

One point shy

Maple Leafs edged out by Silver Streaks

The Maple Leaf track team hosted the Galesburg Silver Streaks and the Rock Island Alleman Pioneers Thursday, April 13.

Galesburg edged Geneseo by just one point, 85 to 84 while Alleman finished a distant third with seven points.

The Leafs were powered by nine first-place finishes in the meet.

"Despite having a break in the schedule, we had some really good performances out of the kids," Coach Mel Snook commented. "If we can get the weather to cooperate, we'll do pretty good."

Mike Poppen swept the throwing events, winning the shot put with a toss of 51'3-1/2" and the discus with a 123'6".

Phil Gradert won the high jump, clearing the bar at an even 6', four inches higher than the second-place jumper.

The 3200 meter relay team of Josh Inch, Adam Forest, Chris Farmer and Jeremy Michels won in 8:46.21.

In the 3200 meter run, Mike Hanson edged a Galesburg runner by one-and-a-half seconds with a time of 10:30.8.

"We got a really good race from Mike," said Coach Snook.

Jon Esche took the 110 meter high hurdles with a time of 17.08 seconds while Jeremy Michels broke the tape in the 800 meter run in 2:09.27.

Jeff Causemaker raced to a win in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles with a time of 43.93 seconds.

Inch won the 1600 meter run, crossing the line in 4:52.70, five seconds ahead of second-place.

Causemaker was second in the triple jump with a mark of 41'1-1/2". Matt Wilson was second in the 200 meter dash in 23.57 seconds.

Jeff Michels took second in the 100 meter dash in 11.49 seconds and in the 400 meter dash in 52.95 seconds.

The 400 meter relay team of Clay Hanson, Wilson, Brian Krantz and Jeff Michels placed second with a time of 45.41 seconds, three-tenths of a second off of first.

The 800 meter relay team of Clay Hanson, Wilson, Krantz and Bob Bowling was second in 1:38.34.

Also second was the 1600 meter relay team of Chris Farmer, Adam Forest, Adam Hines and Jeremy Michels in 3:57.43.

Bowling was second in the shot put with a throw of 48'1/2" and third in the discus with a 116'2" toss.

Troy Boelens was third in the high

jump, clearing 5'6" and Hines took third in the long jump with a mark of 18'1-1/2".

Jon Esche was third in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles with a time of 47.03 seconds.

Jeff Michels took third in the 200 meter dash with a time of 23.61 seconds.

Jeremy Brown was fourth in the 3200 meter run with a time of 12:00.17 while Farmer was fourth in the 800 meter run in 2:14.74.

Boelens placed fourth in the long jump with an 18'1" mark and Burton Wilcox was fourth in the discus with a throw of 110'10". Jon Esche also took fourth in the high jump, clearing 5'4".

"Overall, the kids are competing well," Coach Snook replied.

The frosh-soph squad raced past both Galesburg and Alleman. The Leaflets had 85 points followed by Alleman with 60 and Galesburg with 25.

"The frosh did well," said Coach Snook. "They're looking good. They have a shot at the frosh-soph conference championship."

Steve Schaaf won three individual events. He won the long jump with an 18'10" jump, the 100 meter dash in 11.73 seconds and the 200 meter dash in 24.77 seconds.

Andy Esche won the triple jump with a 35'2-1/2" jump.

Chad Frank won the high jump, clearing 5' even. Nick Henthorn won the pole vault, clearing 8' even.

Corbin Shipp won the discus and the

shot put with tosses of 117'9" and 42'9", respectively.

The 400 meter relay team of Del Lamont, Schaaf, Frank and Ben Forest raced to a win in 47.57 seconds.

The 1600 meter relay team of Doug Patchin, Ben Forest, Frank and Bjorn Myhre also won in 3:59.39.

Ben Forest won the 400 meter run in 58.90 seconds with Patchin taking second in 59.30 seconds.

The 800 meter relay team of Nick Henthorn, Nick DePauw, Andy Esche and Lamont won in 1:47.22.

Frank was second in the long jump with an 18'5" mark and Lamont was second in the 200 meter dash in 25.67 seconds.

The 3200 meter relay team of Myhre, John Kiss, Ryan Mielke and Jason Gray placed second with a time of 9:40.75.

Gray also took second in the 1600 meter run with a time of 5:30.

Tom Anderson was third in the triple jump with a 32'6" mark. Kiss placed third in the 800 meter run with a time of 2:26.15.

Andy Esche took third in the 110 meter high hurdles in 18.29 seconds and in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles in 50.26 seconds.

In fourth place was Adam Anderson in the 3200 meter run in 11:58.53 and the 1600 meter run in 5:45.05.

Lance Hackwith also was fourth in the triple jump with a 32'5" mark and the discus with a 96'7" throw.

Mielke placed fifth in the 800 meter run in 2:27.90. Nick DePauw placed fourth in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles with a time of 53.27 seconds and Alan Sikerkia placed fifth in the discus with a toss of 95'11".
