

Leafs runner up

Geneseo second behind Kewanee in quadrangular

The Maple Leaf track and field team hosted Kewanee, LaSalle-Peru and Princeton in a quadrangular meet Tuesday afternoon, April 18.

"It was cold and windy," commented Coach Mel Snook.

Kewanee ran away with the win with 101 points while Geneseo was second with 72. Princeton finished third with 58 and L.P. fourth with 47 points.

"We knew Kewanee was going to be tough," Coach Snook said. "They've got speed, good relays and some tough distance people."

Two Geneseo runners and a relay team were the only first place finishes for the Leafs.

Jeff Causemaker broke the tape in the 110 meter high hurdles in 15.25 seconds while Jeremy Michels won the 800 meter run in 2:08.24.

The 3200 meter relay team of Josh Inch, Mike Hanson, Chris Farmer and Jeremy Michels won in 8:48.

The 400 meter relay team of Clay Hanson, Matt Wilson, Brian Krantz and Jeff Michels was second in 45.74 seconds.

Also second was the 800 meter relay team in 1:38.74. They were Clay Hanson, Wilson, Krantz and Adam Hines.

Mike Poppen took second in the shot put with a throw of 51'5-1/2" while Bob Bowling was third with a 46'9-1/2" toss. Bowling was also second in the discus with a toss of 132'8".

Wilson finished second in the 100 meter dash in 11.69 seconds, followed closely by Jeff Michels in third with a time of 11.70 seconds.

Jeff Michels placed second in the 200 meter dash, crossing the line in 24.48 seconds while Krantz was third in 25.50 seconds. Krantz was also third in the long jump with a mark of 19'4".

Jeff Michels placed third in the 40 meter dash in 54.68 seconds while Jon Esche was third in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles in 46.38 seconds.

Inch came in third in the 1600 meter run in 4:56.91. Causemaker was third in the triple jump, making a mark at 39'4".

David Cryder had the lone fourth place finish for the Leafs in the 3200 meter run in 11:45.39 while Chris Brown was fifth in 12:06.

Hines took fifth in the long jump with an 18'2" jump. Poppen was fifth in the discus with a throw of 116'5" and Phil Gradert was fifth in the high jump, clearing the bar at 5'8".

"We're starting to get an idea on how the conference is going to shape up," replied Coach Snook. "Kewanee is definitely going to be a threat."

"There are still some places we are still searching and hunting to fill in."

The frosh-soph squad ran away with the win over the three other teams with 127 points. L.P. was second with 85 followed by Princeton with 32 and Kewanee with 21 points.

"The frosh-soph dominated, and I'm happy with that," said Coach Snook. "They have a shot at the conference championship."

Both the 3200 meter and 400 meter relay teams took first.

The 3200 team of Bjorn Myhre, John Kiss, Ryan Mielke and Adam Forest won in 9:48.27 while the 400 team of Ben Forest, Steve Schaaf, Chad Frank and Del Lamont won in 47.67 seconds.

Andy Esche picked up two first place finishes for himself in the 110 meter high and 300 meter intermediate hurdles. He won the 110 in 18.95 seconds and the 300 in 50.16 seconds.

Also picking up two firsts was Corbin Shipp in the two throwing events. He tossed the discus 111'1" and the shot put 19'8".

Schaaf picked up another first place to go with his first in the relay with a

win in the long jump with a 19'8" mark.

Myhre also added to his relay win with a win in the 800 meter run in 2:27.36 as did Adam Forest in the 1600 meter run in 5:17.59.

Also placing first was Jason Gray, breaking the tape in the 3200 meter run with a time of 11:45.06.

Schaaf took second in two events, the 100 and 200 meter dashes with times of 12.31 and 25.66 seconds, respectively.

Tom Anderson placed second twice, in the 3200 meter run and the 1600 meter run. He finished the 3200 in 11:55.18.

Kiss took second in the 800 meter run, finishing in 2:28.52 and Ben Forest was second in the 400 meter run in 58.22 seconds.

The 800 meter relay team of Kyle Misfeldt, Matt Fuelling, Nick Henthorn and Nick DePauw in 1:46.96.

Adam Forest was third in the 100 meter dash in 12.38 seconds and Mielke was third in the 800 meter run in 2:31.45.

Doug Patchin placed third in the 400 meter run in 58.85 seconds and DePauw placed third in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles in 53.52 seconds.

Gray placed third in the 1600 meter run with a time of 5:39.6 and Lamont was third in the 200 meter dash in 26.42 seconds.

