

Fifth in fast crowd

Glass, Boardman pace Leafs in strong UT Invite

Bryan Glass and Adam Boardman each won individual events to lead the Geneseo varsity boys track team to a fifth place finish in the East Moline/Silvis Kiwanis Invitational held Saturday, April 6 at the Soule Bowl, East Moline.

Rock Island ran away with the team title with 98-1/2 points. The Rocks were followed by Rockford East (52), UT (44-1/2), Galesburg (43-1/2), Geneseo (42), Sterling (39-1/2), Moline (33), Pleasant Valley (30), Alleman (14), Sherrard (6) and Rockridge (0).

Leaf Coach Don Fredericks thought his team fared well in the traditionally strong meet.

"I was very pleased with our performance, especially against the teams in this meet. Rock Island and Rockford East field great teams just about every year and there were a number of other strong entrants," he said.

Concern was expressed by some about the Leaf's possible shortcomings in non-running events but Coach Fredericks feels his team will be just fine in these areas.

"There are a lot of teams that hit the indoor circuit early on and we are always playing catch-up this part of the season. I think we are right on pace as a team and our performances in the weight and jumping areas will improve. We aren't even close to peaking yet," noted Coach Fredericks.

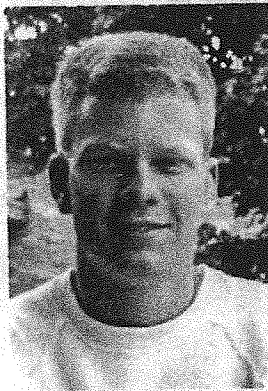
Glass, rounding into form after a bout with bronchitis earlier this sea-

son, captured first place in the 3200 with a time of 9:45.3.

Boardman earned the top spot in the 1600 with a time of 4:33.2. He was also clocked at 1:57.9 in the anchor leg of the 3200 meter relay to lead the Leafs to a third place finish in the event. Josh Pierce, Steve Miller and Mitch Pray were the other members of the 3200 team.

The Leafs earned two second place finishes in the meet.

Andy Snook was second to Glass in

the 3200 with a time of 9:57.7 while the frosh-soph 1600 meter medley relay team of Zach Mayes, Kris Rusch, Todd Gilbert and Snook was clocked at 3:59.3.

Glass earned third in the 1600 with a time of 4:43.3.

Shane McKibbin was fourth in the 110 meter high hurdles, as was freshman Eric Newton in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles, where he was clocked at 43.4 seconds, just .7 behind the winner.

"Newton ran an exceptional race, especially for a freshman. He definitely rose to the occasion," said Coach Fredericks.

On Tuesday, April 2 the frosh-soph track team scored wins over Princeton (123-21) and Sherrard (123-5) in Geneseo.

Brady Rasmussen provided a thrill for those in attendance when he cleared 11'6" in the pole vault, a new freshman record at J.D. Darnall high school. He equalled that mark in the UT Invitational.

Gilbert won three events for the Leaflets. He earned firsts in the high jump (5'6"), 100 (12.67 seconds) and 200 (26.31 seconds).

Double winners for Geneseo included Seth Graham in the shot put (35'10") and discus (128'7"), Andrew Snyder in the 1600 (5:24) and 3200 (11:11.4) and Newton in the 110 meter high hurdles (17.08 seconds) and 300 meter intermediate hurdles (44.76 seconds).

Winning single events were Jeremiah Shoemaker in the long jump (17'), Spiro Liras in the triple jump (34'9") and Eric Anderson in the 800 (2:27).

The Leafs and Leaflets were scheduled to host Galesburg and Alleman on Thursday, April 11.

Geneseo thinclads take fifth

EAST MOLINE - Despite a pair of disqualifications, Rock Island's varsity boys track team away with the championship hardware at the East Moline/Silvis Kiwanis Invitational on Saturday, April 6.

The Rocks racked up 98 1/2 points with a total team effort in both field and running events to finish way ahead of second place finisher Rockford East (52). United Township placed third with 44 1/2 points while Galesburg pulled in fourth with 43 1/2 and Geneseo fifth with 42. Rounding out the 11-team finishers were Sterling (39 1/2), Moline (33), Pleasant Valley (30), Alleman (14) and Sherard (10). Rockridge did not score.

Geneseo struggled in the field

ler and Mitch Pray were a part of that foursome along with Boardman.

