

Focus on state

Leafs prepare for track sectionals in Minooka on Friday

Sectional competition for the J. D. Darnall varsity boys track team is set for Friday, May 21 in Minooka at 4 p.m.

Fifteen teams will be taking part in the Minooka Sectional including Geneseo, DeKalb, Dixon, United Township of East Moline, Galesburg, LaSalle-Peru, Minooka, Moline, Morris, Ottawa Township, Princeton, Rochelle, Rock Island High School, Sterling High School and Streator Township.

First and second place winners in each event, including relay teams, from each sectional will advance to the state finals. In addition, any individual or relay team equalling or surpassing the qualifying standard in the finals of their respective class will also advance.

"For sectionals, we've always focused on getting as many individuals to qualify," Coach Mel Snook explained. "We can't compete as a team against Rock Island and Moline so that's why we work on the individual qualifications."

Coach Snook is looking for a state qualification from Jeff Bowling who is Geneseo's highest seed.

"He is seeded second in the shot put," related Coach Snook. "And he beat the kid from Dixon who's seeded ahead of him at sectional."

"Jeff has already beat the state qualifying distance of 52'9", the coach added. "He's hit 53'5" so hopefully it will happen for him at sectional."

"Our 3200-meter relay team is seeded third," the coach added. "This is the first time we'll have these top guys together and hopefully, they can get second or at least run the state qualifying time of 8:06."

Coach Snook noted his team is

supported by a lot of the underclassmen.

"We have a lot of young kids performing for us. We tell them to feed on their conference performance and reach for another season or personal best."

When asked if the distance to Minooka will have an effect on the Leafs, Coach Snook quipped, "It's really not all that far."

"They have a nice facility there and the track is great. The only problem we may encounter may be the wind. Their track is in a wide open field with no wind break."

"We'll also see something for the first time before hitting state, they have fully automated timing so there will be no problem with human error," he concluded.

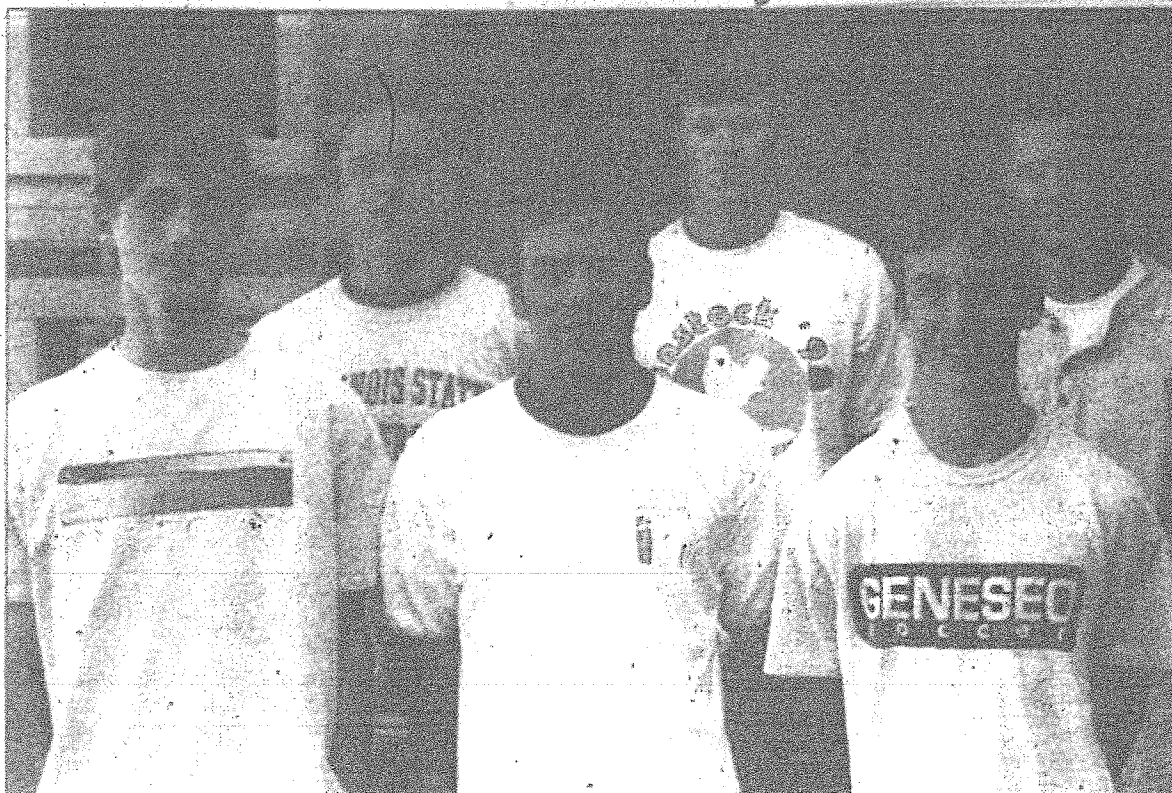
The IHSA Boys Class AA track and field state meet will be held Friday and Saturday, May 28-29 at O'Brien Stadium, Eastern Illinois University, Charleston.

