Ben Hahn leads Leaf tracksters to 2nd in conference

Dixon was the site of the N.C.I.C. boys conference track meet on Friday, May 14 and Geneseo nearly walked away with the title.

Geneseo challenged Sterling right down to the wire before taking second by the score of 139-127.

Blazing a trail for the Leafs was Ben Hahn. Hahn placed first in the 100m dash with a time of :10.94; the 200m dash at :22.72 and the 400m dash with a mark of :51.41.

Seth Graham garnered the top spot in the discus with a toss of 145' and Andy Snook earned first place in the 3200m run with a time of 9:45.94.

Second place finishers for Geneseo were Jeff Causemaker in the triple jump with a mark of 40'8"; the 400m relay team of Eric Newton, Jeremiah Shoemaker, Matt Wilson and Ben Hahn with a time of :43.83; Newton, 110 high hurdles, :15.08; Brad Johnson,

300m intermediate hurdles, :40.41 and Snook, 1600m run, 4:33.98.

Johnson took third in the long jump and fourth place finishers were Tacts in the 1600m; Eric Anderson, 800m; Johnson, 110m high hurdles and high jump; Andy Snyder in the 3200m and the 3200m relay team of Misfeldt, Pobanz, Rogers and Anderson.

Shoemaker took fifth in the long jump and the 800m relay team of Newton, Shoemaker, Wilson and Smith also grabbed fifth place.

The Geneseo frosh/soph team placed sixth overall at the conference meet with a total of 44 points. Sterling dominated the meet, scoring 146 points.

Josh Inch ran a time of 10:38 to bring home the Leaflets only first place finish of the meet and then grabbed the Leaflets only second place finish with a time of 4:53.14 in the 1600m run.

Placing fourth for Geneseo were the 3200m relay team of Eric Durlan, Clay Hanson, Brian Gillatt and Christopher Farmer; Durlan in the 400m dash and Bob Bowling in the shot put.

Fifth place finishers were Brian Krantz in the 300m intermediate hurdles; Andy Nissen, 400m; Troy Collins, triple jump; Hanson in the 1600m and the 1600m relay team of Hull, Neumann, Anderson and Misfeldt.

Finishing in sixth place were Chris Whittington in the discus; the 400m

relay team of Collins, Krantz, Shane Hudnall and Bowling and Brady Rasmussen in the pole vault.

On Tuesday, May 18 the frosh/soph boys competed at the Moline frosh/soph invite and finished second with a score of 84-1/2 points. Rock Island placed first with 118.

First place finishers for Geneseo were Troy Boelens in the high jump with a leap of 6'; Mike Poppen, shot put, 46'4 1/2" and Inch, 3200m, 10:34.42.

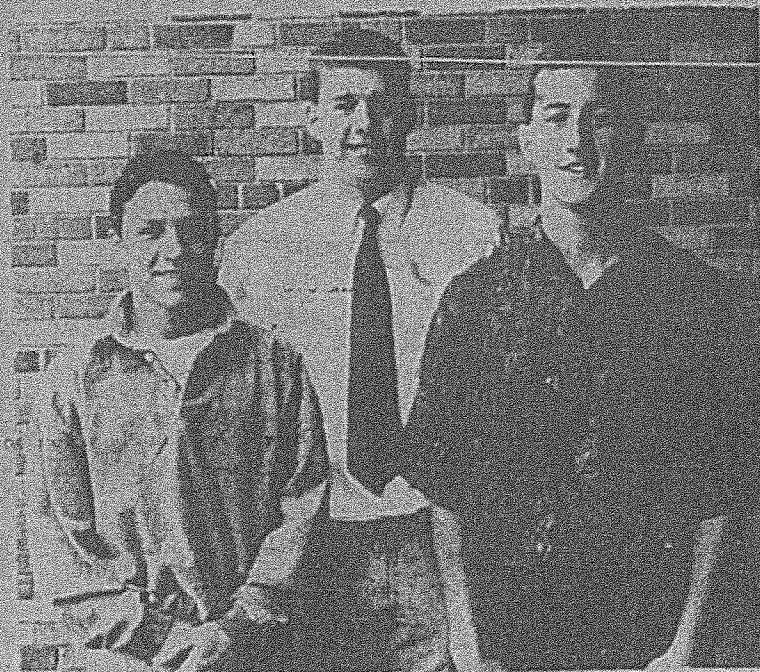
Garnering second place were Poppen in the discus with a toss of 124'; Causemaker, triple jump, 39'2 1/2"; Wilson, 100m, :11.65 and Inch, 1600m, 4:56.09.

