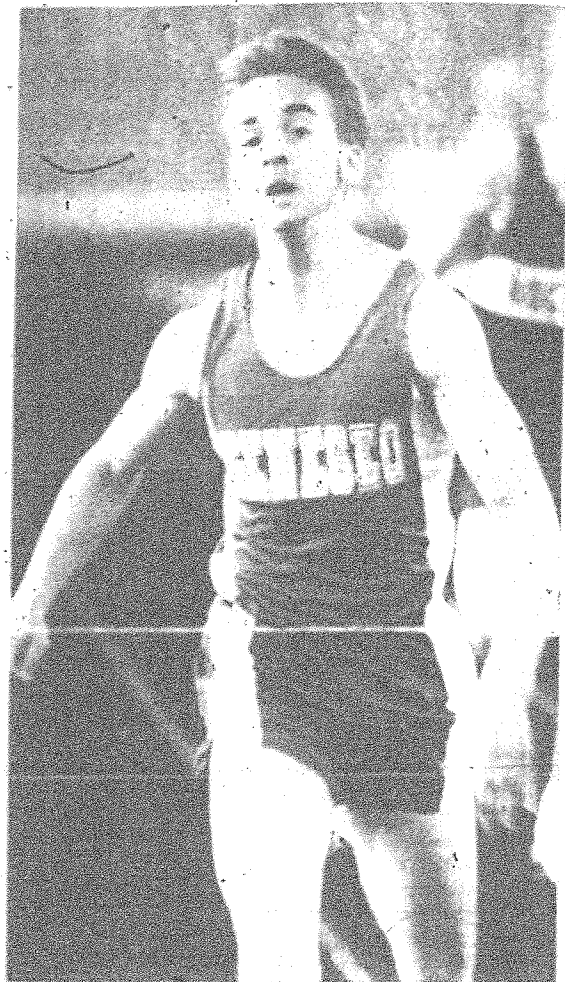
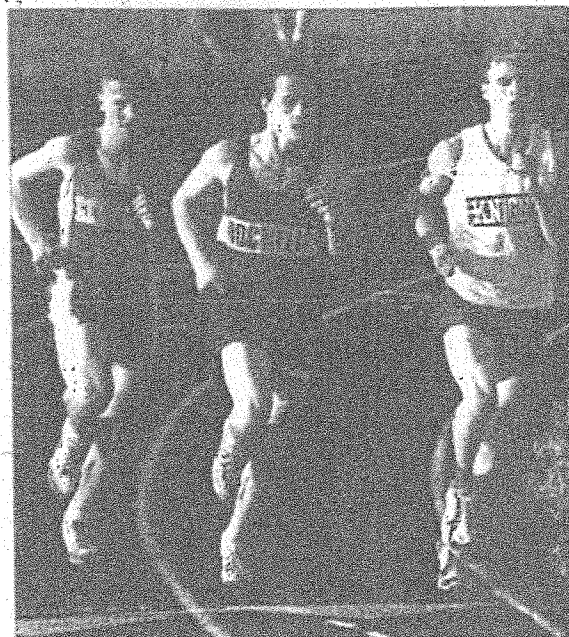

Records "Parrish"

Another new record; Leafs 3rd in NCIC

For the second time this season, Cory Parrish has reset the 300-meter hurdles record at J. D. Darnall High School.

The varsity track star is a senior at GHS and is making sure his name is set in the boys track record books.

Though Parrish did not win the event at the NCIC track meet held Friday, May 12 in Dixon, his time of 39.18 was good enough to break the school record set earlier this year by Parrish in Rock Island. That time was 39.51 which broke a record set in 1989.

Gaumer of Sterling won the NCIC title on Saturday with a meet record-breaking time of 38.97.

Third place went to Neal of Sterling with a time of 41.40.

As a team, the Leafs took third, the same mark the team recorded in 1999. Last year's team was led by Parrish, Dave Bopp, Andy Beuster, Wil McCombs and Grant Venema.

Parrish was the only Leaf to record a win in the 1999 event.

This same core group led this year's contingent as well along with the help of some additional teammates.

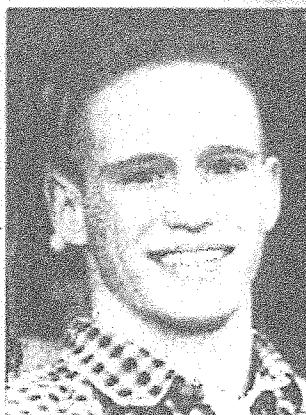
Three titles were earned for the Leafs.

