Maple Leaf tracksters top UT and Orion

Geneseo's varsity boys track team opened the outdoor portion of its season with wins over UT and Orion Tuesday, March 26 in Geneseo.

The Leafs amassed an even 100 points, the Panthers scored 81 while the Chargers did not score.

Senior Shane McKibbin led the Leafs with two individual wins and one relay victory. He was clocked at 15.4 seconds in the 110 meter high hurdles, 41.94 seconds in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles and teamed with David Farmer, Shawn Wehrspann and Nick Sable to win the 1600 meter relay with a time of 3:43.8.

Mike VanDeVelde captured both the 200 and 400 meter dashes with times of 23.89 and 52.1 seconds, respectively.

Bryan Glass was also a double winner for Geneseo. He claimed first place in the 1600 with a time of 4:41.9 and teamed with Adam Boardman, Josh Pierce and Mitch Pray to win the 3200 meter relay with a time of 8:33.8.

Leafs claiming single wins were Mark Chaney in the pole vault with an 11'6" effort, Andy Snook in the 3200 meter run with a time of 10:13.2, Ben Hahn in the 100 with a time 11.56 seconds

and Justin VanVooren in the 800 with a time of 2:12.8.

Second place finishes were earned by Snook in the pole vault, Gary Martin in the 3200, Boardman in the 400, Farmer in the 300 intermediate hurdles, Pierce in the 1600, Hahn in the 200 and the 800 relay team of Christopher Widowski, Wehrspann, Matt Jacocks and Sable.

Nabbing thirds were Nate Culbertson in the shot put and discus, Allen DeSplinter in the high jump and pole vault, Darin Lavery in the triple jump, Farmer in the 110 meter high hurdles, VanDeVelde in the 100, Hahn in the 400 and Snook in the 1600.

"We competed well, especially since it was our first outdoor meet. It is going to take some time before we perform well in the technique events but that will come as we get in more quality practices. The team is making progress, which is the most important thing at this stage of the season," said Coach Don Fredericks.

The frosh-soph tracksters earned decisive victories in their meet, scoring a 116-57 win over UT and a 116-11 triumph over Orion.

Eric Newton and Karl Taets each earned a pair of individual victories for the Leaflets in the meet.

Newton was clocked at 17.54 seconds in the 110 meter high hurdles and 45.17 seconds in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles for his wins while Taets topped the field with times of 5:15 in the 1600 and 11:08.1 in the

3200 meter runs.

Four Geneseo athletes earned single wins. They were Seth Graham with a heave of 36'1/2" in the shot put, Rob Carrothers in discus with a toss of 106/11-1/2", Brady Rasmussen with a 10' effort in the pole vault and Matthew VanDeVoorde with a 17'5-1/2" leap in the long jump.

Relay wins were earned by the 400, 1600 and 3200 teams. The 400 team of Ryan Egert, Landon Neumann, Kris Rusch and Derek Wright was clocked at 47.96, the 1600 team of Steve Pardoe, Newton, Spiro Liras and Bradley Johnson turned in a 4:04.8 winning effort and the 3200 team of Eric Misfeldt, Adam Radicic, Aaron Nelson and Chad Sager was clocked at 10:05.1.

Second place finishes were earned by Carrothers in the shot put, Graham in the discus, Todd Gilbert in the high jump, Pardoe in the pole vault, Wright in the triple jump, 110 meter high hurdles and 300 meter intermediate hurdles, Ryan Carter in the 1600 and 3200, Neumann in the 100 and 200 and Sager in the 400.

Turning in third place efforts were Jonathan Scott in the shot put, Heath DeGoei in the discus, Jeremiah Shoemaker in the high jump, Andrew Snyder in the 1600 and 3200, Misfeldt in the 400, Pardoe in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles and Egert in the 200.

The Leafs and Leaflets are scheduled to host Sherrard and Princeton on Tuesday, April 2.

