Nelson sets new record in annual Kiwanis relay event

Leaf runner Tim Nelson set a new record in the 3200-meter run, C-division, during the United Township High School Boys Kiwanis Invitational held Saturday, April 10.

Nelson, a junior on the J. D. Darnall High School varsity track squad, took the event in 10:10.1 for the record.

Nelson was one of five Geneseo victories in the annual event.

The 25th annual event, held at the South Bowl in East Moline, featured three classes of competition, A-B-C, which is designed to emphasize team depth as well as recognizing individuals.

With the cancellation of the Shipyery Invitational on Saturday, April 3, the Leafs have been out of competition since a home triangular on Tuesday, March 30, which they won.

Over a week later, the Leafs enter a 10-team field, strong with Quad Cities teams, in the annual Kiwanis relays.

In last year's event, the Leafs finished in fifth place with 164 points.

Rock Island earned its second consecutive title, winning this year's event with 254 points, more than 20 points ahead of second-place Sterling at 230.

The field was tight and competitive over the next five positions. East Moline, claiming third place, tallied 189 points, with the Leafs close behind at 187. Moline finished in fifth at 185; Galesburg, sixth, 180 and Freeport, seventh, 176 points.

Rounding out the field were Alton, 44 points, Sherrard, 22 and Rockford East, 14 points.

Senior runner Justin Pluck won the only A-division title for Geneseo, taking the 3200-meter run in 9:48.1 for the win.

Fellow runner Chris Studer competed in the B-division of the race, taking second in 10:11.3 behind the Rock Island winner at 10:08.9.

Jake Verstraete won the only B-division title for the Leafs, taking the shot put event in 49'2". He edged out Sterling's representative marked at 49'1" while the rest of the field couldn't best the third-place distance of 44'1".

Aaron Anderson was a C-division winner, clearing the bar at 5'8" in the high jumping event. There was a three-way tie for the next position at a height of 5'6".

Andy Beuster claimed his C-division title with a time of 2:06.3 in the 800-meter run. The second place runner finished in 2:09.1 while the third runner came in at 2:09.8.

Beuster also earned a third in the A-division of the 1600-meter run. The Rock Island runner came through first in 4:40.1 followed by a Freeport runner in 4:42.5 and Beuster at 4:43.9. The next competitor, a Moline representative, finished in 4:51.2.

In other A-division competition, Jeff Bowling took second in the shot

put with a throw of 49' behind the first-place effort of 55'. He added a third-place in the discus event to his day's accomplishments with his hurl of 132'5". A distance of 137'2.5" won the category.

Dave Bopp scored for the Leafs with a second-place finish in the 800-meter run, clocking in at 2:05.1 behind the winner in 2:00.5.

Neil Russell was a multiple A-division place finisher as well. In a three way tie at 5'10", Russell came in fourth in the high jump. The winning effort was 6'5" and the second and third-place finishers tied at 6'.

Russell was fifth in the 300-meter intermediate hurdles with his time of 44.2; a time of 39.2 won. He later finished sixth in the high hurdles finals, taking the course in 15.1. It was a tight field with six place-finishers packing in between 14.7 and 15.1.

Andy Henry tied for fourth-place in the A-division of the pole vault event with his vault of 9'6". The top three slots came in at 13'6, 12'6 and 11', respectively.

Another A-division competitor for the Leafs was Brendan O'Rourke who took sixth in the 400-meter dash with a time of 54.9. The winning time was 49.9.

Two Geneseo relay squads also competed in the top division, the 3200-meter relay and the 1600-meter relay.

Dave Bopp, Aaron Anderson, Mike Sunstrom and Chris Schwigen teamed for the 1600 relay and came in third with a time of 3:41.4. Galesburg won the event in 3:30.0 while Moline came in second in 3:30.7. The fourth place team, Sterling, finished at 3:45.2.

Will McCombs, Chris Cashman, Matt Travis and Schwigen teamed in the 3200-meter event, taking fourth in 8:53.7. Galesburg won in 8:28.9 ahead of Rock Island, 8:29.8 and Moline, 8:39.9. Alleman rounded out the top five in 9:03.2.

In addition to his first in the shot put, VerStrate added a second in the discus to his day's accomplishments. He reached 124'3.5" for the silver-medal position, finishing second to only a Sterling hurier at 124'8".

Jeremy Heaton tied for second in the B-division of the high jumping event when he and a Freeport leaper both cleared 5'8". The winner, from Rock Island, cleared 5'10" for the title.

Russell switched divisions for the triple jump, competing in the B-division and taking third at 39'2.25", exactly one foot farther than the fourth-place finisher. The top two placers came in with jumps of 40'8" and 39'5.75", respectively.

The pole vault event in the B-division was "tie'd up with the top two placers each clearing 12'6". Heaton was among three athletes to claim second, all reaching 9'6".

Studer, who took second in the 3200-meter event, claimed third in the B-division's 1600-meter run. Studer clocked in at 4:53.4 behind times of 4:45.7 and 4:47.1, respectively. Studer's closest competition came from an Alleman runner who clocked in at 5:09.0.

Mark Keplinger also scored for

Geneseo with a third place, taking the honor in the 100-meter run of the B-division. The winner clocked in at 2:03.6. Keplinger was hot on the heals of the second runner with respective times of 2:06.2 and 2:07.0. The fourth-place runner came in at 2:13.0.

Two fifth and two sixth places also aided in Geneseo's high finish.

Anderson took fifth in the 400-meter dash, clocking in at 56.6 while the winner took the tape in 53.8. Cory Parrish was the other fifth-place finisher for the Leafs, taking the honor in the high hurdles final with a time of 16.4. The top three place finishers tied at 17.4.