Parrish took the 110-meter high hurdles with a time of 14.77 to edge out Gaumer who took second in 14.79.

Bopp claimed the 400-meter dash crown with a time of 50.08 to breeze into victory lane. Rochelle's sprinter stopped the clock in 52.04 for second.

Parrish, Bopp and Venema teamed with Mike Sunstrom to win the 1600-meter relay event with a time of 3:27.78. In a photofinish, Rochelle edged out Dixon with respective times of 3:31.30 and 3:31.39.

McCombs, Beuster and Bopp combined with Matt Travis for the 3200-meter relay and came through in 8:12.49 for second.

The top two teams in the event, Dixon and Geneseo, easily outdistanced the competition. Dixon recorded a time of 8:11.55 for the win while Sterling took third in 8:31.85.

Tim Nelson also registered a second-place finish for the Leafs, coming through the 3200-meter run in 10:05.80, over 14 seconds ahead of the next runner. Josh Franks scored for Geneseo in fourth place with a time of 10:28.71. Rochelle's top distance runner took the tape in 9:58.33.

Back-to-back finishes by Beuster and Nelson in the 1600-meter run also helped Geneseo's cause. Beuster took third in 4:35.59 while Nelson recorded a fourth-place time of 4:38.43. The top two runners finished in 4:33.75 and 4:35.26, respectively.

Jeff Bowling earned third in the shot put with a mark of 52'10.5", just a little more than an inch better than his next competitor.

Two Dixon tossers took the top two positions. The top man broke the meet record with a distance of 60'5". The second-place man was recorded at 55'9".

In the discus, Bowling took sixth with a mark of 140'4", nearly five feet behind the Mendota hurler at 145'3" in fifth place. Kewanee's discus thrower reached 161'1" for the win.

There were only three heights recorded in the pole vault event. The number one finisher came from Sterling and maxed out at 14' and the sixth place finisher was Marc Brun-

ner of Geneseo who reached 13'. The other four place finishers tied at 13'6" to complete the field.

Kyle Reade scored in sixth for Geneseo in the triple jump with a mark of 38'1". He was just four inches shy of Nick Welgat of Kewanee who took fifth at 38'5". The top distance was marked by Hall's jumper at 43'2".

Rounding out the Leafs scoring was the 400-meter relay team of Parrish, Sunstrom, Mike Dietsch and Dallas Drummond. The foursome took fifth overall with a time of 45.27 to finish between Rochelle, 45.09 and Princeton, 45.86. Sterling won the event with a time of 44.43.

Dixon and Sterling scored over 40 points more than the rest of the field to lead the team competition.

The Dukes racked up 137 points for the NCIC title. The Golden Warriors of Sterling took second with 120 points.

Geneseo's Leafs edged Kewanee for third with 79 points; the Boiler-makers had 75.

Other team standings include Rochelle, 61; Rock falls, 25; Ottawa, 21; Hall, 18; LaSalle-Peru and Princeton, 8; Mendota, 5 and Sreator, 0 points.

Dixon also won the 1999 event, scoring 102 points. Rochelle took second with 97 followed by Geneseo, 67 and Kewanee, 60 points.

This weekend, the Leafs are competing in the Sterling Sectionals on Friday, May 19 at 3:30 p.m. The Leafs hope not only to better last year's sixth-place team standing but to qualify a number of athletes for the Class AA Boys State Track Meet set for Friday, May 26.

Geneseo was represented in three events last year. Justin Fluck ran the 3200-meter run for the Leafs; Bowling competed in the shot put and the 3200-meter relay team qualified for the state meet as well.

Other schools in the Sterling Sectional include Dixon, United Township of East Moline, Freeport High School, LaSalle-Peru, Moline, Ottawa Township, Princeton, Rochelle, Rock Island High School, Sterling High School and Sreator Township.

Leafrosh win!

Frosh-soph team takes NCIC title

For the second year in a row, the J. D. Darnall High School frosh-soph boys track team has dominated the NCIC field and claimed the league crown.

The Leaflets regained the crown in 1999 after a one-year hiatus.

Dixon hosted the conference meet on Friday, May 12.

Over 30 points separated the Leafs from their competition. Geneseo's thinclads scored 115 points to beat out Rochelle, 84 and Sterling 78 points.

Dixon and Ottawa tied for fourth with 57 points followed by Kewanee, 49; Princeton, 40; Hall, 22; LaSalle-Peru, 20; Rock Falls, 13; Streator 12 and Mendota, 11 points.

Consistent performances guided the Leafrosh along with four first-place finishes.

