Running for first

Relays give Leafs win in triangular

The boy's track team was paced by 11 first place finishes at Geneseo Stadium Tuesday, April 2 routing Princeton and Sherrard with 90 points.

Princeton finished second with 57 and Sherrard placed last at 31 points.

The Maple Leafs took first in three relay events and placed second in the 400 meter relay.

Ben Forest, Adam Forest, Dave Clementz and Doug Patchin ran the 3200 relay in 9:08.69. Geneseo recorded a 3:44.82 time in the 1600 meter relay on the legs of Jonathan Esche, Patchin, Mike Kanke and Ben Forest.

In the 800 relay, Chad Frank, Zach Pierce, Troy Collins and Del Lamont sprinted to a 1:38.70 first place time.

Bob Bowling grabbed a few top individual spots with a 46'9-3/4" toss in the shot put and a 138.3 launching in discus.

Burton Wilcox placed third in the discus on a 123.1' throw and Shawn

Walsh nabbed fourth in shot put with a 40.4' shot.

The Maple Leafs experienced success in the hurdles with J. Esche and Andy Esche taking first and second spots in the 110 meter high hurdles.

J. Esche ran them in 15.42 seconds and A. Esche followed behind at 17 flat. Nathan Price ran second in the 300 meter low hurdles at a 45.45 tick.

Heath Verstraete soared 5'10" for first in the high jump with teammate Frank finishing second at 5'8".

In the long jump, Frank jumped 18'7-1/2" for third but Steve Schaaf took second on a 19'4-1/2" leap.

Schaaf grabbed one of Geneseo's two sprint wins in the 200 meter dash, timed at 24.75. And close behind was Lamont at 24.87 seconds.

The other win came in the 400 on Justin Buechler's time of 56.22.

B. Forest stole the 800 meter run at a 2:06.23 mark, just one-half second ahead of second place.

The Leafs had no problems with the 1600 meter run, taking the top three positions.

Justin Fluck finished first at 4:55.74, A. Forest recorded a 5:02.06 time and in third was Clementz at 5:22.91.

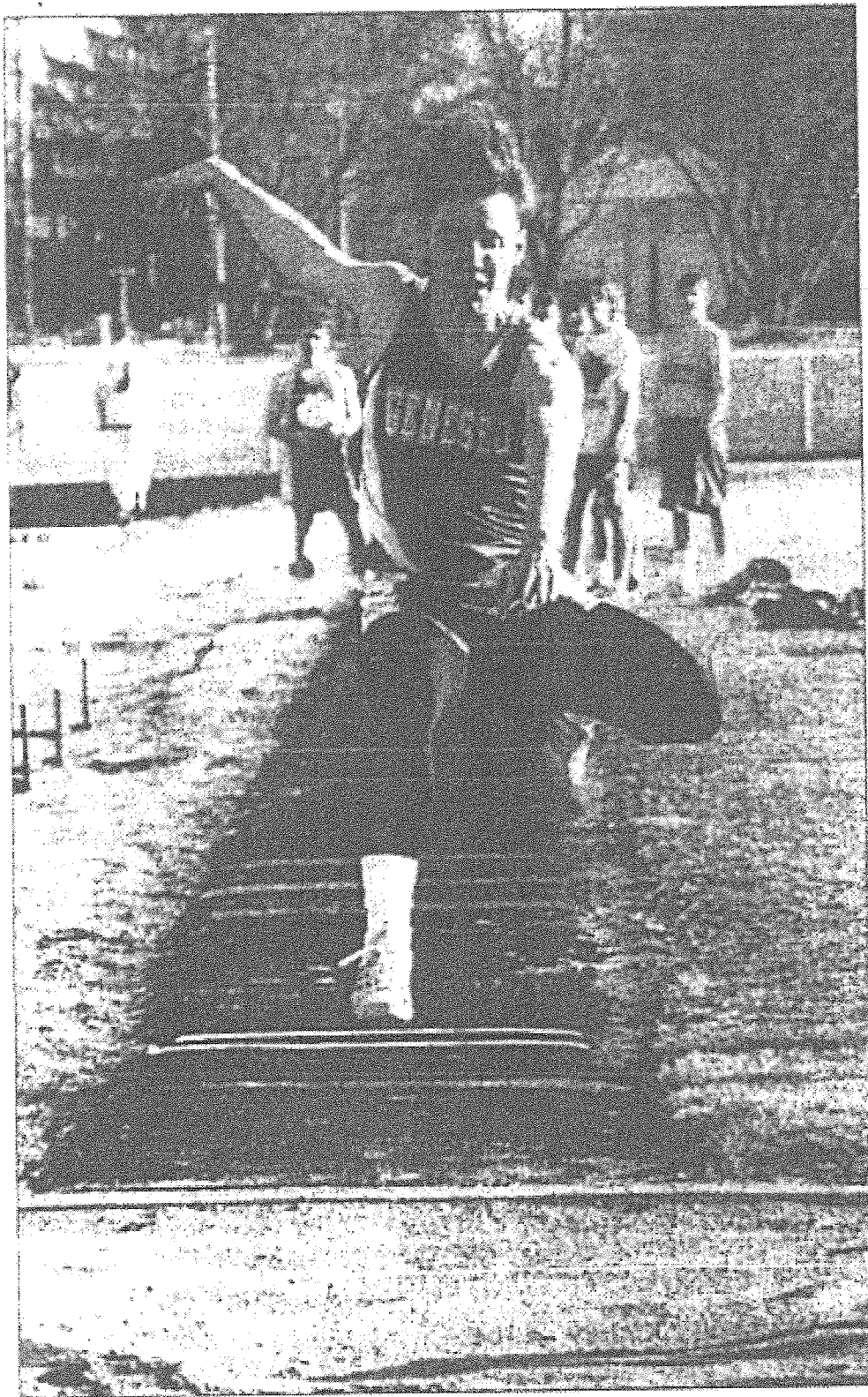
The long distance running of David Cryder in the 3200 meter run managed a 11:30.30-second place finish.