Sunstrom and Josh Nelson were the two athletes to score in sixth place for the Leafs within the B-division. Sunstrom took the 300-intermediate hurdles in 44.6 while Watson scored sixth place with a time of 12.9 in the 100-meter dash finals.

Competing in the C-division, Anderson took fourth in the long jump event with a distance of 18'3.5". The winning jump was 19'1".

Ben Gerhardt took second in the shot put with a throw of 42'10" behind the first-place effort of 44'6". He also earned fifth in the discus for the class, giving a hurl of 96'1".

Another second-place finisher for the Leafs was Mike Windy who took the silver-medal position in the pole vault by clearing 9'0". A Sterling vaulter cleared 12'6" for the title.

Parrish nearly nipped the winner in the 300-intermediate hurdles with his second-place time of 42.9; the winner was clocked at 42.8. The third-place runner was timed at 44.3.

Taking second in the high hurdles for Geneseo was Sunstrom who cleared the course in 16.2 behind Moline's hurdler at 15.6.

Dallas Drummond finished the 100-meter dash finals in the C-division in fourth place with rather tight competition. The top three runners came in at 11.9, 12.0 and 12.1, respectively while Drummond led the last three with a time of 12.4 followed by times of 12.5 and 12.6.

Joe Curnyn and Nelson claimed thirds for the Leafs in running events as well. Curnyn finished the 400-meter dash in 57.1 behind times of 53.6 and 54.6 in first and second, respectively. Nelson finished the 1600-meter run in 4:52.3. The top two came in at 4:47.8 and 4:50.0, respectively.

Rounding out Geneseo's scoring in the C-division was Pat Mapes in the triple jump. Mapes' distance of 35'3.25" was good for sixth place.

Weather permitting, the Leafs were home against Galesburg and Alleman on Thursday afternoon, April 15.

Next on the schedule is the track team's trip to Rock Island for an invitational on Friday, April 23, beginning at 4 p.m. The frosh-soph squad will host the annual Geneseo Frosh-Soph Invite on Monday, April 26 while the varsity team prepares for the Pekin Invite on Friday, April 30. The next home meet for the varsity Leafs is the John McCormick Invitational on Friday, May 7.

Rocks dominate Kiwanis Relays

The Rock Island Rocks earned points in almost every conceivable manner in defending their title at the 25th annual Kiwanis Relays at the Soule Bowl in East Moline Saturday.

The Rocks took top honors in 14 events — including five on the A level, with this meet featuring A, B and C divisions — as they piled up 254 points compared to 230 for runner-up Sterling.

The host Panthers were third with 189 points, with Geneseo and Moline right on their tail with 187 and 185, respectively. Sherrard was eighth with 44 and Alleman had 22 for ninth.

"We were just glad to get one in outdoors," Rocks coach Ed Lillis said. "We don't look at the points too much; we're mainly looking at performance. If you get the good performances, then you'll get the points and the titles."

While the Rocks' depth was expected to be the difference in the meet, Lillis said his team did get some unexpected points from underclassmen.

"We had a young freshman pole vaulter, Steve Burnett, who cleared 12-6 to win the C division," he said, "and that's just a phenomenal vault for a freshman."

"We also got some good races out of our young kids. It's good to see them come along to complement our upperclassmen."

Twelve different Rocks earned firsts, including a sweep of all three divisions in the 1600-meter run and the A and B divisions of the 800 and 110 high hurdles.

John Austin and Bryan Tyson were the only double-individual winners for the Rocks. Austin took the B division 110-meter high hurdles (14.7 seconds) and 200 (23.4). Tyson won the B high jump (5 feet, 10 inches) and C long jump (19-1).

"I like this kind of a meet, because even if you're not one of your team's top two guys in an event, you still get a chance to contribute," said Austin, who also ran on a second-place varsity 400 relay and was third in the B 300 hurdles. "I thought my times were pretty good. I was really happy with my 200. I ran a personal-best and it came in my fourth race of the day right after the 300 hurdles."

All but one of the Rocks' A division wins came on the track. Shawn Mendoza (1,600, 4:40.1), Dustin Green (800, 2:00.5), Ranel Muskeyvalley (100, 11.1) and Ellery Stewart (110 high hurdles, 14.7) all collected firsts.

In the field events, Justin Roessler (shot put, 137.25) collected an A division first for Rock Island.

The only other area athletes to collect "A" first were Geneseo's Justin Fluck and Moline's Tim McDonald. Fluck broke open a tight race with

Freeport's Dan Trainor and Rock Island's Mendoza to win the 3200 in 9:48.10. McDonald, who had been edged out by Stewart at the tape in the 110 hurdles, got off to a fast start and then barely held on to win the 300 hurdles (39.2).

"I got off the blocks really good, but I got off stride over there (at the top of the curve)," he said, "so I was leading with the wrong foot the rest of the way."

"But I was really happy with my time. A race like that this early in the year makes me think I can be All-State or better."

The host Panthers earned wins in the freshman 400 and 1,600 medley relays — Joe Schatteman, Justin Schatteman and Aaron Frazier competing on both.

Senior Justin Hoggard earned B division field-event firsts in the triple jump (40-8), long jump (19-10) and 100 (11.5).

"I was really pleased with how our young sprinters ran," UT coach Mike Patterson said. "Aaron Frazier gave us some real strong anchor legs in both those races and also got us a third in the A 100. Those kids are only going to get better as the season goes on."

Galesburg dominated the relays with victories in the varsity 400, 800, 1,600 and 3,200.

Moline's Matt Cornelia won both the 110 (15.6) and 300 hurdles (42.8) in the C division.
