

Indoor victory

Leaflets win second indoor meet of year

For the second week in a row the Geneseo boys frosh/soph track team have found success at Westwood Athletic Complex in Sterling, winning their second indoor meet there in as many weeks.

On Tuesday, March 20 the Maple Leaf frosh/soph scored 142 points to defeat teams from Rockton-Hononegah, who finished with 126 points; Sterling, who scored 93; Erie/Prophetstown who scored 72 and Freeport who finished with 53.

The Leaflets displayed very good depth. They won four events and placed more than one athlete in many of the others.

Josh Reschke and Dylan Kenney led a strong effort in the jumping events. Reschke took first place in the triple jump with a leap of 38'4" while Kenney placed second by jumping 35'11-3/4". The duo also placed highly in the long jump where Reschke finished in second place after jumping 18'9" and Kenney took third place with a leap of 18'6 3/4".

Curt Russell finished second in the high jump after clearing a height of 5'8". Reschke placed fifth with a height of 5'4".

Korry Klemmer won the shot put with a throw of 39'9-1/2" while fellow Leaflet Matt Biondi took fourth place by tossing the shot 36'2". Mike Matakas placed sixth with a distance of 35'4-1/2".

Adam Hock vaulted 7'3" to take fourth place in the pole vault.

Geneseo showed good depth on the track as well as in field events. Russell won the 400 meter race with a time of 57.22 seconds and Garrick Wayne finished fourth with a time of 59.42.

Kyle Fluck finished second in the 1600 meter run with a time of 5:08.06. The race was won by a runner from Rockton who claimed victory with a time of 5:07.44.

The 1600 meter relay team of Russell, Wayne, Luke Steinkopf and Luke Thompson took first place with a time of 4:07.01.

Aaron Kuban took second place in the 55 meter dash with a time of 6.88. He also placed third in the 200 meter dash with a time of 25.44. Kenney followed in fourth place with a time of 26.06.

Andre Jackson finished third in the 55 meter high hurdles with a time of 9.81. Thompson finished sixth in the 55 meter low hurdles with a time of 8.79.

Three Leaflets placed in the 3,200 meter run. Christian Rowlands finished in third place with a time of 11:53 while Justin Trujillo took fifth place with a time of 12:37 and Jon Weiser came in sixth with a time of 12:40.

Geneseo's 800 meter relay team of Jackson, Kenney, Kuban and Russell took third place with a time of 1:44.72. The event was won by a team from Rockton-Hononegah who finished in 1:41.28.

Derek Wahlheim finished fifth in the 800 meter run with a time of 2:29.64.

The leaflets will compete at the Gene Shipley Invitational at Browning Field, Moline on Saturday, March 31.
