Leafs to host first home meet Tuesday, April 1

Geneseo varsity track squad returned to the Westwood indoor track facility, Sterling, Tuesday, March 25 to compete against Freeport, Sterling and Hononegah. Unfortunately, the Leafs traveled home with a fourth-place finish, tallying just 38 team points.

A bright point in the quadrangular was three gold medals earned in three events for the Leafs.

Adam Forest, Doug Patchin, Adam Anderson and Ben Forest teamed for the 3200-meter race, taking first with a time of 8:52.19. Hononegah claimed second in 8:55.18.

Jason Gray took the tape in the 3200-meter run, finishing the race in 10:35.24.

The third gold came from Ben Forest in the 800 run. Forest cleared the track in 2:11.05 with Trent of Sterling in second in 2:12.87.

The lone silver for the Leafs came

from Andy Esche in the 55-meter low hurdles. Nick DePauw also finished in the hurdles, taking fourth behind his teammate and earning the only bronze position for Geneseo.

Fourth place finishes were earned by Gray in the 1600-meter run; Corbin Shipp, shot put; Steve Schaaf, long jump; Ryan Scherer, high jump and Esche, 55-meter high hurdles.

The 800-meter relay of Schaaf, DePauw, Nick Henthorn and Matt Fuelling and the 1600 relay team of Fuelling, Tom Anderson, Patchin and DePauw also earned fourth places.

DePauw took fifth in the high hurdles; Fuelling in the 55-meter dash and Adam Anderson in the 1600 run.

Sterling took the meet with 91 team points followed by Hononegah with 61, Freeport with 54 and Geneseo with 38 points.

The boys track teams will host Princeton and Sherrard at 4:30 p.m. Tuesday, April 1 for the first home meet of the season.

Hot cinders

Frosh/soph tracksters win big over field

Dominating 11 of the 16 events, Geneseo's frosh-soph track team took first place in a quadrangular with Freeport, Sterling and Hononegah. The victory came Tuesday afternoon, March 25 at the Westwood indoor track near Sterling.

Geneseo claimed the first four of five slots in the 1600-meter run with Mark Keplinger taking first in 5:02.53. Second went to Andy Beuster, 5:11.56; third was earned by Will McCombs, 5:19.87 and Joel Madsen, came in fourth in 5:23.90.

In several events, Leafrosh cinder-men took the first two slots. Jason Marquis took the 200 in 25.10 followed by teammate George Ofslager with a time of 26.48. Jeff Bowling threw the shot put 41'9" for first with Gabe Possin taking second with a toss of 40'9-1/2". Leafroshs Jake VerStrate and Marshall Freeman claimed fourth and fifth in the event.

Marquis and Ofslager also teamed up on the competition in the 55-meter event. Marquis again took the tape, covering the track in 6.92 followed by Ofslager in 7.01.

Corey Parrish cleared the 55-meter

high hurdles in 10.28 for first place while his teammate, Brendan O'Rourke took third with a time of 10.77.

Also earning first-place finishes were O'Rourke in the 400-meter run, 1:00.94; Beuster, 3200-meter run, 10:45.42 and all three relay teams.

The 3200-meter relay of Dave Whisker, Dave Bopp, Madsen and Keplinger covered the track in 9:32.21; the 800-meter relay of Ofslager, Aaron Anderson, Grant Venema and Marquis took the tape in 1:44.18 while the 1600 relay won in 4:02.82 with members Bopp, Venema, Whisker and O'Rourke.

O'Rourke took fourth in the triple jump; Parrish in the 55 low hurdles; Bopp in the 800 run and Bobby Ristau in the 3200-meter run. Parrish cleared the high jump at 5'2" for fourth place but his height tied two Hononegah jumpers. The winning height of 5'4" was also made by a Hononegah athlete.

Aaron Anderson finished behind O'Rourke in the triple jump. The only two events Geneseo did not place in were the long jump and pole vault.

As a team, Geneseo tallied 104 points. The closest competitor was Hononegah with 58 points followed by Sterling with 41.5 and Freeport with 34.
