J. McCormick annual meet set for May 10

Formers track and field teams are slated to participate in the John McCormick Invitational Saturday. May 10 at the J. D. Darnall High School oval. Field eyents will begin at 5 p.m. while the running events are slated to start at 5:30 p.m.

Schools expected to field athletes in addition to Geneseo are Canton, Dixon, Peoria Richwoods, Galesburg, Hall, Kewanee, LaSalle-Peru, Metamora, Ottawa, Princeton, Rochelle, Rock Falls and Rock Island Alleman.

Richwoods won last year's event, tallying 101 points to overpower the rest of the field. Ottawa took second with 69 followed by Metamora, 54.5; Dixon, 48; Galesburg, 42; LaSalle-Peru, 34 and Genesco, 33.

The sole gold for Geneseo came from Bob Bowling in the discus event. His 154'5" throw was almost three feet farther than his competitors. Ben Forest also placed within the top three finishers in his event, taking second in the 800 run in 2:02.84.

Three records were set at last year's McCormick invite. Seth Langley of Ottawa set the 100-meter dash at 10.70; Jason Abbot of Kewanee re-established the 800-meter run mark at 1:56.77 and the 400-meter varsity relay team from Galesburg, with members Derek Cropp, Brence Turner, Rich Johnson and Mike Hunigan, set a record of 43.37.

Other records up for grabs this year are the 200-meter dash, set in 1979 by Ted Nehrkorn of Rock Falls at 22.1; 400-meter dash, set by Ben Hahn of Geneseo in 1992 at 50.10; 1600-meter run, set in 1992 by John Weigel of Metamore, 4:20.06; 3200-meter run, set by Tim Broe of East Peoria in 1994 at 9:08.69; 300 intermediate hurdles, which was set by Phil Hilton of Ottawa in 1994 at 39.23 and the 110 high hurdles, currently held by Tony Smith of Galesburg and set in 1985 at 14.2.

East Moline currently holds the 800-meter relay record of 1:30.79 set in 1987. Members of the team were Robert Taylor, Mike Barnett, Chris Palmer and Brad McCorkle. An East Moline contingent of Mitch Smith, Terry Toliver, Jason Branch and Brad McCorkle holds the 1600-meter relay record, also set in 1987, with a time of 3:25.03.



Ottawa edges Metamora for McCormick title

Justin Young of Dixon cleared 68-1/4" in the 1997 John McCormick Invitational Friday, May. 9 to set a new high jump record. The former record was of 6'8" was set in 1994 by Phil Hilton of Ottawa.

Ottawa won this year's event, scoring 70 points to edge out Metamora which claimed second with 69.

Fourteen schools fielded athletes at the annual invite. Canton took third with 60 points; Peoria Richwoods, 54; Rochelle, 52; Dixon, 47; Galesburg, 45; Kewanee, 44; Rock Falls, 43 and Geneseo, 28. The remaining teams were Princeton (25), LaSalle-Peru (12), Spring Valley Hall (8) and Rock Island Alleman.

Ben Forest collected the only win for the Leafs in a come-from-behind finish in the 800 run.

Chris Studer was the only other individual finisher for Genesco, taking second in the 3200 run and sixth in the 1600. The Leafs 3200-meter and the 800-meter relay teams tallied fourths for the team standings.

Under windy and cold-weather conditions, B. Forest covered the 800-meter run in 2:05.25 for the win. Al Thompson of Rochelle placed second in 2:05.76. It was close quarters in the third and fourth-place slots as well. Josh Bird of Kewanee was third in 2:06.53 while Nate Rucker of Rock Falls was fourth in 2:06.64.

Studer carned a silver for the Leafs with a 10:06.15 time in the 3200-meter run. Justin Young of Richwoods took the tape in 9:50.11. Two Metamora runners placed third and fourth, Scan Morrison clocking in at 10:18.16 and Paul Hoppe at

10:22.88.

B. Forest was joined by Mark Keplinger, Dave Whisker and Adam Forest in the 3200 relay and finished in fourth with a time of 8:42.52. Metamora claimed the win in 8:29.07 with Kewanes in second, 8:31.86 and Ottawa, third, 8:39.26.

Matt Fueling, Ryan Scherer, Steve Schaaf and Jason Marquis finished the 800-meter relay in 1:38.31 for a fourth-place finish to edge out Kewanee which took fifth in 1:38.39. Galesburg won the event in 1:33.92 followed by Metamora, 1:36.51 and Rochelle, 1:37.71.


Genesee athletes also combined efforts for the fourth in the Big Boy Relay for weightmen. Gabe Possin, Jeff Bowling, Corbin Shipp and Marshall Freeman finished in 52.03 for fourth. A Dixon foursome won in \$48.03 while Ottawa was second, 49.93; Rock Falls, third, 51.30 and Hall, fifth, 55.81.

Nick DePauw came through with a sixth in the 100-meter high hurdles for the Leafs. DePauw covered the course in 16.36; Jaymie Gunderson of Metamora won at 15.23. Other finishers in the event were Seth Frey, Rock Falls, 15.53; Nate Beal, Canton, 15.60; Giacobaz Yanez, Canton, 15.66 and Mark Niemuth, Princeton, 15.95.

Studer also claimed a sixth spot for Geneseo, covering the 1600-meter run in 4:39.34. It was a tight finish for Richwoods' Justin Young as he took the tape in 4:28.46 just ahead of Garey Driscoll of Metamora, 4;28.48. Bond of Ottawa was third at 4:33.89 while Joel Bourque of Kewanee finished in fourth at 4:35.02 and Kevin Hodel of Metamora in fifth at 4:37.61.




