## Hahn leads Leafs past Sherrard and Princeton

Junior sprinter Ben Hahn captured first place in three individual events to lead the Geneseo varsity boys track team to a triangular meet win over the Princeton Tigers and Sherrard Tigers Monday, April 6 in Sherrard.

The Leafs amassed 112.5 points to easily out-distance Princeton (37) and Sherrard (33.5).

Leaf Coach Don Fredericks was pleased with the performance of his team.

"This was a good meet for us. The jumpers have made a great deal of improvement and the relay teams posted their best times of the season. We are starting to gel as a team," he said.

Hahn captured first place in the 100 (11.9 seconds), 200 (24.6 seconds) and 400 meter dashes (53.3 seconds).

"Ben had an exceptional meet. Though the dashes were run into a head wind, I thought his times were very respectable for this early in the season," noted Coach Fredericks.

Eric Newton captured both of the hurdle races for the Leafs. He was clocked at 17.3 seconds in the 110-meter high hurdles and 43.4 seconds in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles.

Nabbing single wins for Geneseo were Brady Rasmussen in the pole vault (10'6"), Darin Lavery in the long

jump (19'3-1/2"), Andy Snyder in the 3200 (10:42.3), Josh Pierce in the 800 (2:11.1) and Andy Snook in the 1600 (4:44.5).

The Leafs also captured first place in all four relay events. They were the 400 team of Jon Smith, Newton, Nick Sable and Hahn (45.5 seconds); the 800 team of Smith, Newton, Jeremy Holke and Sable (1:36.4); the 1600 team of Holke, Sable, Landon Neumann and Pierce (3:42.9); and the 3200 team of Chad Sager, Eric Misfeldt, Snook and Pierce (8:53.3).

Second place finishers for the Leafs were Andy Porter in the shot put, Pierce in the high jump, Nate Durick in the triple jump, Karl Taets in the 3200, Smith in the 100 and 200 and Eric Anderson in the 800 and Misfeldt in the 1600.

Placing third were Nate Culbertson in the shot put, Seth Graham in the discus, Todd Gilbert in the high jump, Tom Britton in the long jump, Lavery in the triple jump, Ryan Carter in the 3200 and Taets in the 1600.

The Geneseo sophomore squad was also victorious in its meet, amassing 106 points to defeat both Princeton (58) and Sherrard (19).

Jeremiah Shoemaker, Josh Inch and Brad Johnson each captured two individual events for the Leaflets. Shoemaker won both the long jump (18'1-1/2") and 100 meter dash (12.5 seconds); Inch was clocked at 5:22.6 in the 1600 and 11:05.5 in the 3200; and Johnson turned in times of 18.7 sec-

onds in the 110 meter high hurdles and 46.5 seconds in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles.

Winning single events for Geneseo were Phil Gradert in the high jump (5'6"), Matt Wilson in the pole vault (10'), Jeff Causemaker in the triple jump (37'9"), Eric Durian in the 800 (2:26.3) and Dan Flood in the 400 (56.1 seconds).

Winning relay events were the 1600 team of Phil Smith, Gradert, Mike Poppen and Wilson (4:00.2) and the 3200 team of Flood, Chad Sellman, Jeremiah Waggoner and Durian (9:41.9).

Second place finishers for the Leaflets were Andy Nissen in the pole vault, Troy Boelens in the long jump and triple jump, Joe Loftus in the 3200, Causemaker in the 110 meter high hurdles and 300 meter intermediate hurdles, Sellman in the 800, Wilson in the 400, Waggoner in the 1600 and Flood in the 200.

Also placing second was the 400 and 800 relay team of Hudnall, Johnson, Phil Smith and Shoemaker.

Third place finishers for Geneseo were Kevin Wachtel in the discus, Brad Schnowske in the pole vault, Waggoner in the 800 and Loftus in the 1600.

Geneseo is next slated to compete Saturday, April 11 in the East Moline Kiwanis Relays. Meet time is 11 a.m. at the Soule Bowl.

Work on the Geneseo track was scheduled to begin on Wednesday, April 15, weather permitting. It is expected to take 7-10 days to complete the project.