Taking third were Wilson, pole vault; Bowling, shot put; Boelens, triple jump and the Leaflets' 1600m and 800m relay teams.

Fourth place finishers included Phil Gradert in the high jump; Causemaker, 110m high hurdles; the 400m relay team; Joe Loftus, 3200m run and Nissen in the 400m.

Fifth place finishers were Bowling in the high jump and Farmer, 800m while Leaflets finishing sixth were Whittington in the shot put; Collins, triple jump; the 3200m relay team and Krantz in the 200m.

The boys sectional track meet will be held on Friday, May 21 at Sterling.

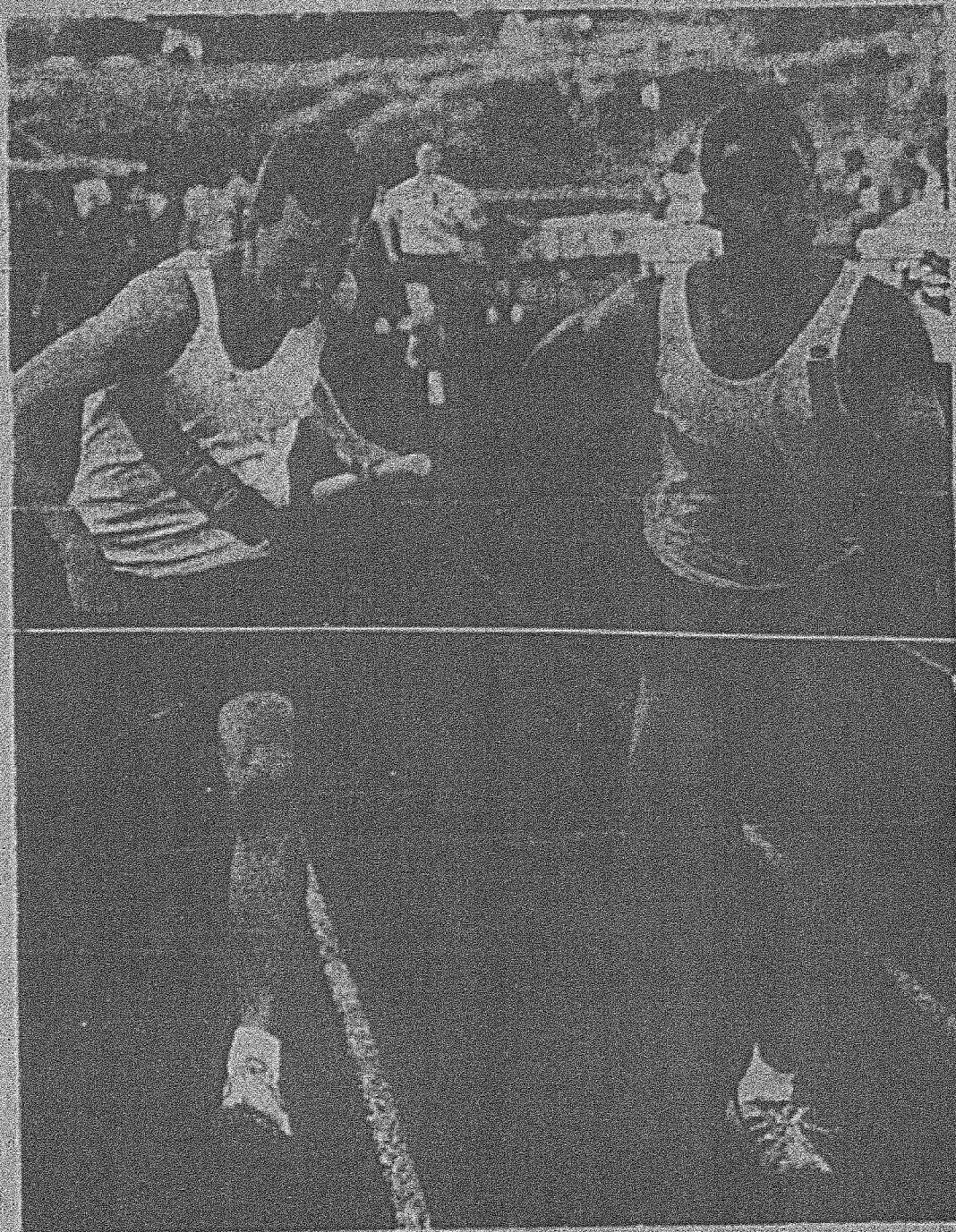

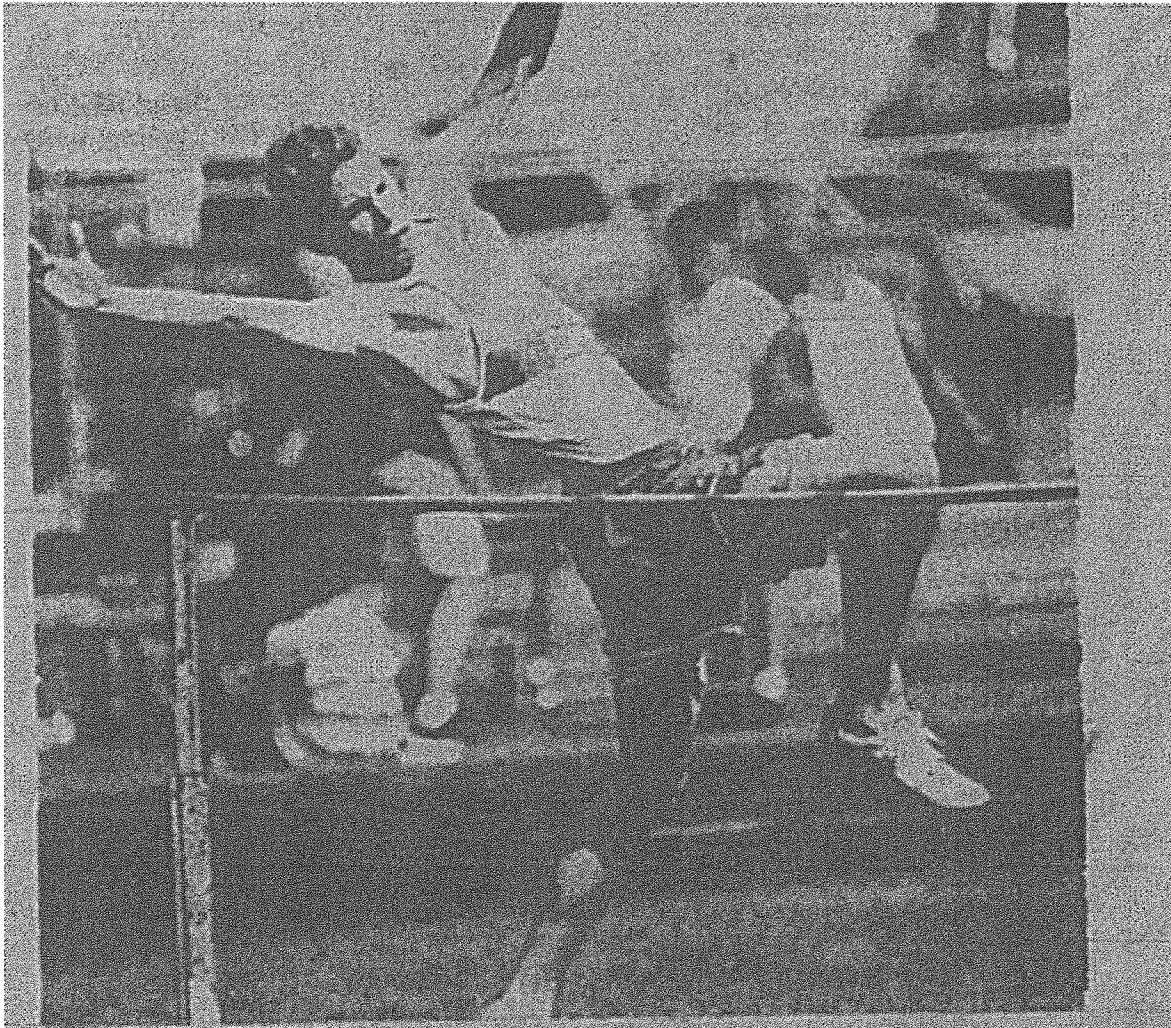

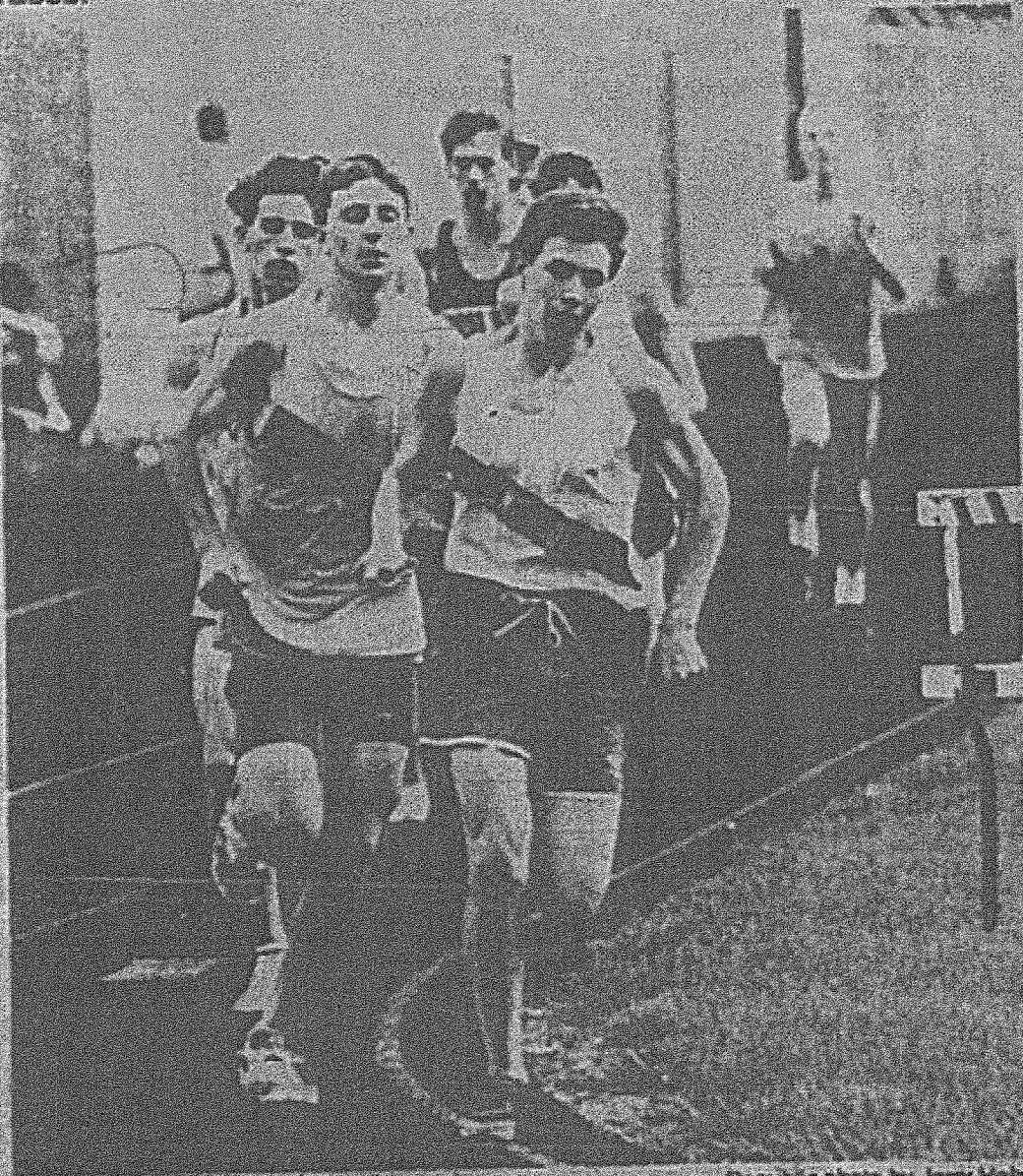
