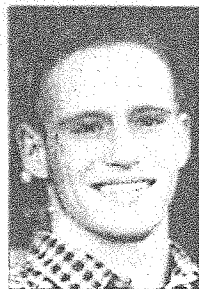


Mid-season stretch

Parrish sets new record; Leafs take 4th at R.I. invite

Cory Parrish set a new school record in the 300 intermediate hurdles during the Rock Island Boys Track and Field Invitational on Friday, April 21.

The invitational was the first meet in over a week for the J. D. Darnall High School boys track squad but followed an overwhelming victory by the Leafs in the squad's first home triangular.

Parrish took fourth overall in the A division of competition with a time of 39.51 to best Tyrone Jackson's mark of 39.8 set in 1989.

Ellery Stewart topped the field with a time of 38.66. The top three contenders all broke the meet record of 38.50 set in 1998. Parrish and Kevin Noel of Naperville Central who took fifth, were faster than the IHSA qualifying time of 39.94.

Jeremy Heaton represented the Leafs in the B division, tying for fifth place with Jeff Beck of Rock Island at 43.90.

In the C division of the intermediate hurdles, Leaf Justin Kempfer took third with a time of 44.74 while Chris Jones of Thornwood took the tape in 42.75.

Another highlight in the Leafs' competition was Jake VerStraete's first-place finish in the B division of the discus throw. VerStraete marked in at 139'11" for the title, nine feet farther than the second-place finisher from Thornwood.

Ben Gerhardt represented Geneseo in the C competition, taking seventh overall with a mark of 111'1".

The top three hurlers in the A division bettered the IHSA qualifying mark. Zach Edwards of Rock Island won at 155'3" followed by Chris Voller, Naperville Central, 155'2" and Adam Hainline, Macomb, 144'3".

VerStraete and Jeff Bowling topped two separate divisions of competition in the shot put.

Bowling took first in the A category with an effort of 32'4". He was followed by Voller's 49'8.5" mark and David Zdunek of Thornwood's effort of 48'7.25".

Tim Nelson took third in 9:57.27. Ryan Teising of Naperville took the division with a time of 9:25.18.

At the B level, Geneseo was led by Josh Franks who took second in 10:22.25 behind Dan Rickert of Naperville's time of 10:15.89.

Bob Ristau also placed second, earning his honor in the C level of competition. Ristau clocked through at 10:28.14 behind Richwood's Nick Jongerious at 10:23.61.

Geneseo's top finisher in the 110-meter high hurdles was Mike Sunstrom. Sunstrom took fourth in the B level with a time of 16.75 while the winner, Matt Meier of Naperville Central, took the tape in 15.33.

Parrish finished one slot out of scoring range in the A division of the hurdles, taking seventh place with a time of 15.94. The top three runners in the event bettered the IHSA qualifying mark including the winner, Calvin Oppenorth of Galesburg who finished at 14.56.

Geneseo's 800-meter sprint medley finished seventh with a time of 1:45.49, three tenths of a second behind U.T. which captured the last scoring position. Thornwood took the win in 1:38.40. Running for Geneseo were Kempfer, Alex DePauw, Erik Norin and Aaron Kuban.

In the 4x800-meter relay, Geneseo's squad of Dave Bopp, Andy Beuster, Wil McCombs and Grant Venema took third behind Naperville Central and Thornwood. The Leaf foursome finished in 8:14.04; Central won in 8:03.68.

Geneseo's 4x400-meter relay team finished seventh out of the 11 teams competition in the event. The Leaf foursome, Bopp, Parrish, McCombs and Beuster, came across the finish line in 3:35.25. Thornwood won in 3:26.52 to edge out Bartlett at 3:26.88.

Nelson and Mattie represented the Leafs in the 1600-meter run. Nelson scored in the fourth position of the C division with a time of 4:44.26. Rickert of Naperville won in 4:37.95. Mattie finished just out of scoring range, taking seventh in the B division at 4:50.51. The winner, Harland White of Naperville, was clocked at 4:35.75.

Scoring for Geneseo in the high jump were Kyle Reade and Kyle Wickwire.

Reade finished in the three-way tie at the mark of 5'8", placing third between Troy Walker of East Peoria and Brandon Reynolds of U.T. who also finished at that mark. De'on Willis of Thornwood won the division with a mark of 5'10".

