

"Fielders" pace Leaf tracksters

Field event wins help Leafs past UT, Orion

A strong showing by the field event athletes helped the Geneseo varsity boys track team to wins over United Township and Orion Tuesday, March 31 in East Moline.

The Leafs amassed 94 points to top both the Panthers (76) and Chargers (13).

First place finishes in the triple jump, discus, pole vault and high jump helped the Leafs to the victory in cold, windy conditions, something which pleased Coach Don Fredericks.

"Coach (Mel) Snook's and Coach (Denny) Dierick's boys paved the way for us in this meet. This was a very nice win for the kids. All of the teams had to battle the elements but I felt we did the best job of dealing with it. The kids really performed well," praised Coach Fredericks.

Josh Pierce and Ben Hahn each claimed a pair of wins for the Leafs. Pierce claimed first in the high jump (5'8") and the 800 (2:09.3) while Hahn turned in winning efforts in the 200 (24.1 seconds) and 400 (54.0 seconds).

Claiming single victories for the Leafs were Darin Lavery in the triple jump (40'10-1/2"), Andy Porter in the discus (116'2"), Brady Rasmussen in the pole vault (12'0"), Andy Snook in the 1600 (4:47.7) and Eric Newton in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles (44.0 seconds).

Also claiming first was the 1600 relay team of Nick Sable, Jeremy Holke, Landon Neumann and Pierce (3:44.1).

Second place finishers for Geneseo were Lavery in the long jump, Tom Britton in the triple jump and high jump, Porter in the shot put, Seth Graham in the discus, Hahn in the 100, Eric Anderson in the 800 and Jon Smith in the 200.

Claiming seconds in relays were the 400 team of Smith, Newton, Sable and

Hahn; the 800 team of Smith, Newton, Holke and Sable and the 3200 team of Snook, Anderson, Misfeldt and Pierce.

Third place finishers for the Leafs were Jim Van Acker in the shot put, Ryan Carter in the 3200 and Misfeldt in the 1600.

Geneseo's frosh-soph boys track team was also victorious in its meet, topping UT 98-73.

Jeff Causemaker and Dan Flood each scored a pair of wins to lead the Leaflets. Causemaker finished first in the triple jump (36'11-1/2") and 110 meter high hurdles (18.8 seconds) while Flood captured the 200 (26.0 seconds) and 400 meter dashes (57.5 seconds).

Claiming single wins for Geneseo were Mike Poppen in the shot put (37'6"), Andy Nissen in the pole vault (9'0"), Troy Boelens in the high jump (5'4"), Joe Loftus in the 3200 (11:37.8), Jeremiah Shoemaker in the 100 (12.2 seconds), Brad Johnson in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles (47.2 seconds) and Josh Inch in the 1600 (5:16.7).

Relay teams which posted wins were the 400 and 800 team of Shane Hudnall, Johnson, Phil Smith and Shoemaker (49.5 seconds and 1:43.7 seconds) and the 3200 team of Flood, Chad Sellman, Eric Durian and Inch (9:26.2).

Claiming runner up positions for the Leaflets were Shoemaker in the long jump, Brad Schnowske in the pole vault, Phil Grader in the high jump and Durian in the 800.

Also finishing second was the 1600 relay team of Phil Smith, Grader, Poppen and Matt Wilson.

Third place finishers for Geneseo were Causemaker in the long jump and 300 meter intermediate hurdles, Boelens in the triple jump, Kevin Wachtel in the discus, Wilson in the pole vault, Sellman in the 800 and Hudnall in the 200.

The Leafs and Leaflets will travel to Sherrard on Monday, April 6 for a triangular meet against Princeton and the host Tigers.