Geneseo's frosh/soph team took first with nine top place finishes and 82 team points followed by Princeton's 69 points and Sherrard's 18.

Freshman Mark Keplinger picked up two individual wins in the 800 and 1600 meter runs. Keplinger ran the 800 in 2:09.39 and the 1600 in 5:07.58.

Matt Fuelling took first in the 200 meter dash with a 25.25 sprint and Bart Vandersnick edged out the 400 win at 57.05.

Other gold medal winners were Nick Henthorn on a 10' pole vault mark, Tom Anderson's 34'10" triple jump leap and Jason Gray grabbed the first in the 3200 meter run with a time of 11:08.41.

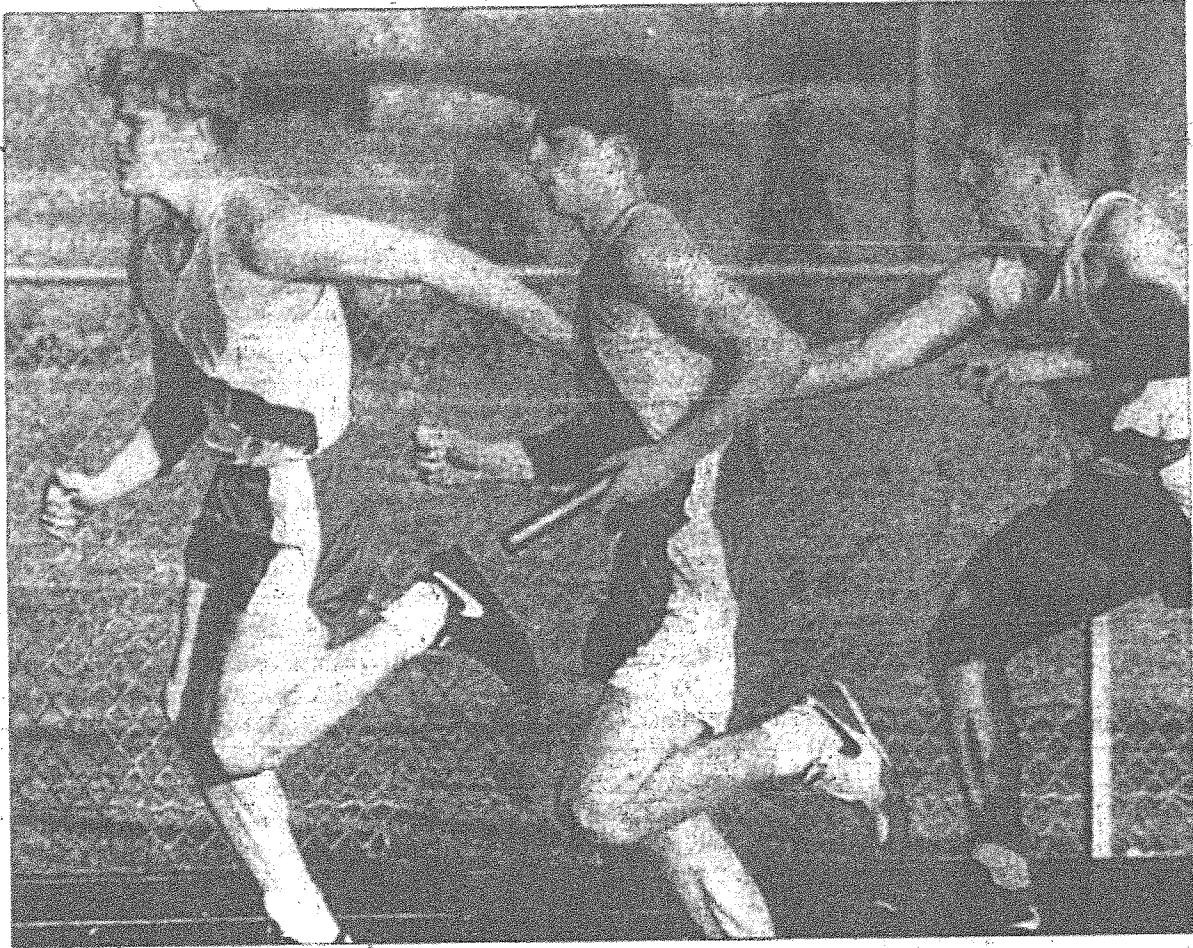

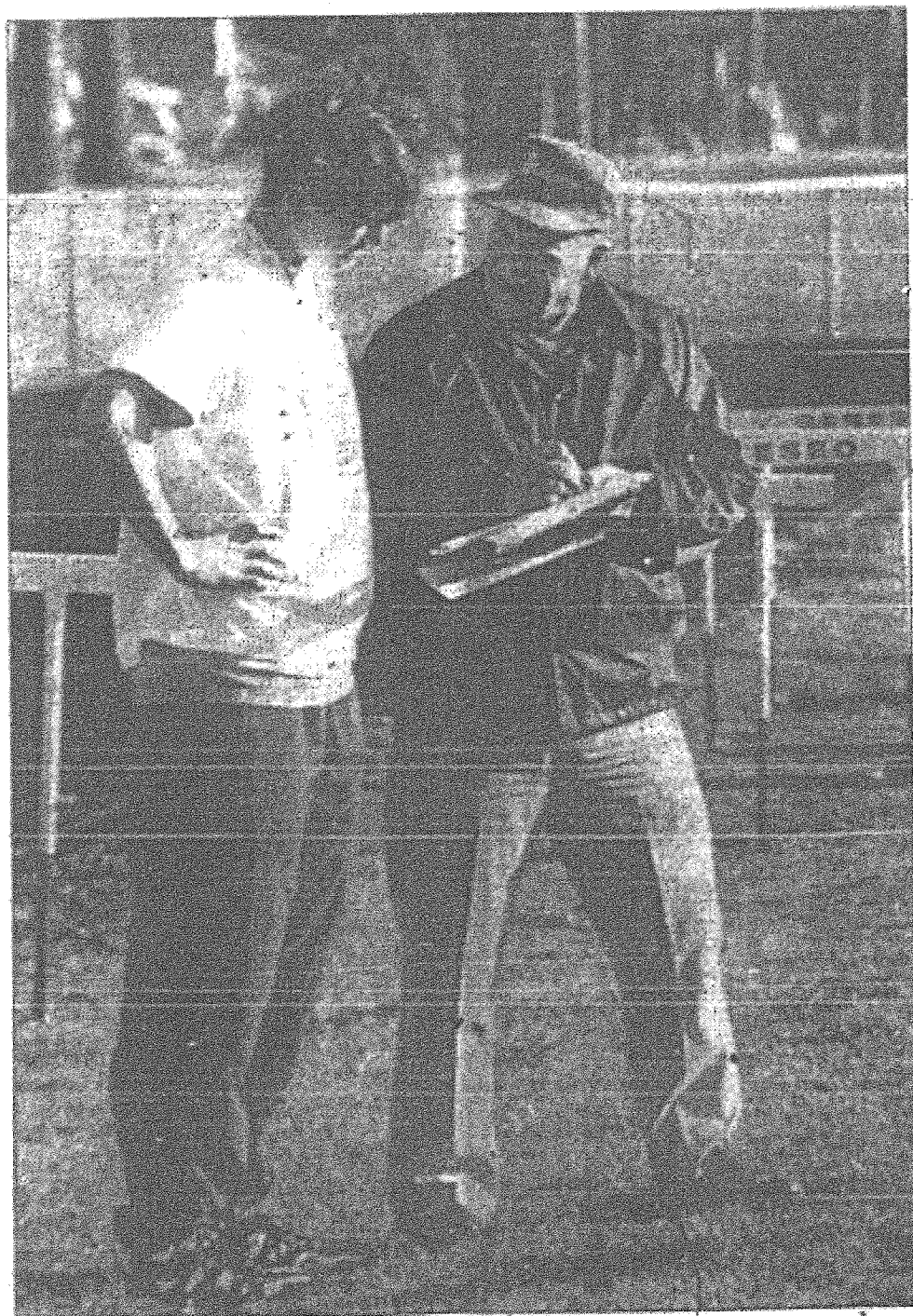

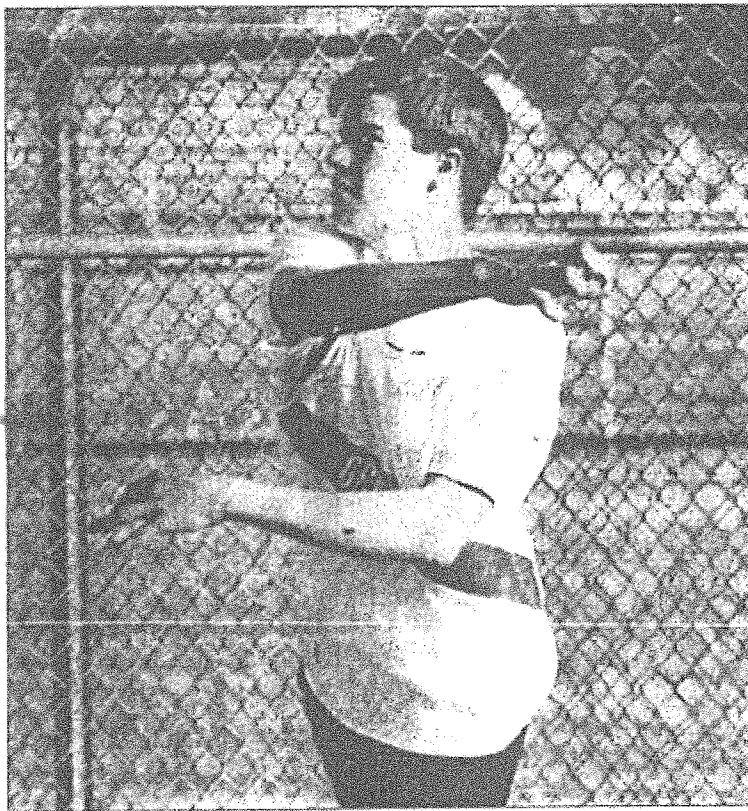
