Snow doesn't stop indoor meet in Sterling for Leafs

Despite the fact it was snowing outside, the Maple Leaf track team still had their meet at Sterling on Tuesday, March 19. Luckily for the Leafs, it was held indoors at Westwood so they would not have to brave the cold outside.

Geneseo faced Sterling, Freeport and Rockton Hononegah in the quadrangular meet.

The Leafs came away with only one first as they placed third with 41-1/2 points behind runaway winner Sterling with 99-1/2 and Hononegah with 69. Freeport was a distant fourth with 29 points.

"Sterling is always ahead of us at this time of the season with their indoor facility," said Coach Mel Snook. "We will be closer later in the season.

"We had a lot of illnesses and kids sick. Some weren't there while others did not perform as well as they would have."

Jon Esche was the only first place finisher for Geneseo, winning the 55 meter low hurdles in 7.91 seconds.

"Jon did an excellent job, winning both of his high hurdle races the last week against very tough competition," remarked Coach Snook.

Steve Schaaf came home with a pair of seconds for the Leafs. He finished behind two-time conference sprint champ Doug Densmore in both the 55 meter dash (6.64 seconds) and the 200 meter dash (24.43 seconds). Densmore's times were 6.51 and 23.3 seconds, respectively.

The 800 meter relay team of Schaaf, Bart Reed, Chad Frank and Del Lamont was third with a time of 1:42.98 while the 1600 meter relay team of Mike Kanke, Zach Pierce, Doug Patchin and Nathan Price were third in 3:55.75.

Adam Forest was third in the 3200 meter run in 10:44 and Schaaf took third in the long jump with a leap of 19'1-3/4".

Ben Forest was third in the 800 meter run in 2:13.68 and Esche was third in the 55 meter low hurdles with a time of 7.67 seconds. Bob Bowling took third in the shot put with a heave of 44'3".

Andy Esche brought home a fourth place in the 55 high hurdles in 9.1 seconds. Patchin was fourth in the 400 meter dash in 57.23 seconds.

Adam Forest took fourth in the 1600 meter run with a time of 5:15.55 and Justin Buechler was, fourth in the 200 in 25.07 seconds.

David Cryder took fifth in the 3200 with a time of 11:27. Frank was fifth in the long jump with a mark of 18'7-1/4".

Andy Esche placed fifth in the 55 low hurdles in 8.32 seconds and the triple jump with a mark of 36'11-1/2".

In frosh-soph action, the Leaflets won the meet with 76 points, edging out Sterling with 68 and Hononegah with 66. Freeport was fourth with 29.

"Our frosh-soph kids won a very strong meet," said Coach Snook. "Sterling is loaded there, also, and the kids did a nice job.

"Without our jumping some kids up to the varsity level, and with the showing of the frosh-soph group last year, we're getting there. These kids are our future."

Justin Fluck had a pair of wins in the 3200 (10:36.2) and the 1600 (5:04.13),

Mike Dumolien also had two first in the 55 in 6.87 seconds and the 200 in 24.49 seconds. David Whisker took the 800 with a time of 2:19.74

The 3200 relay team of Bjorn Myhre, Mark Keplinger, Bill Curnyn and Chris Studer won in 9:14.72.

Jason Gray was second in the 3200 in 11:16 while Keplinger was second in the 800 in 2:19.99. Tom Anderson was second in the triple jump with a mark of 34'1-1/2".

The 1600 meter relay team of Myhre, Brendan O'Rourke, Keplinger and Bart VanDerSnick were second in 4:00.16.

In third place was O'Rourke in the 400 in 57.95 seconds, Whisker in the high jump, clearing 5'4", J.J. Hazelett in the 55 low hurdles in 9.02 seconds and Studer in the 1600 in 5:10.81.

Fourth places went to Whisker in the long jump at 16'11-1/2" and the 1600 in 5:14.33, VanDerSnick in the 400 in 58.78, Nick Henthorn in the 55 low hurdles in 9.44 seconds and Matt Fuelling in the 200 in 25.8 seconds.

Josh Stohl was fifth in the high jump, clearing 5'2" while Gray was fifth in the 1600 in 5:23.09.

The Leafs have their first outdoor meet slated for Tuesday, March 26 against United Township and Orion at Soule Bowl in East Moline at 4:30 p.m.
