

2nd place for Leafs

Sophomore Justin Trujillo may go down in Geneseo history as one of the school's best 800-meter runners ever.

For now, he'll have to settle for being NCIC champion.

Trujillo broke the 2-minute barrier in the 800 last Friday afternoon at the North Central Illinois Conference varsity boys track and field meet, held on the high school track, winning one of two titles on the day in the process.

It was the first time that Trujillo, who hadn't considered himself an 800-meter runner at the time of indoor season two months ago, had gone under two minutes. His time of 1:59.98 was 1.24 seconds faster than the runnerup in the race.

But Trujillo wasn't done, winning the 1,600 as well, holding off junior teammate Kyle Fluck for the victory. Trujillo ran the "mile" in 4:41.18, .8 seconds faster than Fluck, who's been closing fast as the 2002 track season winds down.

Those were the Leafs' only titles won on a day where Dixon dominated, winning nine individual events enroute to rolling up 175 points and the team title.

To give an idea of how much the Dukes dominated last Friday's team competition, consider that the Leafs, who were second with 80 points, could have doubled their point total—somehow—and still not won the meet.

Geneseo narrowly outpointed Princeton, 80-74, for second, with Sterling a close fourth at 65. Rochelle (42), Ottawa (35), LaSalle-Peru (22), Hall

Township (19), Streator (18), Rock Falls (16), Kewanee (12) and Mendota (zero) rounded out the conference field.

In addition to Fluck's runnerup finish in the mile, three other Geneseo entries also picked up second-place finishes.

Sophomore Curt Russell lost only to Dixon's Stephen Fritts in the 400-meter final, finishing with a time of 50.81 seconds for his runnerup mark.

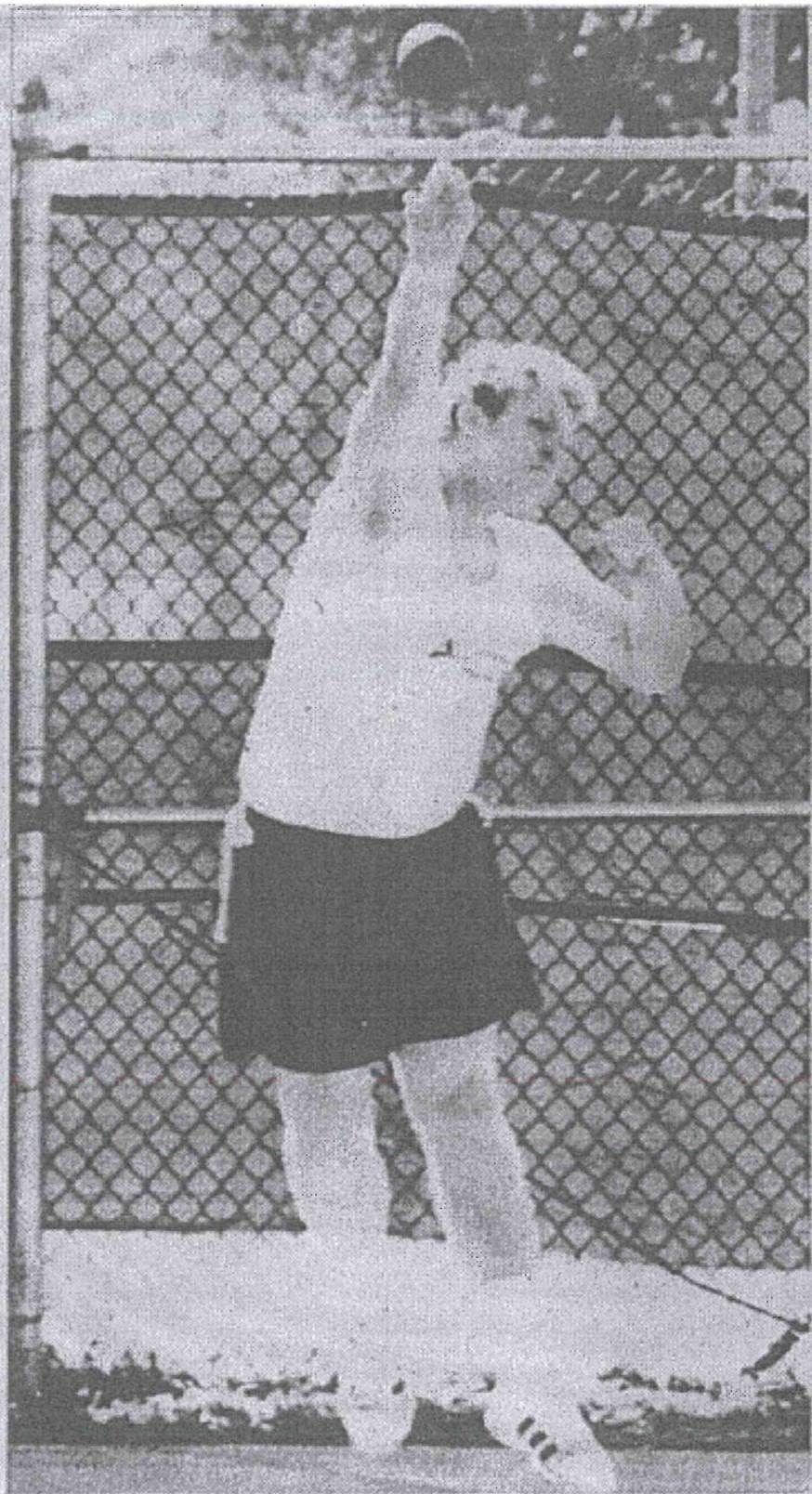
Geneseo also picked up two seconds in relay events, with the 800-meter relay team of Andy Thurman, Jake Swanson, Dylan Kenney and Luke Steinkopf finishing only behind Dixon with a time of 1:34.94.

