdistance their nearest competitor, Sterling. The Golden Warriors finished with 78 points.

"I am ecstatic," Maple Leafs coach Don Fredricks said, "This was a total team victory. Everywhere I look I see a personal best, I couldn't have asked for any more."

Mike VanDeVelde grabbed three gold medals while setting a school record in the 400. The senior sprinter toured the 400 course in 49.8 and claimed the 200 in a personal best time of 22.5.

VanDeVelde also helped the 400 relay unit to a helping of gold and nailed down a bronze medal in the 100.

Adam Boardman continued his mastery of the 800 and 1600. The senior captured the titles in both those events for the third straight year.
