

Full steam ahead

Geneseo boys team competing among the top

Leaf tracksters traveled to Rock Island for the Rock Island Track and Field Invitational Friday, April 22. Geneseo came in sixth place with 100-1/2 points out of 14 teams. Rocky won the meet with 233 points.

There were three classes that the athletes participated in, A, B and C along with the relay events.

In the C Division, Chad Frank placed sixth in the long jump, leaping 173-1/4." Steve Schaaf was third in the triple jump with a leap of 36'1." Mike Hanson was sixth in the 1600 meter run in 4:57.8.

In the B Division, Schaaf was fourth in the long jump with a mark of 183-1/4." Jeff Causemaker placed third in the triple jump, landing at 39'6-1/2."

Josh Inch was fifth in the 3200 meter run in 10:20.9. Justin Fiers tied for third in the high jump, clearing 5'10". In the pole vault, Sam Weinert finished fourth, clearing 10' even.

Jeremy Michels was second in the 800 meter run with a time of 2:05.2. Jeff Michels finished third in the 400 meter dash in 52.4 seconds.

Mike Poppen grabbed fourth in the A Division shot put with a toss of 48'8-1/2." Andy Snyder finished fifth in the 3200 meter run, recording a time of 9:52.7.

Poppen finished sixth in the discus with a throw of 130'11." Nate Durick recorded a 40'9" triple jump for third place.

Eric Missett finished fourth in the 800 meter run in 2:01.6. Eric Anderson ran the 400 meter dash in 52 seconds for fifth place. Phil Gradert secured

fourth in the high jump, clearing 62," two inches better than the first place finish for the other classes.

In the relays, Geneseo's 3200 meter relay team of Missett, Adam Forest, Jeremy Michels and Anderson finished third in 8:20. The 1600 meter relay team placed fourth in 8:33.1.

Geneseo's frosh-soph team placed seventh with 39 points out of 104 teams at the Geneseo Frosh-Soph Invitational Monday, April 25. Sterling won the meet with 83 points.

The 3200 meter relay team of Chris Farmer, Jeremy Brown, Doug Patchin and Adam Forest placed second in 9:09.96.

Jon Esche finished third in the 110 meter high hurdles in 17.91 seconds. The 800 meter relay team of Schaaf, Frank, Matt Salinas and Troy Collins finished fourth in 140.89.

In the 800 meter run, Farmer was fourth in 2:11.77 and Adam Forest was fifth in 2:12.94.

Jon Esche finished second in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles in 45.2 seconds. Collins was third in the triple jump, leaping 38'4."

Geneseo took on Moline in track action Tuesday, April 26. The varsity squad defeated the Maroons, 99-37. The frosh-soph fell, 80-53.

The varsity Leaf's 3200 meter relay team of Mike Hanson, Adam Radicic, Joe Loftus and Ryan Carter won in 9:18.93. The 400 meter relay team of Matt Wilson, Causemaker, Durick and Jeff Michels won in 45.82 seconds.

Snyder finished second in the 3200 meter run and Inch was third. Causemaker won the 110 meter high hurdles in 15.9 seconds. Jon Esche was second.

Jeff Michels grabbed first in the 100 meter dash in 11.65 seconds. Wilson finished second behind him. Carter was

third in the 800 meter run.

The 800 meter relay team of Jon Esche, Troy Boelens, Brian Krantz and Wilson won in 1:38.94. Jeff Michels won the 400 meter dash in 54.54 seconds.

Jon Esche won the 300 meter intermediate hurdles in 47.93 seconds. Krantz finished second. Anderson won the 1600 meter run in 4:46.97. Jeremy Michels was second and Missett was third.

Wilson sprinted to first in the 200 meter dash in 25.52 seconds. The 1600 meter relay team of Jeff Michels, Causemaker, Missett and Anderson won in 3:45.20.

Poppen finished second and Kevin Wachtel third in the discus. Poppen won the shot put with a throw of 50'4-1/2."

Durick won the triple jump, leaping 39'2" and Causemaker was second. Boelens won the long jump with a leap of 19'10" while Krantz finished third. Boelens also won the high jump, clearing 5'10" while Gradert was second.

