

Runners on their mark

Varsity and Frosh-Soph Leafs in action

Leaf track traveled to Galesburg Thursday, April 14 for a triangular meet with Galesburg and Rock Island Alleman. Geneseo's boys came out on top with 87 points. Galesburg was next with 63 and Alleman third with 31.

Troy Boelens placed second in the high jump and long jump, and Jeff Causemaker was third in the long jump.

Nate Durick nabbed second in the triple jump and Causemaker was third. Brady Rasmussen finished first in the pole vault, clearing 13'6".

Mike Poppen grabbed second in the discus and shot put and Kevin Wachel was third in the discus.

Geneseo's 3200 meter relay of Joe Loftus, Josh Inch, Mike Hanson and Adam Radicic and the 400 meter relay team of Jeff Michels, Eric Anderson, Brian Krantz and Durick finished second. Andy Snyder won the 3200 meter run in 10:15.1.

Causemaker won the 110 meter high hurdles in 15.6 seconds. Jeff Michels won the 100 meter dash in 11.2 seconds.

Eric Misfeldt ran to first in the 800 meter run in 2:06. The Leafs 800 meter relay team of Krantz, Durick, Michels and Boelens won.

Anderson finished second in the 400 meter run, and Causemaker was second in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles.

Inch finished second in the 1600 meter run and Jeff Michels won the 200 meter dash in 23.4 seconds.

The 1600 meter relay team of Krantz, Jeff Michels, Misfeldt and Anderson won in 3:37.2.

The frosh-soph team won with 70 points to Alleman's 35 and Galesburg's 45.

The 400 meter relay team of Ben Forest, Del Lamont, Steve Schaaf and Chad Frank won.

Steve Nordstrom finished third in the 3200 meter run. Jon Esche won the 110

meter high hurdles in 17.7 seconds. Matt Salinas was third in the 100 meter dash and Lamont was fourth.

Adam Forest came in second in the 800 meter run in 2:14.7 and Jeremy Brown was third in 2:19.

Ben Forest came in second in the 400 meter dash and Doug Patchin was third. Geneseo's 800 meter relay team of Salinas, Jon Esche, Schaaf and Justin Buechler won in 1:44.6.

In the 300 meter intermediate hurdles, Jon Esche won in 44.6 seconds while Andy Esche was third.

Jared Thompson was third in the 1600 meter run. Buechler was third in the 200 meter dash and Lamont was fourth.

Schaaf won the long jump, leaping 17'9" and Frank came in second. Schaaf was second in the triple jump with Andy Esche finishing third and Lance Hackwith fourth.

Andy Esche was second in the high jump also. Burton Wilcox won the discus with a toss of 102'7" and Corbin Shipp was fourth.

The 1600 meter relay team of Patchin, Adam Forest, Ben Forest and Frank won in 4:01.

In a quadrangular Tuesday, April 19, at Geneseo, the varsity Leafs finished second with 85 points behind Keweenaw with 95. Princeton was third and LaSalle-Peru came in last.

Phil Gradert finished third in the high jump and Durick was second in the triple jump.

In the pole vault, Rasmussen won, clearing 13'2". Poppen finished third in the discus and second in the shot put.

The 3200 meter relay team of Anderson, Snyder, Hanson and Misfeldt won with a time of 8:52.1. The 400 meter relay team of Causemaker, Krantz, Durick and Jeff Michels finished third.

Inch won the 3200 meter run in 10:39 and Joe Loftus was third. Causemaker won the 110 meter high hurdles in 15.94 seconds. Jon Esche was third.

Jeff Michels grabbed third in the 100

meter dash and Anderson nabbed first in the 800 meter run in 2:03.5.

Misfeldt finished second in the 400 meter dash. Jon Esche was third in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles.

Jeremy Michels won the 1600 meter run in 4:49.14 and Snyder came in second. Krantz finished third in the 200 meter dash.

The 1600 meter relay team of Jeff Michels, Inch, Misfeldt and Anderson grabbed first with a time of 3:37.5.

The frosh-soph Leafs scored 57 points for third behind Princeton with 91 and LaSalle-Peru with 85. Keweenaw had 36.

The 3200 meter relay team of Farmer, Brown, Patchin and Adam Forest won in 9:49.95 and the 400 meter relay team of Schaaf, Frank, Ben Forest and Lamont was second in 49.36 seconds.

Thompson was second in the 3200 meter run in 11:26 and David Cryder was fourth in 12:29. Salinas finished fifth in the 100 meter dash in 12.5 seconds.

Farmer was second in the 800 meter run in 2:12 and Adam Forest was fourth in 2:16. Ben Forest finished third in the 400 meter dash in 59.81 seconds and Patchin was fourth in 59.99 seconds.

Andy Esche finished fourth in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles in 50.6 seconds. Brown was third in the 1600 meter run in 5:28 and Nordstrom was fourth in 5:30.

Salinas grabbed second in the 200 meter dash in 26.41 seconds and Buechler was fourth in 27.07 seconds.

The 1600 meter relay team of Ben Forest, Patchin, Frank and Farmer was third in 4:04. Schaaf was third in the triple jump with a 35'4" and Andy Esche was fifth with a 33'8" jump.

Andy Esche was third in the high jump, clearing 5' and Wilcox was third in the discus with a toss of 103'4". Schaaf was second in the long jump, leaping 16'7" and Frank was third with a jump of 16'1".