The 1,600 relay team, consisting of Kenney, Thurman, Kyle Wickwire, and Russell, stayed within half a second of the Dukes, with a time of 3:30.20.

Two Geneseo entrants in the meet won third place medals. Wickwire took third in the triple jump with a leap of 42 feet, 2 inches, while Fluck was third in the 3,200, finishing in a season-best 10:09.12.

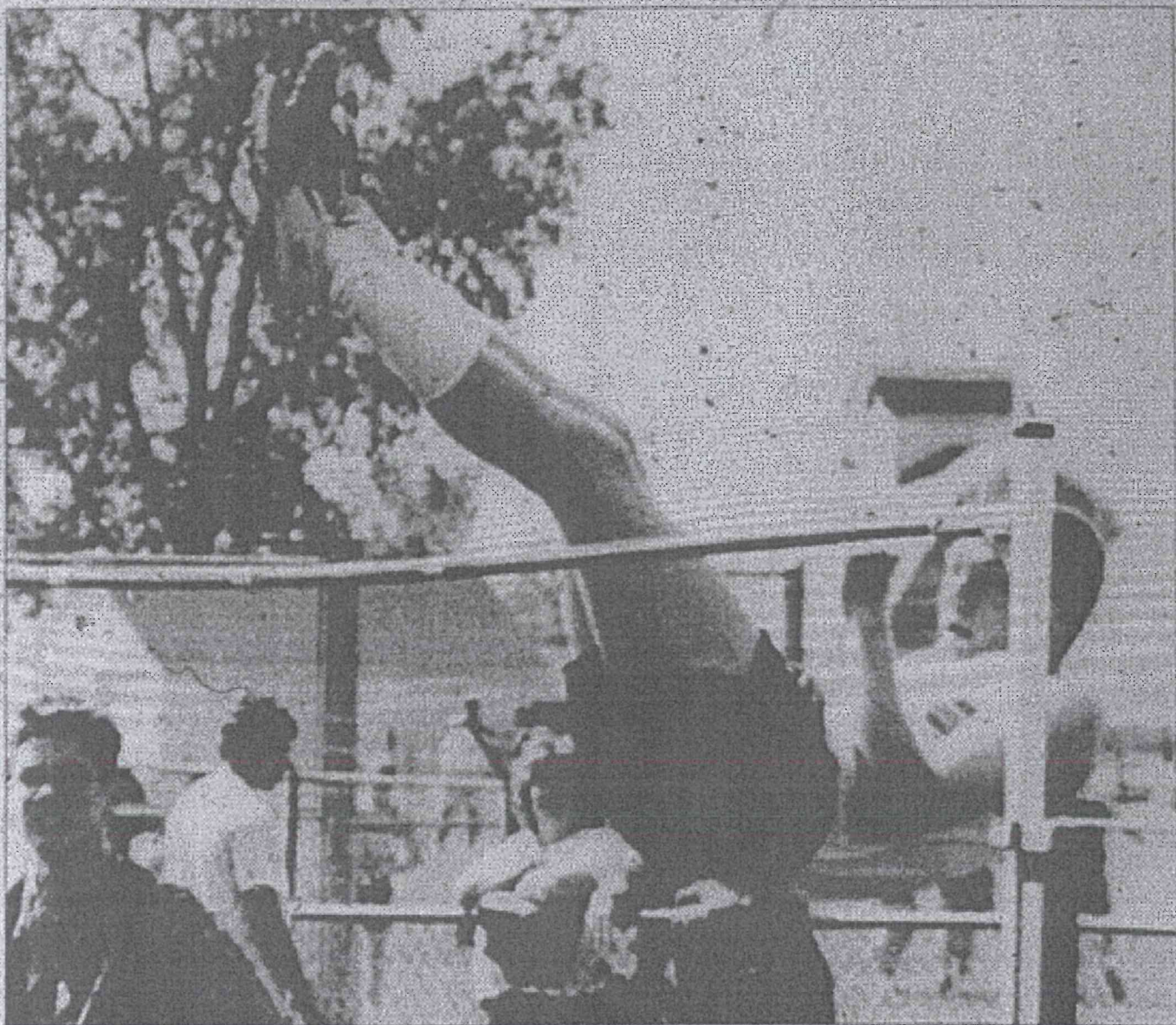
Also placing in the meet for Geneseo were: Jeremy Heaton (4th in pole vault), Kory Klemmer (4th in discus), Kenney (5th in long jump), Christian Rowlands (5th in 3,200) and Luke Thompson (6th in 110 high hurdles).

The Leafs also got sixths from their 400 and 3,200 relay teams. Thurman, Swanson, Aaron Kuban and Steinkopf made up the 400 relay, while the 3,200 relay was run by Matt Arkell, Garrick Wayne, Brad Mattan and Derek Wahlheim.

F/S boys take 4th in NCIC

Geneseo's frosh-soph boys track and field team scored nearly half of its 69 points in the triple jump and shot put events last Friday at the North Central Illinois Conference frosh-soph track meet, held at the high school track.

Sophomores Shane VerStraete and Matt Paulson engineered a 1-2 sweep in the shot, with VerStraete throwing 45 feet, 3 inches, and Paulson throwing 43-5 1/2 for their first and second, respectively.

