Leafs finish second in Sterling meet

Senior hurdler Shane McKibbon earned first place in both hurdle events to lead the Geneseo varsity boys track team to a second place finish in a triangular meet held Tuesday, March 19 at the Westwood Sports Complex, Sterling.

The host Golden Warriors won the meet with 67 points and was followed by the Leaflets with 58 and Freeport with 42.

The meet marked the first true team competition for the Leaflets, who sent just their distance runners to the Macomb Invitational on Saturday, March 2.

"This was strictly a developmental meet for the kids, a chance to compete. Until we get some good weather for an extended period of time, it is going to be difficult for us to post good numbers. When the good weather does come and we get some quality practices under our belt, we should improve in almost all areas," noted Coach Don Fredericks.

McKibbon's victories came in the 55 meter intermediate hurdles with a time of 7.95 seconds and the 55 meter high hurdles with a time of 8.13 seconds.

The Leaflets earned first place in four other events.

Andy Snook placed first in the 3200 with a time of 9:58, Ben Hahn captured the 400 with a time of 54.3 seconds, Adam Boardman turned in a time of 4:31.2 in the 1600 and the 3200 relay team of Josh Pierce, Mitch Pray,

Boardman and Gary Martin was clocked at 8:52.7.

Second place finishes were earned by Darin Lavery in the long jump, Tom Britton in the triple jump, Hahn in the 55 meter dash, Shawn Wehrspann in the 200 and by the 1600 meter relay team of Pierce, Nick Sable, Lavery and McKibbon.

Earning third place were Britton in the long jump, Bryan Glass in the 1600 and 3200 and Pierce in the 800.

Sterling was victorious in the frosh-soph meet with a total of 71 points. Geneseo had 61 and Freeport totalled 33.

The Leaflets claimed first place in four events, with freshman hurdler Eric Newton earning two of them. He was clocked at 8.60 seconds in the 55 meter intermediate hurdles and 8.67 seconds in the 55 meter high hurdles.

Todd Gilbert cleared 5'8" in the high jump and Steve Pardoe turned in a 12' effort in the pole vault to claim the other wins for the Leaflets.

Earning seconds were Karl Taets in the 1600 and 3200 meter runs, Derek Wright in the 55 meter intermediate and high hurdles and triple jump, Matt VanDeVoorde in the long jump and the 1600 meter relay team of Kris Rusch, Wright, Newton and Spiro Liras.

Third place finishes were turned in by Scott Durian in the 3200, Eric Anderson in the 800, Andrew Hebden in the 400, Ryan Egert in the 200, Pierce in the high jump and Nate Durick in the triple jump.

The Leaflets and Leaflets are scheduled to open their outdoor season on Tuesday, March 26 with a home meet against UT and Orion.