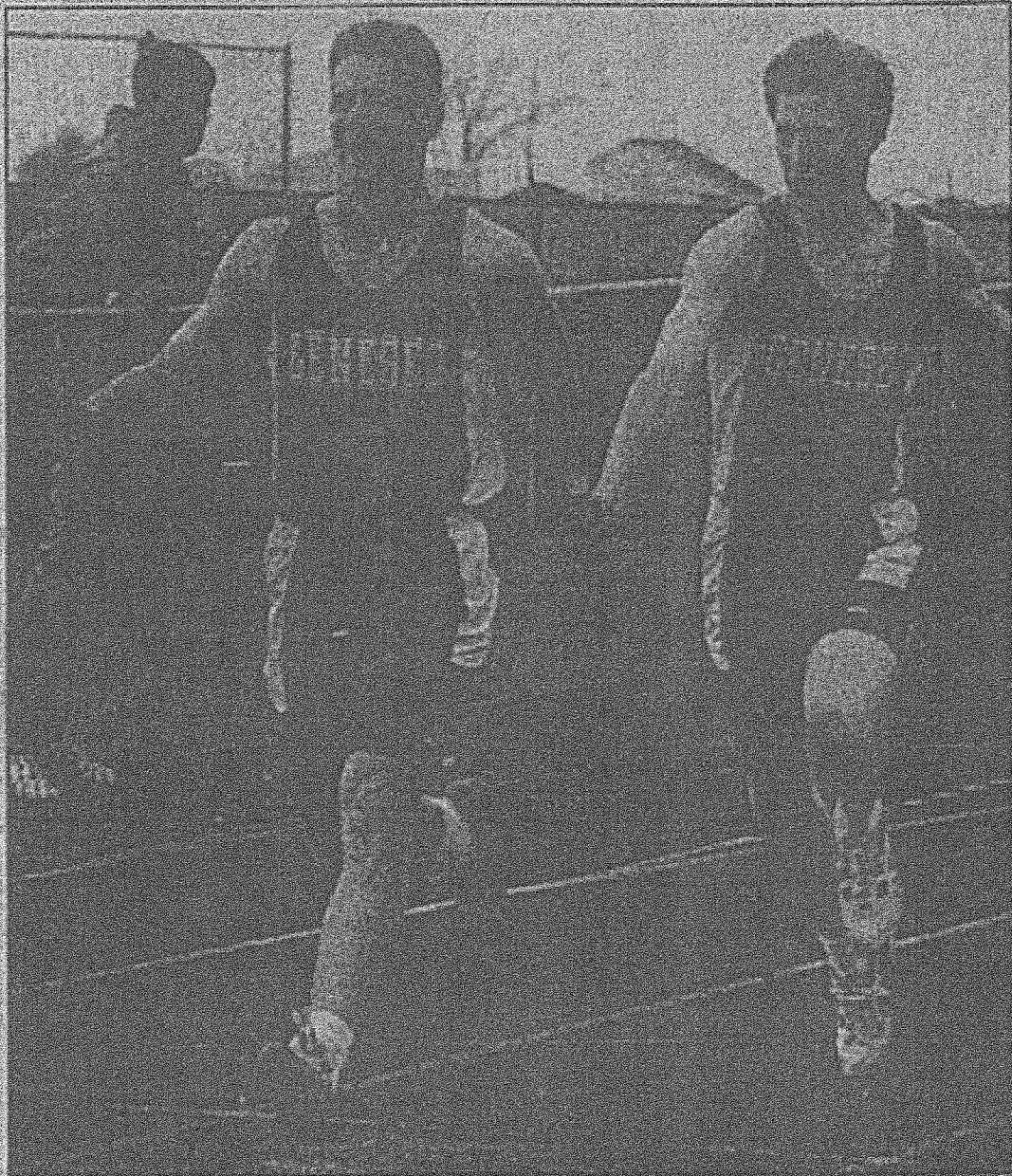
Mike Nicholas took third in the triple jump with a 34'5" mark and Frank was third in the long jump, leaping 17'11". Alan Sikarskie was third also in the discus with a 104'6" throw.

The 1600 meter relay team of Myhre, Patchin, Ben Forest and Frank was third in 4:13.98.

Andy Esche took fourth in the triple jump with a 33'6-1/2" mark and the high jump, clearing 5'2" while Henthorn was fourth in the pole vault, clearing 8' even.

Fifth place finishes came from Anderson in the triple jump with a 32'5", Nicholas in the long jump with a 17'2" jump and Frank in the high jump.

"There has been no way for us to get a look at these kids," Coach Snook said. "Unless we run some exhibition races during these meets, we aren't going to know. We're running out of time."