Geneseo runs past UT

GENESEO - Geneseo's varsity boys track team totally dominated the running events to capture a 100-81 win over United Township on Tuesday, March 26. Orion also competed but did not score.

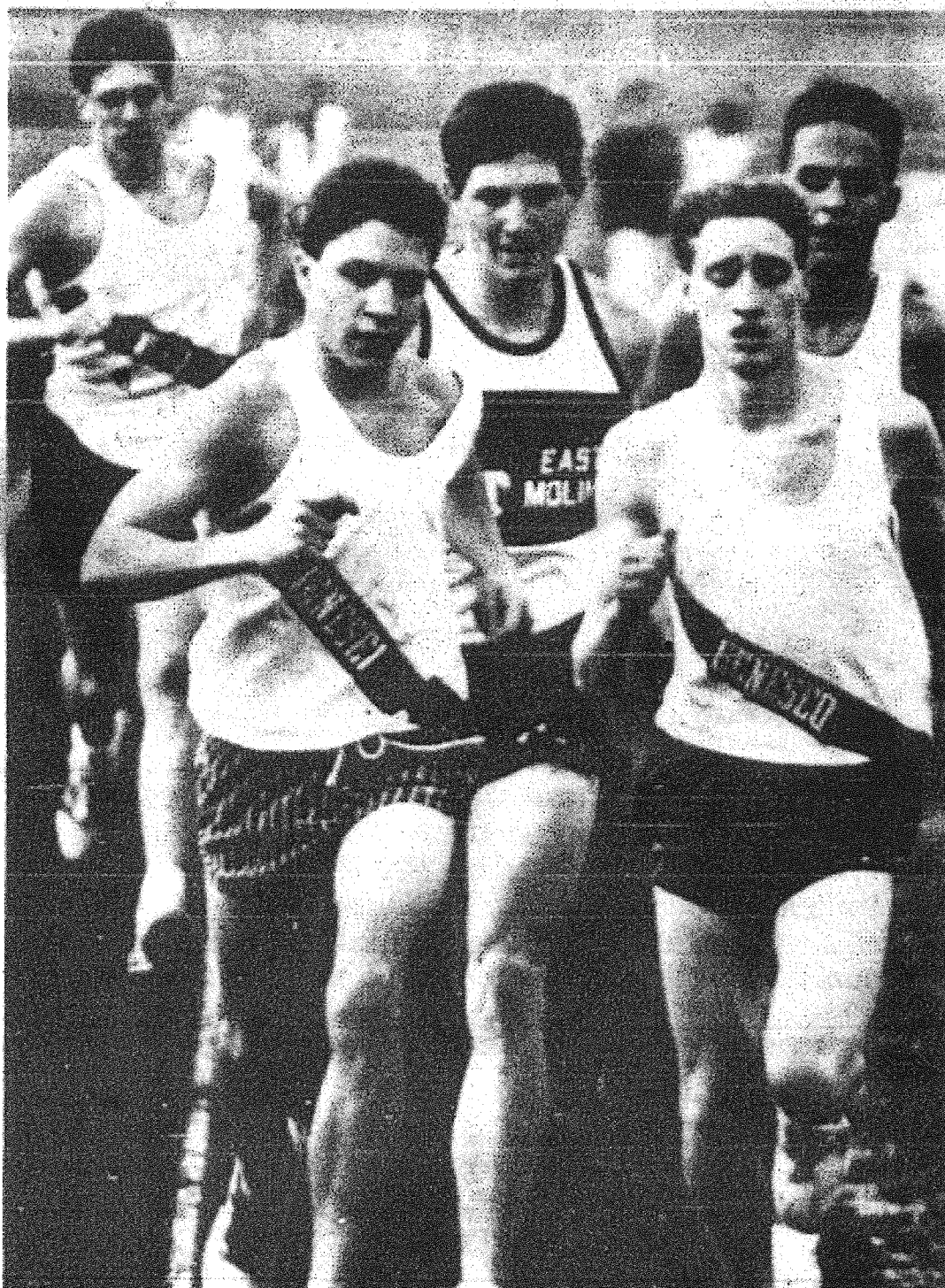
The win moved the Leafs to 3-1 on the young season as they won all but two of the running events.

