

Boys track invite

Thirteen teams to compete in McCormick Invite

The John McCormick Boys Track Invitational will be held Friday, May 6 at 5:30 p.m. Each team is allowed one relay team per relay event and two individuals for the individual events.

Teams entered are Canton, Dixon, East Peoria, Galesburg, Geneseo, Kewanee, LaSalle-Peru, Metamora, Ottawa, Princeton, Rochelle, Rock Falls and Rock Island Alleman.

There will be a weightman's 400 meter relay for boys that throw in the shot put or discus and are not consid-

ered regular sprintmen. It will not count toward team points for the relay championship, but it will count as an event for competition.

A traveling trophy will be awarded to the first place team and first, second and third place trophies will be awarded.

Individual medals will be given for first, second and third place finishers and ribbons will be awarded to fourth fifth and sixth places.

Individual medals will be given for first place in the relay events and ribbons for second, third, fourth, fifth and sixth places. Each individual is allowed to compete in a maximum of four events.

Geneseo finishes third

Leafs place high at home to race into N.C.I.C.

Geneseo's boys track team hosted the McCormick Invitational Friday, May 6. The Leafs placed third out of 13 teams with 70 points. Kewanee won the meet with 90 and East Peoria was second with 85 points.

Troy Boelens placed fourth in the long jump with a 19'7" leap. Nate Durick was third in the triple jump with a 41'5-1/2" mark. Brady Rasmussen was fourth in the pole vault, clearing the 12'6" bar.

Geneseo's 3200 meter relay team of Eric Misfeldt, Josh Inch, Jeremy Michels and Eric Anderson won in 8:08.44.

The 400 meter relay team of Matt Wilson, Jeff Causemaker, Brian Krantz and Jeff Michels finished sixth in 45.54 seconds.

Andy Snyder took second in the 3200 meter run in 9:53.25 and Joe Loftus was fourth in 10:20.88. Causemaker

won the 110 meter high hurdles in 15.61 seconds.

Misfeldt came in second in the 800 meter run in 2:00.66. Anderson was fourth in the 400 meter dash in 52.24 seconds and Jeff Michels was sixth in 52.83 seconds.

Causemaker took sixth in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles in 43.25 seconds. Inch was fifth in the 1600 meter run in 4:42.68.

The 1600 meter relay team of Jeff Michels, Causemaker, Misfeldt and Anderson finished second with a time of 3:30.47.

The boys freshman team traveled to Sterling for the Sterling Freshman Invitational Monday, May 9. Geneseo placed fourth with 43 points out of seven teams. Sterling won with 60 and Dixon and Princeton tied for second with 50 points.

Alan Sikarskie placed fourth in the discus with a toss of 110'9". Steve Schaaf was fourth in the long jump with a 17'11-3/4" mark and Chad Frank was fifth with a 17'9" jump. Frank was also fifth in the high jump, clearing the 5'4" bar.

Geneseo's 400 meter relay team of Schaaf, Frank, Ben Forest and Del Lamont finished second in 48.82 seconds. Schaaf was second in the triple jump, marking a 36'1-3/4" jump. Andy Esche was fifth with a 35'3-1/2" mark.

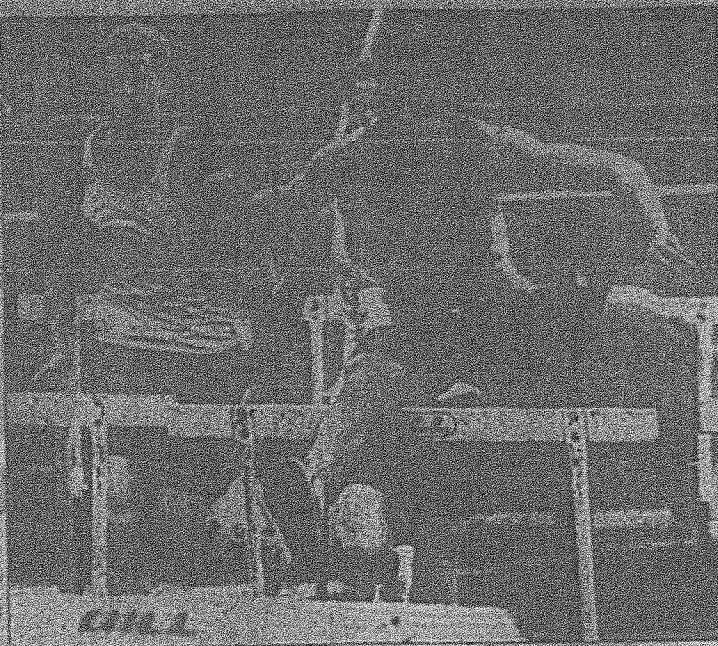
Esche placed third in the 70 meter high hurdles in 12.17 seconds. Adam Forest was second in the 800 meter run in 2:14.33.

The 800 meter relay team of Sikarskie, Lance Hackwith, Lamont and Ben Forest finished fifth in 1:48.52.

Doug Patchin nabbed third in the 400 meter dash in 57.25 seconds. Ben Forest won the 300 meter low hurdles in 45.80 seconds and Andy Esche was second in 46.68 seconds.

Lamont placed third in the 200 meter dash in 26.34 seconds. The 1600 meter relay team of Patchin, Adam Forest, Frank and Ben Forest finished third in 4:07.88.

The Leafs are preparing for the N.C.I.C. conference meet Friday, May 13 at 3 p.m. at Kewanee High School.
