Time to heal injuries

Leaf boys head back to track today after an eight-day layoff

This week has been a welcome time off for the Geneseo boys track and field team.

It's been eight days since the Maple Leafs were in competition. Today, they return to the track in the Rock Island Invitational.

"Our kids will get in there and mix it up," Snook said of today's meet. "There's a lot of top teams in the meet, but if our relays and sprinters can score, that'll be an ace in the hole for us."

The meet, which mixes local schools against a slew of teams from the suburban Chicago area, is one of the stronger ones in the Leafs' schedule.

Geneseo has finished third in the meet before, but Snook admitted that finish was achieved before the importation of suburban teams.

Last Thursday, they knocked off Galesburg in a home dual meet by the closest of margins, defeating the Streaks, 73-72.

"We're still improving, but we're glad to get the time off," head coach Mel Snook said. "We're coming on, but the guys will have time to heal a bit.

"We've got some guys like Jeremy Heaton, who're overcoming shin splints. He'll have some time to savor this win."

The meet was one where several athletes made

breakthroughs in their chosen events, including senior Heaton, who cleared 13 feet in the pole vault for the first time this year after a sluggish outdoor season start due to those shin splints.

Senior Kyle Wickwire also broke new ground in the jumps, clearing 6-2 in the high jump for the first time this year, and going beyond the 42-foot mark in the triple jump. His high jump was good enough for a victory in that event.

Sophomore Curt Russell posted the fastest 400-meter dash time in any meet Geneseo has competed in this year, running a 51.95-second clocking in that event.


And junior Brian Blank

became the first Maple Leaf shot putter to break the 47-foot mark in the shot, taking first in that event.

"Every time out, we're getting outstanding performances. The kids keep coming on, and it's catching everybody throughout the team," Snook said.

The Leafs also got firsts from sophomore Christian Rowlands (3,200), sophomore Justin Trujillo (800) and the 400-meter relay.

"Our kids are not going to be in awe of anybody," Snook said. "They feel they can compete with anybody. They'll be rested and ready to go (today). I'm looking forward to it."



F/S wins easily

Sophomore hurdler Luke Thompson and freshman jumper Greg Reiling each won a pair of individual events to lift the Geneseo frosh-soph track team to an easy 98-50 home dual-meet victory last Thursday against Galesburg.

Thompson swept the hurdles events, finishing the 110 highs in a time of 17.51 seconds, his best of the season in that event, and won the 300 intermediates in 44.93, also a personal best.

Reiling won the long jump.

with a 17-foot, 6-inch effort, and took first in the triple jump with a leap of 36 feet even.

The Leafs also got individual event victories from Luke Reschke in the high jump. Shane VerStraete in the shot put, Scott Mapes in the discus, Augie Anderson in the 400, Eric Darwin in the pole vault and Brad Mattan in the 1,600,

Geneseo also picked off a first-place finish in the 3,200 relay, finishing with a time of 10:23.74.