Wickwire finished fourth in the B competition, topping the two other jumpers who also marked 5'8" as well. Anthony Maye of Homewood-Flossmoor claimed fifth while Justin Smith of Bartlett took sixth with their 5'8" marks. Winning the event

sixth-place finisher from U.T. The winning mark of 41'3" was given by Cornelious.

At the C level, Aaron Anderson rounded out the scoring with a sixth-place finish. Anderson was marked at 34'7.25" while the winner, Sean Walker of Homewood-Flossmoor, was marked at 40'4".

Two thirds and a fourth-place finish were earned by the Leafs in the pole vault event.

Marc Brunner took fourth in the A level of competition with a mark of 12'6", six inches better than the pair who tied for fifth. Two vaulters also tied for second at 13' while the winner, Casey Friske of Rockford Guilford topped out at 14'6".

In the B division, Andrew Henry took third for Geneseo, finishing at a height of 12'. The top two tied at 12'6". Tim Hollman of Guilford and L. Beasley of Peoria High.

With a vault of 11' flat, Heaton took third for the Leafs in the C division of the pole vault. David Few of Guilford topped the field at 12'.

McCombs edged his way into fifth place in the B division of the 800-meter run. His time was recorded at 2:02.98. Ahfir Sarumi of Thornwood broke the tape in 2:02.98.

Three Leafs scored in their respective divisions of the 400-meter dash.

Bopp dashed into third place in the A division with a time of 50.64, just six hundredths of a second behind Jabari Adams of Macomb who took second. The top sprinter, Terry Westbrook of U.T., was timed at 50.30.

In the B level of competition, Venema took fourth for the Leafs with a time of 53.71 just four hundredths of a second ahead of the fifth-place finisher. Brandon Simmons of Thornwood broke the tape at 52.08.

Sunstrom was Geneseo's top finisher in the C division of the 400 dash. His time of 54.44 placed him behind Jason Ford of Naperville, 53.48 and Ron Westbrook of Homewood-Flossmoor, 53.98.

As a team, the Leafs finished fourth with a score of 119.5.

Thornwood and Naperville Central topped the field with respective scores of 231 and 213.

Rock Island placed third in its invitational with 162.5 points.

Rounding out the team competition were Moline, 107; Homewood-Flossmoor, 102.5; Rockford Guilford, 91.5; United Township, 88; Peoria High, 85.5 and Macomb, 76.

Also fielding teams were Bartlett, 65.5; East Peoria, 62; Peoria Richwoods, 49; Galesburg, 40 and Alleman, nine points.

Leaflets take on QC teams in Rocky invite

With weather conditions forcing the cancellation of the United Township Invite on Saturday, April 8, the J. D. Darnall junior varsity boys track team had nearly 10 days to prepare for the Rock Island J.V. Invite on Tuesday, April 11.

The field offered tight competition with Rock Island taking home track advantage with 99 points for first place.

United Township of East Moline, and Rock Island Alleman tied for second with 98 points followed by the Leaflets in third with 88.

Moline was 16 points behind Geneseo with 72 points. Pleasant Valley High, 48 and Galesburg, 37, rounded out the competition.

After 10 events, Geneseo held the lead with a four-point advantage over Rock Island and 10-point edge on U.T.

Jeremy Heaton and Kyle Fluck claimed individual titles for the Leaflets.

Heaton won the pole vault event with a jump of 10'7". Grant Wyffels also competed for Geneseo, reaching 8'2" in a three-way tie for fourth place. Joe Johnson also pole vaulted but no time was kept past sixth place.

Fluck earned his honor in the 3200-meter run, taking the tape in 11:16.41 for top points. Also finishing in the top 10 for the Leaflets were Michael Stone, sixth, 11:58.48 and Derek Wahlheim, eighth, 12:06.42.

The lone second-place ribbon earned by Geneseo came from the 4x100 relay team of Andy Thurman, Erik Norin, Dallas Drummond and Aaron Kuban. The foursome came through at 47.40 behind Rock Island's contingent which won in 46.51. Alleman and Pleasant Valley tied for third with a time of 48.21.

Kyle Sullivan and Brian Blank scored back-to-back for the Leaflets in the shot put. The pair scored in the third and fourth-place positions, respectively, with distances of 39'5.5" and 38'8". U.T. took top points from John Johnson's mark of 44'3" followed by Jon Nagel of P.V. in second at 40'6.5".