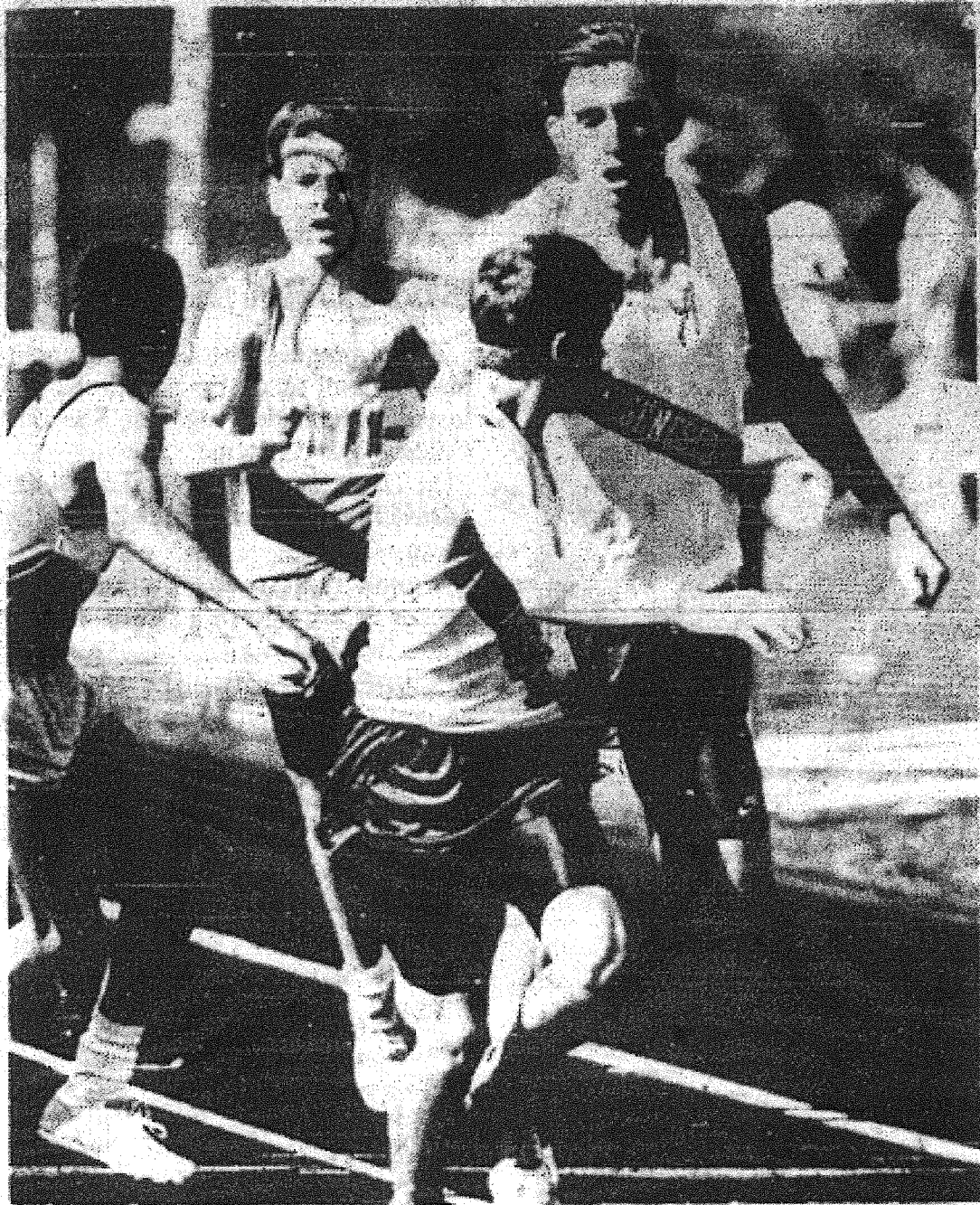
Bryan Glass captured the Leafs only other first place medallion, running a 9:45.6 in the 3200 while teammate Andy Snook took second in the event with a time of 9:59.7.

Geneseo picked up a pair of fourth place finishes in the hurdle events. Shane McKibbin recorded a 15.7 in the 110 high hurdle finals while Eric

Newton was clocked at 43.4 in the 300 intermediates.

Ben Hahn was the only other individual to place for Geneseo, taking fifth the 400 with 53.9.

The Leafs' frosh-soph 400 relay squad of Newton, Todd Gilbert, Kris Rusch and Zach Mayes placed fourth (48.2), while the frosh-soph 1600 medley foursome of Mayes, Rusch, Gilbert and Snook posted a second (3:59.5).
