

Leafs win Invite

Geneseo tops twelve teams at McCormick Invitational

Geneseo's boys track team played host to 12 competitors on Thursday, May 6 at the John McCormick track invitational.

The Leafs won the meet with a total of 101 points, 19 points ahead of second place East Peoria with 82.

Leading the first place parade for the Leafs was Brad Johnson, earning the top spot in the long jump with a leap of 21'5 1/2" and in the 300m intermediate hurdles with a time of :40.75.

Other first place finishers were the

Leafs' weightmen's relay squad of Seth Graham, Jeremiah Shoemaker, Mike Poppen and Bob Bowling with a time of :48.26 and Ben Hahn in the 400m run with a mark of :50.88.

Taking second place for Geneseo were Andy Snook in the 3200m run with a time of 9:51.50 and Hahn in the 200m dash with a time of :22.81.

Earning third place honors were Hahn in the 100m dash with a time of :11.2; Eric Newton in the 110m high hurdles with a mark of :15.42, Eric Misfeldt, 800m run, 2:04.55 and Johnson, high jump, 6'2".

Five Leafs garnered fourth place including the 3200m relay team of Misfeldt, Chris Pobanz, Scott Rogers and Eric Anderson with a time of 8:25.87 and the 400m relay team of

Newton, Jeremiah Shoemaker, Matt Wilson and Hahn at :44.73. Other fourth place finishers were Andy Snyder in the 3200m run with a time of 10:17.69; Shoemaker, long jump, 20'1 1/2" and Chad Sager, pole vault, 13'.

Finishing fifth for Geneseo were Johnson in the 110 high hurdles with a time of :15.91; Snook, 1600m run, 4:37.35; Brady Rasmussen, pole vault, 13'; Jeff Causemaker, 300m intermediate hurdles, :42.48 and Newton, 200m dash, :23.81.

Placing sixth for the home team was Karl Tacts in the 1600m run with a time of 4:39.27.

The Leafs will compete in the M.E.I.C. conference meet in Dixon on Friday, May 14 at 3 p.m.

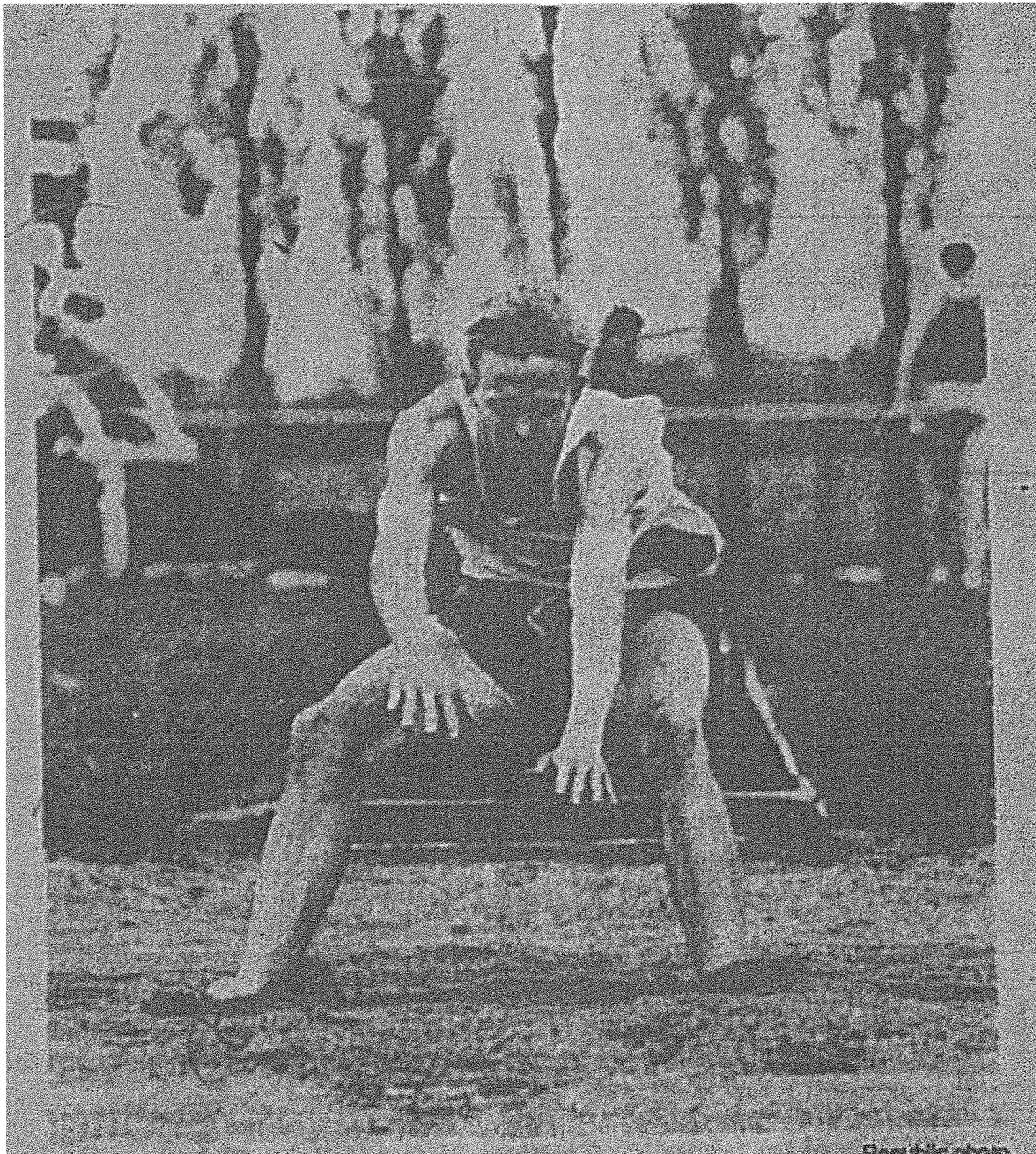