Jeremy Heaton won the 300-meter hurdles for Geneseo, breaking the tape in 42.51. Helping to boost the Leafrosh's score was a third-place finish from Justin Kempher at 44.07. Dixon earned the second-place points with a time of 43.84.

David Mattie was the title holder in the 3200-meter run with his time of 10:32.22. Rock Falls offered his closest competition with a second-place runner at 10:35.96.

Mattie also had a second-place finish for the day, taking the silver-medal honor in the 1600-meter run.

His time of 4:47.76 was better than the Princeton distance runner who took third in 4:48.40 but was behind the Rochelle rep at 4:46.96.

Andy Thurman, Erik Norin, Aaron Kuban and Alex DePauw earned another first for the Leafrosh, winning the 400-meter relay with a time of 46.34. Sterling's contingent followed the Geneseo group across with a time of 47.04.

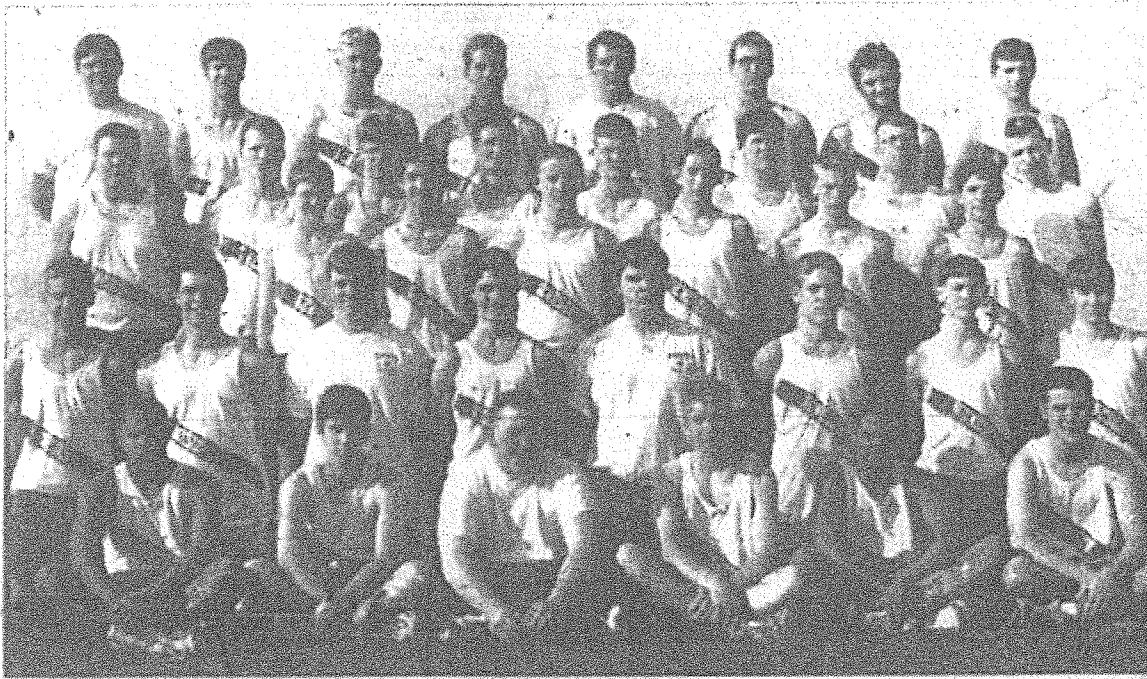
The final title earned by a Geneseo group came in the 800-meter relay event. Thurman, Kempher and Norin teamed with Grant Wyffels for a time of 1:38.16 to beat out Kewanee's team which took second at 1:39.23.

The Leafrosh also received a boost in the scoring with back-to-back finishes from Kyle Wickwire and Heaton in the high jump. Princeton's leaper took the event with a mark of 5'11". Wickwire bowed to third with a tying mark of 5'9" with the second-place finisher from Streator. Heaton finished ahead of two in a three-way tie at 5'7" to earn fourth place.

Heaton also scored in the 100-meter hurdles, taking third in 16.75. Sterling and Ottawa hurdlers topped the field with respective times of 16.23 and 16.38. Wickwire also placed in the event, taking sixth in 20.18.

Another third-place effort was put forth by Heaton in the pole vault. He was one of three athletes to clear 11' and took third place ahead of the rest. The top two athletes cleared 12' and 11'6", respectively.

Nick Eberhardt, Eric VanEarwage, Paul Kretschmar and Derek Wahlheim took fourth in the 3200-meter relay with a time of 9:37.45.