Kyle Wickwire was marked at 37'4" in the triple jump to take third place. Garrick Wayne, Josh Reschke and Adam Blank also competed with respective distances of 34'11", 31'7.5" and 30'5". Rock Island's Quentin Jefferson took the top position with a 38'11" effort following by R. J. Severtsgaard of U.T. at 38'8.5".

In top three

Rocky took the top points in the triple jump with a 38'11" effort from Quentin Jefferson. U.T. claimed second behind R. J. Severtsgaard's 38'8.5" mark.

Heaton scored for Geneseo with a third-place effort of 44.81 in the 300-meter intermediate hurdles. Justin Kempfer and Wickwire ran the course as well, coming through with times of 46.43 and 51.34, respectively. Andy Parer of Rock Island topped the field in 43.75 while Seth Denato of Moline came through in second at 43.86.

Geneseo's 4x200 earned six points for the Leaflets with a third-place time of 1:42.85. Thurman, Drum-

mond, Norin and Josh Watson ran. Rock Island and U.T. battled for the top positions with times of 1:38.54 and 1:38.63, respectively.

Drummond earned another third-place ribbon for his 100-meter dash time of 12.29, tying a runner from Galesburg who placed fourth. U.T.'s Joe Robertson won in 12.19 followed by Andrew Burgmeier of Alleman in second at 12.22.

Thurman and Norin both recorded times of 12.55 to finish within the top 10 but out of scoring range in the dash.

Michael Strohmman, Pat Schwigen, Brandon Sandoval and Nick Eberhardt ran the 4x800 meter relay for Geneseo and finished fourth in 9:30.46 to edge out U.T.'s effort at 9:30.90. Moline won the overall competition with a time of 8:54.16.

Among the fourth-place finishers scoring for Geneseo was the Leaflet's 4x400 relay team of Strohmman, Wayne, Joe Curnyn, Travis Puckett finished at 3:58.55, slipping in ahead of Galesburg at 3:58.57. The Silver Streaks claimed the last scoring position. Rock Island won the top points with a time of 3:44.11.

Also scoring in fourth was Jake Willet who hit 110'1" in the discus throw. U.T.'s Johnson was the top hurler with a distance of 124'2".

Also competing in the discus event for Geneseo were Anthony Rokis (101'8"), Kory Klemmer (95'8"), Chris Springer (94'11"), Blank (88'6"), Mike Gawrysiak (88'1"), Adam Hock (83'6"), A. J. Reynolds (83'5"), Steve Griffith (75'9"), Dave Mapes (74'7") and Tim Kabatra (60'8").

Watson added four points to the Leaflet tally with a fourth-place finish in the long jump with a distance of 16'8.5". Kempfer and Kuban also gave long jump efforts and finished at 15'4.5" and 15'2.5", respectively.

Alex DePauw added points with the fourth-place finish in the 400-meter dash, coming through at 56.95. Eric Rodriguez of Moline was the top finisher with a time of 54.75. Strohmman finished just outside of scoring range with a sixth-place time of 58.09. Curnyn also ran the dash and came through at 59.59.

Brandon Sandoval captured the last scoring position in the 800-meter run, taking fifth with a time of 2:20.82. The top time was recorded by Drew Patterson of Moline at 2:13.86. Schwigen also finished in the top 10 with his time of 2:26.65. Puckett took the course in 2:29.35.

Five Leaflets ran the 200-meter with Drummond claiming the final scoring position. His time of 25.13

earned him fifth-place overall. Norin also placed within the top 10 with his time of 26 flat. Others participating were Kuban, 26.24; Watson, 26.27 and Joe Johnson, 27.43.

Kempfer, Andre Jackson, Wickwire and Zak Riley all took part in the 110-meter high hurdles. Kempfer was Geneseo's top finisher at 20.24 followed by Jackson at 20.65. Wickwire was timed at 21.04 while Riley came through in 24.10.

Geneseo's top finisher in the 1600 meter run was Fluck who took ninth overall with a time of 5:30.57. Derek Wahlheim and Michael Stone also competed but no times were kept after 10th place.

This Friday, April 28, the cinder-men head to Pekin for an invitational at 4 p.m. Two underclassmen meets are slated before the John McCormick Invitational hosted by the Leafs on Friday, May 5.

A week's break will prepare the Leafs for the NCIC meet on Friday, May 12.