Class AA preliminary and semifinal track events will begin at 9 a.m. on Friday with all finals slated for Saturday, May 29.

Last year, the Leafs qualified Chris Studer in the 3200-meter run and the 3200-meter relay team of Adam Anderson, Tom Anderson, Mark Keplinger and Grant Venema in state competition. Geneseo finished second in both events to earn their state berths. Keplinger and Studer are both seniors on this year's roster while Venema is a junior.

As a team, the Leafs finished 11th out of 14 in the sectional event; Rock Island won the overall competition.

If Studer qualifies for state again this year, it will be his third consecutive trip to Charleston. The past two years, he had competed in the 3200, taking eighth in his heat in 1998 for a 28th place overall finish. Last year's 3200-relay squad clocked an 8:06.32 in the preliminaries but the time was not high enough to qualify for the finals.

Reaching the top

Six cindermen to
compete in IHSA
Class AA meet

Justin Fluck, Jeff Bowling and the 3200-meter relay squad will represent J. D. Darnall High School at the IHSA Class AA Boys Track and Field competition this weekend.

The 3200 relay team is comprised of Dave Bopp, Mark Keplinger, Chris Schwigen and Grant Venema.

The three qualified for the state meet at the Minooka Sectionals on Friday, May 21.

Fluck earned his berth at the state meet by winning the 3200-meter event while Bowling was second in the shot put event.

Even though the 3200 relay squad finished third in the competition, the Geneseo squad bettered the qualifying mark to reach state.

Only the top two individuals from each event, including relay teams, from each sectional advance to the state finals. In addition, individuals or relay teams equaling or surpassing the qualifying standard in the finals of their respective class advanced.

Preliminaries for the state meet are slated to begin at 9 a.m. on Friday, May 28 with finals scheduled for Saturday, May 29 at O'Brien Stadium, Eastern Illinois University, Charleston.

Two members of the 3200-meter relay team are returning to the state meet for their second consecutive year. Keplinger and Venema were also members of the 1998 squad which took second at sectionals (with a time of 8:08.7) and then finished in 8:06.32 in preliminaries for a 23rd-place overall finish. Joining the pair were Tom Anderson and Adam Anderson.

This year, however, Keplinger and Venema were joined by Bopp and Schwigen for the event. Keplinger and Schwigen are seniors on this year's roster while Venema and Bopp are juniors.

The first three teams on the course out-distanced the competition. Moline won at 8:01.26 followed by Rock Island High at 8:01.32. Though the Leaf contingent was third at 8:05.68, their time was better than the qualifying standard of 8:06.0 to earn the foursome a trip to Charleston.

Sterling was the number four team, finishing at 8:30.07. Dixon rounded out the scoring at 8:37.26.

Going into the state meet, Geneseo's 3200-meter relay team's time of 8:05.68 is ranked 29th among the state qualifying relay squads. Pontiac holds the top time at 7:53.3.

Fluck pushed into first place in the 3200-meter run with a time of 9:46.70 ahead of David Bergeson of Rochelle, 9:53.52.

Elkhart Leaf trackster Chris Studer wrapped up third in the competition with a time of 10:07.26. Studer made the trip to state the last two years in the 3200.

Fluck's time of 9:46.70 ranks him 27th among the qualifying runners for state. The top time is recorded by senior Ed Torres of Wheeling at 9:15.2.

Bowling, earning Geneseo's one field event berth at state, took second

in the shot put event to Nick Byrnes of Dixon. Byrnes was marked at 57'4" while Bowling hit 53'. His distance also beat the qualifying mark of 52'9". Rounding out the top three was Dan Sheridan of Dixon who finished at 52'4".

Jake VerStraete also competed in the event and finished in the top 10 participants. VerStraete's distance of 47'1" placed him ninth overall among the 25 competitors.

Bowling's shot distance of 53' ranks him 18th and ties the 19th-ranked thrower, Ryan Levenchuk, a senior at Charleston. Bowling is a junior. The top distance of 59'11" is held by senior Jeremy Benberry of Aurora West.