In the triple jump, it was sophomore Dylan Kenney who was the winner, defeating a Sterling jumper by four inches with a leap of 40-8 for his title. He was joined by freshman teammate Luke Reiling, who was fifth.

Sterling was the runaway team champion, scoring 150 points. Princeton was second with 106, followed by Dixon with 84 and the Leafs with 69, four points ahead of fifth-place Ottawa.

Sixth-place Kewanee was well back of the leaders, with 22 points, followed by Hall (21), Mendota (17), Rochelle (12), Rock Falls and Streator (four points each) and LaSalle-Peru (two).

Three Geneseo entries earned third-place finishes.

Augie Anderson was third in the 100-meter dash, with a time of 12.00 seconds, while Luke Reschke was third in the long jump, with a leap of 17-11 1/8. Geneseo's 3,200 relay team of Kyle Wayne, Jordan Weber, Justin Ogilvie and Justin Hight also took third in 9:37.39.

Other placewinners in the meet for the Leafs were: Scott Mapes (4th in discus), Brad Mattan (4th in 800), Nathan Schlindwein (5th in 3,200), Eric Darwin (5th in pole vault) and Colin Cushman (6th in high hurdles).

The Leafs also took fourth in the 400 relay, fifth in the 800 relay and sixth in 1,600 relay.
