

Battling conditions

Three silvers boost Leafs to 11th place

Geneseo's varsity boys track team not only had weather conditions to battle but 15 other teams as the Leaf cindermen took part in the Moline Gene Shipley invitational at Brown-ing Field Saturday, April 5.

The Leafs finished 11th overall with 71 points. Rock Island took the meet with 220 points followed by Waubonsie Valley (183), United Township (143.5), Moline (133.5), Bettendorf (109), Rockford Guilford (89), Davenport North (79), Ottawa (78) and Davenport Central and East Peoria. (76 each).

Other teams fielding events were Princeton (65), Rockford Auburn (44), Sherrard (18), Davenport Assumption (13) and Alleman (5).

Each event was divided into three flights, A, B and C. The highest place finishes for Geneseo were three second places, one by Mark Keplinger, another by Marshall Freeman and one by Adam Forest.

Forest earned second in the C flight 800-meter run with a time of 2:06.0 behind a Rock Island runner who won the event in 2:04.9. Keplinger took second in the 1600 run within Flight C with the time of 4:55.58. The winning time for the event was 4:49.3, recorded by a Moline athlete.

In Flight B competition, Keplinger

earned fifth place in the 800 run with a time of 2:08.7; winning time was 2:05.6.

Ben Forest competed in the same event within Flight A, earning fourth place with a time of 2:07.6; the top runner finished in 2:01.4.

Freeman earned his silver medal within Flight C discus competition. The Leaf sent the discus 115'3-1/2" behind the first place effort of 117'.

Andy Henry received a bronze medal for pole vaulting in Flight C. Henry cleared the bar at 9', three feet behind the top effort of 12'.

Jeff Bowling earned a fourth place in Flight B shot put. He hurled the shot 42'1-1/2" while the winning effort was 45'5-1/4". Also competing in the shot put event were Corbin Shipp and Gabe Possin. Shipp finished fifth within Flight A with a distance of 45'6" (51'10-1/2" won the event) and Possin also earned a fifth but within Flight C with his toss of 39'11-1/2". The winning effort was 45'6-1/2".

Lance Hackwith also participated in Flight B competition, within the discus event. He hit the 113' mark in the event while the first place effort was recorded at 136'2-1/2". Neil Russell earned a fifth for Geneseo in the high jump of Flight A, clearing 5'8" behind a first-place leap of 6'3".

Chris Studer and Nick DePauw also competed within Flight A. Studer took the 3200-meter run in 10:14.7 for a sixth place finish (winning time was 9:43.3) while DePauw earned fifth in the 300 intermediate

hurdles with a time of 44.71(41.52 won the event).

Leaf runners took part in the other two flights in each of these events as well. Gray took fifth in Flight B of the 3200 with a time of 10:19.7 while Andy Beuster covered the track in 10:44.2 for fifth place in Flight C. The winning time in the B flight was 10:02.4 while 10:15.7 took the gold in Flight C.

Andy Esche earned fifth with a time of 46.15 in the intermediate hurdles for Flight B while Corey Parrish took fifth in the C flight with a time of 46.90. Winning time in Flight B was 44.35 and 43.05 took the win in Flight C.

Two Leafs placed within the top six in the 110 high hurdles. DePauw clocked a 17.43 in Flight B while Seth Hanson covered the Flight C with a time of 18.70. Winning efforts were 16.28 and 16.40, respectively.

Jason Marquis and Studer finished within the top six places for the Leafs. Studer earned sixth in the 1600 run in Flight B and Marquis was sixth in the 200-meter dash in Flight C.

Another fifth place was claimed by the 1600-meter relay team of Ben Forest, Brendan O'Rourke, Grant Venema and Bill Curnyn. The squad covered the course in 3:57.43 behind a winning time of 3:34.10.

The Leafs will travel to the Soule Bowl in East Moline for the annual United Township Invitational on Saturday, April 12. The next home competition will be a triangular on Thursday, April 17 with Galesburg and Alleman beginning at 4:30 p.m.
