Hahn helps Leafs sprint past Galesburg, Alleman

Junior sprinter Ben Hahn captured first place in three events to lead the Geneseo varsity boys track team to a triangular meet win Thursday, April 16 in Galesburg.

The Leafs amassed 81 points to defeat the host Silver Streaks (73) and Alleman (31).

Hahn earned first place in the 100 (11.2 seconds), 200 (23.53 seconds) and 400 (53.34 seconds) to lead the Leaf tracksters.

Andy Snook led a Geneseo sweep in the 3200 event, posting a winning time of 10:08.1. Teammates Karl Taets and Andy Snyder were second and third, respectively.

Earning relay wins for the Leafs were the 800 team of Jon Smith, Eric Newton, Jeremy Holke and Nick Sable (1:38.5) and the 3200 team of Josh Pierce, Eric Anderson, Chad Sager and Eric Misfeldt (8:53.3).

Second place finishers for Geneseo were Darin Lavery in the long jump and triple jump, Brady Rasmussen in the pole vault, Seth Graham in the discus, Nate Culbertson in the shot put, Newton in the 110 meter high hurdles and 300 meter intermediate hurdles and Smith in the 200.

Also placing second were the 400 team of Smith, Newton, Sable and Hahn and the 1600 team of Lavery,

Newton, Landon Neumann and Sable.

Third place finishers for the Leafs were Lavery in the high jump, Bill Campbell in the triple jump, Jim Van Acker in the shot put, Smith in the 100, Anderson in the 800 and Snook in the 1600.

The Geneseo frosh-soph track team was also in action at Galesburg and picked up a pair of victories. The Leaflets scored 90 points to defeat both Alleman (45) and Galesburg (44). Individual results were not available.

The Geneseo boys will take part in the Rock Island Invitational Friday, April 24. Competition is slated to start at 5:30 p.m.

On Monday, April 27 the Geneseo Frosh Invitational will be held in Moline due to the work being done on the track at J.D. Darnall high school. Also, the Wednesday, April 29 dual meet against Moline will be hosted by the Maroons.

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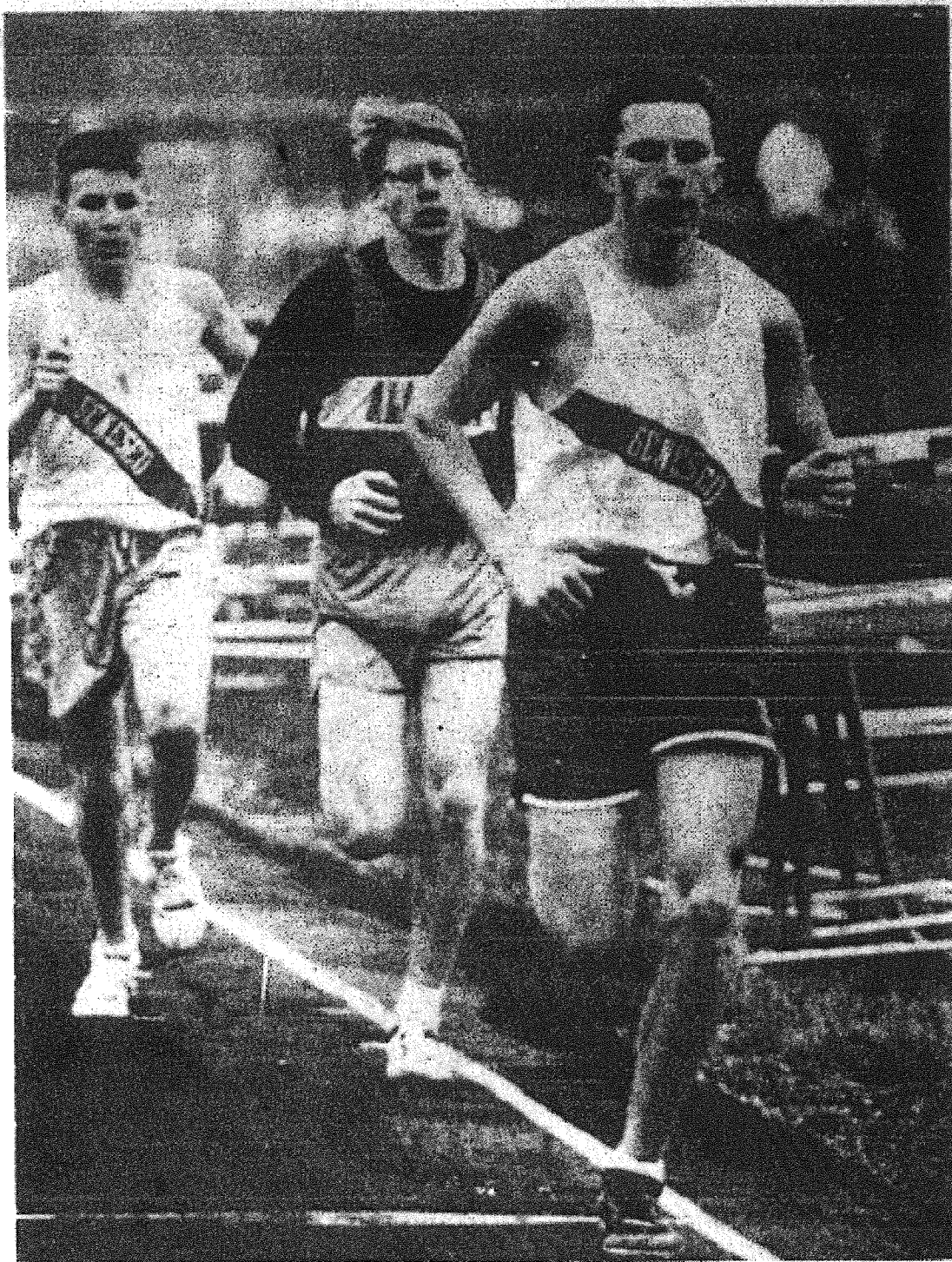