Both Bowling and VerStraete were slated to compete in the discus throw as well but were scratched to the list prior to competition.

As a team, the Leafs bettered last year's team ranking from 11th up to sixth.

Galesburg won the competition with 80 points while Rock Island was second at 79.

Moline, 64; Dixon, 48; United Township of East Moline, 46 all placed ahead of Geneseo at 44 points.

Rounding out the field were Rochelle, 40; Ottawa and DeKalb, 30; Sterling, 29; Princeton, 24; Minooka and Morris, 10 and Sreator, 6 points.

Helping in the scoring were two other third-place finishes. Andy Beuster took third in the 1600-meter run with a time of 4:35.36. Jeremy Smith of Ottawa (4:28.42) and Mark Creger of Rock Island (4:32.19) took the state-bound positions.

David Mattie also competed within the event, taking 13th in the 23-runner field with a time of 4:55.82.

Mike Sunstrom also took bronze medal, finishing the 300-meter intermediate hurdles in 41.72, just a tick ahead of Evan Rau of Minooka at 41.73. Topping the field were Tim McDonald of Moline, 40.30 and Chris Howell, Morris, 41.33.

The top five place-finishers scored in each event.

Neil Russell and Cory Parrish packed up the competition in the 110-meter high hurdles but only Russell earned points. Russell was fifth overall with a time of 16.13 while Parrish took sixth in 16.34. Tim McDonald of Moline won the event at 14.75 followed by Calvin Oppenorth of Galesburg, 15.14.

Russell took sixth in the high jump, one of three reaching 5'9".

Bryan Tyson of Rock Island claimed fifth though reaching the mark while Phil Doch of Dixon and Russell shared sixth. The next seventh were marked at 5'7". Leading the competition was Pierre Woods of Galesburg who reached 6'5" for the title with Tom Lendy of Ottawa in second at 6'1".

Leaf Jeremy Heaton was the last athlete in the high jump event to reach the 5'7", tying him for 12th place with two others.

Bopp just missed scoring for the Leafs in the 400-meter run, taking sixth in 52.47. Justin Brown of Galesburg took the last scoring position, finishing fifth at 52.36. Woods took the event in 49.73 while Ryan Ptak of Sterling was second at 50.28. Venema was also slated to compete

but was scratched prior to the competition.

Will McCombs was also one spot away from scoring, taking sixth in the 800-meter run with a time of 2:03.81. Beating him out of fifth was Adam Faupl of Ottawa at 2:03.33. The top two place finishers were McDonald, 1:57.83 and Ryan Allen of Rock Island, 1:58.81.

Matt Travis also ran the 800 for Geneseo, taking 14th out of the 21-man field. His time was 2:11.03.

Derek Speller, Dallas Drummond, Aaron Anderson and George Ofslager ran the 4x200 meter relay for the Leafs, taking seventh overall with a time of 1:37.46. They were right in the middle of a pack that finished within the 1:37 time frame. Galesburg took the title with a time of 1:30.47 while United Township claimed the last advancing spot with a time of 1:30.72.

Two Leafs tied in the 200-meter dash. Speller and Ofslager both came through at 24.3 to tie for seventh place in the 22-man field. Alfonso Pugh of Galesburg and Mark Moellering of Rochelle took the top two positions with times of 22.7 and 23.0, respectively.

In the triple jump, Kyle Reade took eighth overall with a distance of 39'6.25" while fellow leaf Russell took 12th overall at 37'5". Jesse Schroeder of United Township and Mike Przysucha of Dixon claimed first and second with respective marks of 41'11" and 41'0.75".

Two Leafs finished back-to-back in the pole vault as well. Andrew Henry and Heaton both marked 12' to take eighth and ninth, respectively. The other athlete to clear 12' was Adam King of Sterling who claimed seventh.

The top four jumpers in the event tied at 13'6" to match the qualifying standard and advance to the state meet. The four include Tom Ryerson of Rock Island, Tyler Gaumer of Sterling, Ratha Chum of Ottawa and Lucas Brainerd of Dixon.

Speller took ninth-place in the 100-meter dash, coming through at 12.08. Justin Hoggard of United Township and Ronel Muskeyvalley of Rock Island clocked at 11.31 and 11.32, respectively, for the top two times.

Speller, Drummond, Brian Mosher and Ofslager competed in the 4x100 meter relay for Geneseo, taking ninth overall with a time of 46.70. Earning

state trips were Galesburg (43.30) and Rock Island (43.42).