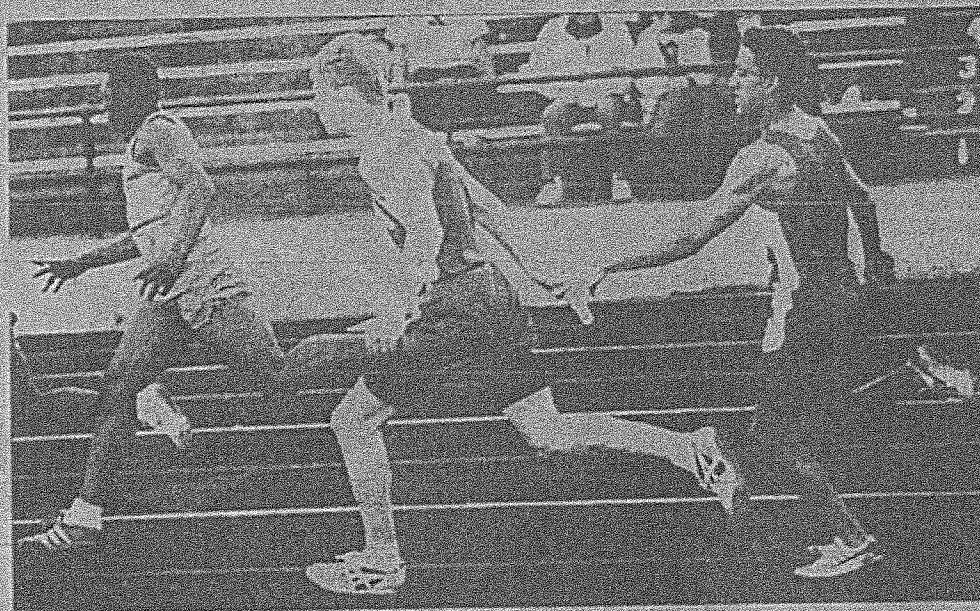
In frosh-soph action, Farmer won the 800 meter run in 2:15.07 and Adam Forest finished second. Salinas was third in the 100 meter dash.

Burton Wilcox won the discus with a toss of 99'8." Alan Sikarskie was second and Corbin Shipp third. Shawn Walsh finished second in the shot put and Ben Sleasford was third.

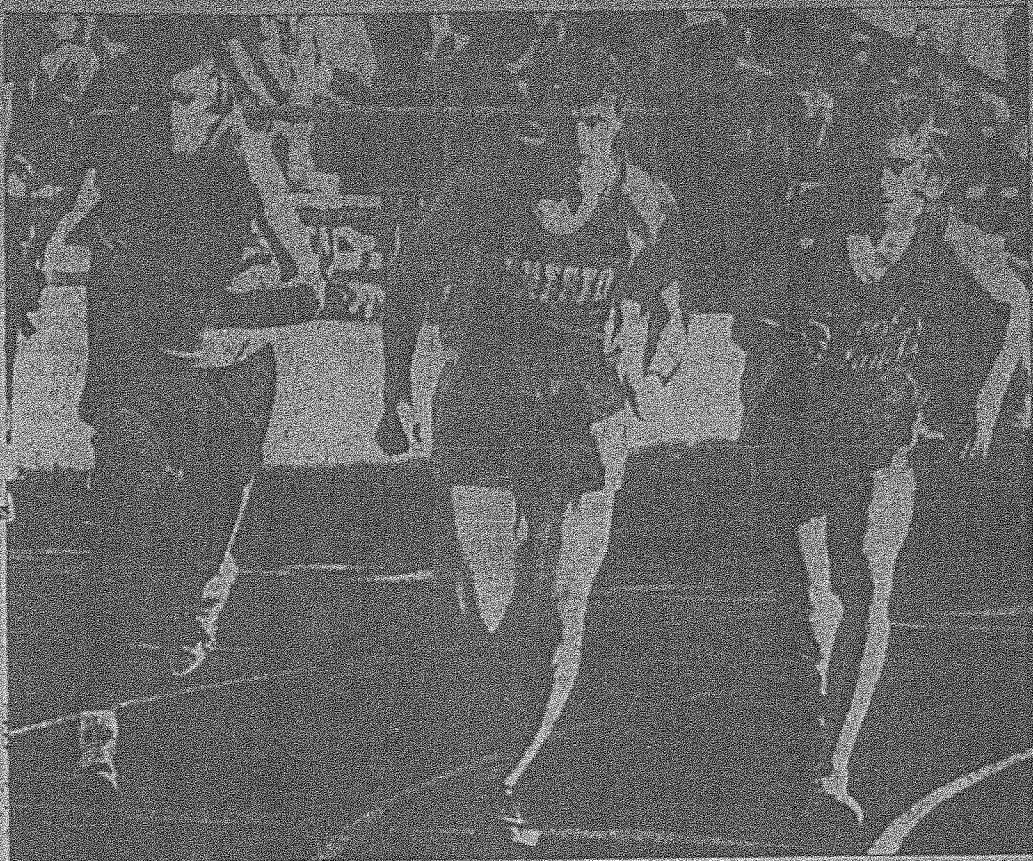
Collins won the triple jump, skipping to 37'1" while Schaaf finished second and Andy Esche third.
