Leaflets take title, Leafs improve to third at NCIC meet

One individual and one relay title spearheaded the J. D. Darnall High School varsity boys track team to a third-place finish at the 1999 NCIC Boys Track Meet in Sterling Friday, May 14.

The Leaflets regained the conference title this year after a one-year hiatus.

Cory Parrish won the Leafs' lone individual crown, taking the 300 intermediate hurdles in 40.93 for the win. His closest competition came from Monk of Dixon in 41.22.

Dave Bopp, Andy Beuster, Will McCombs and Grant Venema took the 3200-meter relay in 8:12.34 for the second Geneseo crown. The Sterling contingent which took second finished in 8:18.25.

Last year's 3200-meter relay squad was the only first-place finisher for the Leafs with Venema being the common link between the two squads.

This year's squad improved on last year's team standings, taking third to Dixon (102 points) and Rochelle (97). Geneseo captured third overall with 67 points, seven points ahead of fourth-place Kewanee. In 1998, the Leafs tied for fifth with Rochelle with Sterling taking the crown.

In the frosh-soph division, Geneseo was guided by Mike Sunstrom and David Mattie who each claimed two titles within the NCIC competition. Derek Speller and Kyle Reade also earned individual titles.

Last year's squad finished second to Ottawa in the team standings with five titles, four individual and one relay. The top two teams in 1998 (Ottawa - 182 points and Geneseo - 123) were well ahead of the field as Rock Falls which finished third only had 48 points.

The 1999 team reclaims the team title for Geneseo. In 1997, the Leaflets took first behind five individual and one relay victories.

"I'm very, very pleased with how our guys performed at the NCIC meet. We're very happy," Coach Snook noted.

"Our frosh-soph was seeded number one and that proved to be true. The varsity was seeded fifth and bettered that with a third-place finish.

"We had some outstanding performances from our frosh-soph athletes," Coach Snook continued. "It looks good for the future with so many younger kids performing so strong. There were a lot with personal bests at this meet."

In addition to his first in the intermediate hurdles, Parrish was the top Leaf finisher in the 110 high hurdles, taking second in 15.15 behind Princeton's Niemuth at 15.12. Neil Russell also competed for Geneseo, claiming fourth with a time of 15.60.

Jeff Bowling, expected prior to the

competition to be a top contender for the Leafs, took second in the shot put. His distance of 51'8" fell between two Dixon athletes, Byrnes at 56'4" and Sheridan at 50'10".

Justin Fluck and Chris Studer wrapped up second and third for the Leafs in the varsity's 3200-meter run. Joel Bourque of Kewanee took the tape in 9:47.89 followed by Fluck, 9:52.94 and Studer, 9:53.85.

Chris Schwigen and Mark Kepplinger both finished within the top five of the 800-meter run. Schwigen finished in 2:02.22 while Kepplinger was clocked at 2:02.90. Inaya of Rochelle won the race in 2:00.47.

Fluck finished behind Bourque again in the 1600-meter run, taking fifth overall in 4:36.80 while the Kewanee runner took the tape in 4:23.35.

Geneseo's 1600-meter relay team also finished fifth in the competition. Bopp, Schwigen, McCombs and Venema combined efforts to finish in 3:35.05. Rochelle's foursome in 3:24.65.

A new record was set in the 400-meter run by Glynn of Hall who completed the sprint in 48.77 for the title.

Dave Bopp ran the course for Geneseo, taking sixth overall with a time of 51.63.

Another record set at the meet was the 200-meter dash again with Glynn holding the title. He covered the course in 21.56 for the win.

In addition to the 200 dash, Geneseo did not place finishers in the 100-meter dash, high jump, pole vault, 800-meter relay, discus, long jump, 400-meter relay or triple jump.

Other teams competing in the NCIC meet and their point standings include Hall, 51 points; Rock Falls, 46.5; Ottawa and Sterling, 46; Princeton, 27; Streator 26; Mendota, 5 and LaSalle-Peru, 4.5.

Frosh-Soph

Sunstrom took first in both the 110-meter high hurdle finals and the 300-intermediate hurdles as one of Geneseo's duo winners at the NCIC meet.

In the 110 finals, Sunstrom took the ribbon in 15.86 ahead of Duffield of Hall who took second in 16.78. In

the intermediate event, Sunstrom clocked in at 41.50 to lead Alba of Dixon at 43.28.

Geneseo's other double winner, Mattie, took titles in the 1600-meter run and the 3200-meter run.

His time of 4:51.85 topped the field in the 1600. Bebej of Princeton finished between Mattie and his teammate Bill Bean who took third. Their respective times were 4:55.53 and 4:56.05.

The pair from Geneseo wrapped up first and second in the 3200 with Mattie taking the tape in 10:23.18 followed by Bean in 10:52.78. Niemuth of Princeton was the next runner across the line, clocking at 10:58.75 for third.

Speller earned his title in the 100-

meter dash finals, covering the course in 11.60 for the title. He was followed by Cowsey of Princeton in second, 11.71 and DeJong of Sterling in third, 12.00.

Rounding out the title winners for the Leaflets is Reade who took top honors in the triple jump with a distance of 40'6". Inskeep of Ottawa and Wickens of Dixon tied for second at 39'7".

Fierce competition highlighted the high jump event with the only clear winner being Nea of Rock Falls who claimed first with a jump of 6'0". The next four athletes cleared 5'10" including Jeremy Heaton who claimed second and Reade who moved into fifth-place.

Geneseo's 400-meter relay team of Dallas Drummond, Kyle Sullivan, Andy Thurman and Speller claimed second in the conference meet as well, finishing in 46.91, following Ottawa's time of 46.81. The Leaflets slipped in ahead of Princeton whose squad was clocked at 46.95.

The 800-meter relay team of Justin Kempher, Sullivan, Thurman and Speller also finished in the silver-medal slot. It was another tight competition with Dixon taking the lead at 1:38.63 followed by Geneseo, 1:38.73 and Princeton, 1:38.82.

The 1600-meter and 3200-meter relay teams captured thirds in the Leaflets' efforts. The 3200 squad of Brandon Sandoval, Nick Eberhardt, Mike Strohman and Nick Ogle clocked in at 9:15.53 behind Ottawa (8:50.75) and Sterling (9:10.91).

Ottawa also won the 1600-meter relay title, taking the tape in 3:40.58 ahead of Dixon (3:47.22) and Geneseo (3:49.78). Taking the course for the Leaflets were Thurman, Kempher, Sandoval and Sunstrom.

Finishing fourth overall, Speller took the 200-meter run in 24.30. DeJong of Sterling took the tape in 24.00 for the win.

Heaton added a fifth-place in the pole vault event to his day's stats, clearing 9'6", a full two foot shorter than the winning mark.

Eberhardt took fifth for Geneseo in the frosh-soph 800-meter run, clocking in at 2:13.32. Ottawa's sprinter took the event in 2:07.38.


Justin Watson earned fifth in the long jump. The Leaflet planted his feet at the 17'11.25" mark while the top distance was 18'9".

Reade wasn't the only Leaflet in the triple jump. Wickwire also finished within the top 10, taking eighth overall with a leap of 375.5".

The Leaflets did not place finishers in the discus or shot put.

In earning their crown, the Leaflets amassed 121.5 points, a good distance ahead of the rest of the field. Sterling finished second with 76 points followed by Ottawa, 75; Princeton, 73 and Dixon, 69 points.

Other teams competing included Rock Falls, 46; Hall, 27; LaSalle-Perrin, 26; Rochelle, 25; Kewanee, 13; Mendota 4.5 and Streator 2.