Bopp, McCombs, Schwigen and Venema combined for the 4x400-meter relay and claimed 10th place for Geneseo with a time of 3:40.17. Galesburg claimed the number one slot at 3:23.91 followed by Rochelle, 3:24.73.

Twenty-four athletes were marked in the long jump and Geneseo placed two within the field. Josh Watson took 11th at 18'6.5" while Aaron Anderson marked at 18' for 15th place.

The top three qualified in this competition, all besting the qualifying mark of 22'. Topping the field was Pugh at 22'5.5" followed by Jesse Schroeder of United Township, 22'1" and Moellering at 22'0.5".

Streaks shock Rocks in AA boys sectional

MINOOKA — It may have been the Class AA track and field sectional meet, but Friday's Minooka Sectional had a strong Western Big 6 flavor.

The Rock Island Rocks and the Galesburg Silver Streaks battled it out throughout a rainy evening at the Minooka High School athletic field, with Moline and United Township right there in the mix as well.

Led by six state qualifiers, the Streaks eventually topped Rocky by one point, 80 to 79, for team supremacy. The Maroons settled for third place with a team total of 64 points.

UTHS was fifth at the 15-team meet with 46 points, just two behind fourth-place Dixon and two ahead of the sixth-place Geneseo Maple Leafs.

However, the team sweepstakes was the least of Rock Island coach Ed Lillis' worries: He was more pleased with the five Rocky individuals and the two relays that qualified for next weekend's IHSA Class AA State Championships at Charleston.

"Oh sure, that's the old cliché going into (sectionals) and coming out of it, too," said Lillis. "Qualifying guys for state is more important, and it is. The team picture is a bonus; if it happens, fine. If it doesn't, it's not the most important thing."

Individuals carrying the crimson-and-gold banner to Eastern Illinois University's O'Brien Stadium next weekend are Tom Ryerson (pole vault), Ronel Muskeyvalley (100), Ryan Allen (800), John Austin (200) and Boomer Creger (1600).

With the exception of Ryerson's first-place 13-6 effort in the pole vault, all of the above came away with silver medals. Muskeyvalley posted a time of 11.32 in the 100, while Allen ran 1:58.57 in the 800, Austin posted a 23.39 clocking in the 200 and Creger hit the tape in 4:32.02 in the mile run.

"I'm happy for Boomer Creger," said Lillis, who also got second-place runs from his 3200 relay (8:01.15) and his 400 relay (43.2). "He's only a sophomore, and he ran a real nice mile. I was happy with John, too, and Tom was real solid in the pole vault.

"Ryan Allen had a spectacular night; he ran two 1:58's (prelims and finals), and that's a good night. We had some highlights."

Moline coach Jeff Quick came away from Friday's sectional meet very pleased at the overall performance of his Maroons, who qualified a pair of individuals and their first-place 3200 relay (8:01.10) for state.

"We got beat by 20 seconds last week in the two-mile relay (at the Western Big 6 Conference meet), and we were able to come back and win that today," Quick stated. "There's nothing disappointing for us tonight, nothing at all."

Individually, the Maroons' Tim and Tom McDonald each had a huge evening, coming away with two gold medals apiece.

Tom McDonald pocketed his golds with a first-place run of 1:57.52 in the 800 and as part of Moline's first-place two-mile relay. Tim, meanwhile, captured the 110 high hurdles in a time of 14.75 and followed up by winning the 300 intermediates with a 40.30 clocking.

"I'm happy for Tim and Tom," said Quick. "They both definitely earned their (Metro) Pacesetter, they showed that it was well-earned."

United Township coach Mike Patterson, whose club advances a pair of individuals to go with its second-place 800 relay (1:30.72), also feels the Panthers accomplished their sectional goals.

"We came through in the events I thought we'd come through in," said Patterson. "That's satisfying right there."

UTHS individuals punching tickets to Charleston are Jesse Schroeder and Justin Hoggard.

Schroeder claimed the triple jump with a lead of 41-11 after placing second in the long jump with a 22-1 effort. Meanwhile, Hoggard captured the 100 meter dash with a time of 11.31 seconds and was fourth in the long jump, just missing out on a state bid with a 21-2 effort.

Geneseo will be represented by a pair of individuals in Justin Fluck (3200) and Jeff Bowling (shot put), along with its third-place 3200 relay (8:05.45).

Fluck used a potent finishing kick to complete the two-mile in a first-place time of 9:46.53. Bowling threw 53 feet to take second in the shot put.