Geneseo's frosh-soph team took first with 116 points while United Township had 57 and Orion 11.



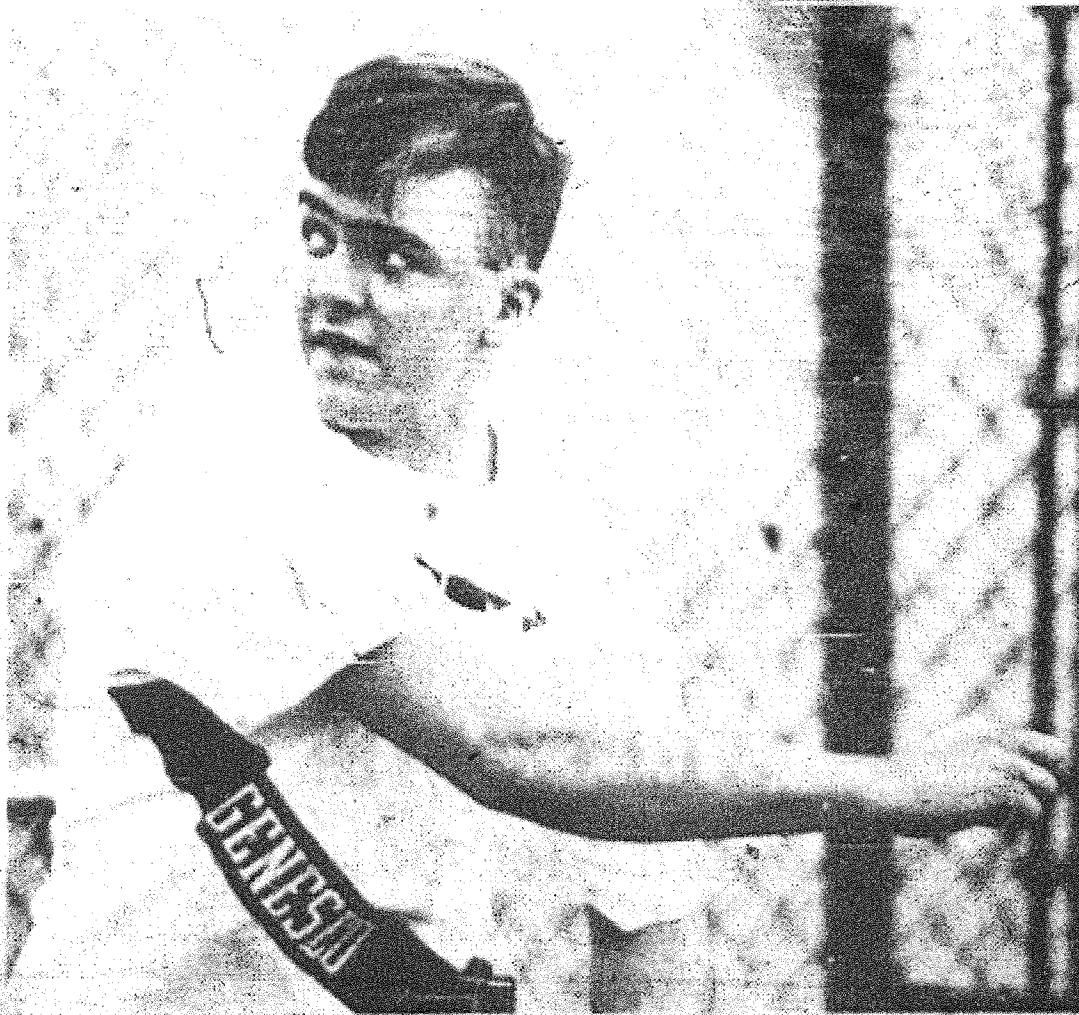
