Leaflets earn fourth at UT JV invitational

Geneseo's Junior Varsity track team placed fourth in the United Township High School JV Invitational Tuesday, May 6.

Rock Island won the meet with 148 points followed by UT, second, 111; Moline, third, 102 and Geneseo, fourth, 80. Other teams competing were Galesburg, 47 points; Westmer, 30; Cambridge, 22 and Rock Island Alleman, 0.

The Leaflets scored their points by earning second, third and fourth place finishes. There were no Geneseo athletes in the number one slots.

Leaflets earned five individual second-place finishes in the meet. Bobby Ristau earned second in the 3200-meter run with a time of 10:55.6; 10:54.2 was the winning time. Adam Anderson's time of 2:16.7 was good enough for second place in the 800 behind the winning time of 2:05.6.

Jake Verstraete took second in the shot; Ryan Scherz took the silver in the high jump and Marshall Freeman threw the discus for a second-place effort.

Andy Esche earned a bronze for the Leaflets, taking third in the 300 intermediate hurdles. The 3200 relay and the 800 relay also clocked in for third place. Andy Beuster, Joel Madsen, Dave Bopp and Jon Lake combined for a 3200 time of 9:15.7; the winning time was 8:51.5.

George Ofslager, Kyle Misfeldt, Scott Lambin and Shannon White finished the 800 relay in 1:39.9 for third; 1:37.4 won the event.

Geneseo's 400-meter relay team came in fourth as did the 1600 relay. Members of the 400, Ofslager, Misfeldt, Lambin and Scherer, finished in 47.9. Westmer also clocked a 47.9 but claimed third place; 47.0 won the event for UT.

Bill Curnya, Bjorn Myhra, Brendan O'Rourke and Hopp clocked in at 3:54.8 for fourth in the 1600 relay; 3:42.9 won.

Seth Hanson also earned a fourth for the Leaflets, placing in the 110 high hurdles.

Neil Russell took fourth in the high jump and Esche tied for fifth in the triple jump to round out the Geneseo scoring.

The 1996-97 track season concludes with the John McCormick Invitational in Geneseo on Friday, May 9 and the Starting Fresh Invitational Monday, May 12.
