Reschke leads Leafs to second

Geneseo fares well at McCormick track meet



GENESEO — Geneseo sophomore Luke Reschke had never run an open 400-meter race before his first go at it Friday night at the John McCormick Invitational on the Maple Leafs' track.

"In the open, you don't have to worry about letting your teammates down," Reschke said. "The last 100 meters, I started sprinting and went by everybody else. I couldn't believe it. I was really surprised."

Based on his performance, a winning time of 50.9 seconds, he'll be doing it a lot more often in the future.

Reschke's effort — plus wins from senior brother Josh Reschke in the triple jump and junior Justin Trujillo in the 800, plus a first-place showing in the 1,600 relay — paced the Leafs to a second-place finish at the meet.



Dixon, behind a huge sprint effort from Nate Davidson in the 100 and 200, outpointed the Leafs, 115-96. Galesburg, with 33 points, was sixth, while Alleman (28 points) was eighth and Kewanee (3 points) was 12th.

The 1,600 relay — which consisted of Luke Reschke, Luke Steinkopf, Curt Russell and Justin Trujillo — was just a few tenths off of the state-qualifying time and only two-tenths off the Leafs' school record. Geneseo finished in 3 minutes, 24.85 seconds, a full two seconds ahead of Galesburg.

Meanwhile, Trujillo had little trouble winning the 800 by more than three seconds over Dixon's Kel Bond, finishing in 1:58.9.


"I wanted to break 1:58 today, and that obviously didn't happen, but I'll get it," Trujillo said. "There's still work to do. It's not exactly where I want it yet."

That was the case also for Josh Reschke, who needed a big one on his last triple jump to pass the Dukes' Will Mardauss for the victory. Reschke leaped 42 feet, 9 inches for the win.

"He (Mardauss) jumped 42-3, and I had 42- 1/2 inch. I waited for his last jump, and he did like 41-something. So I got pumped up and just popped one," Josh Reschke said. "I've definitely got to get over 43 next week. I've done it before, so there's no excuse to hold back."

Alleman got its lone victory from senior Kile Krol in the 1,600. Krol went to the lead on the race's first turn and was never seriously challenged, finishing in 4:29.2.

"I kind of wanted to get out and see how the pace was going and then pour it on during the last lap," Krol said. "It went really smooth, just the way I want-

Leafs second at McCormick

The Geneseo boys also had am impressive showing at last Friday's John McCormick Invite, taking second place in a very talented field.

Dixon won the meet with 115 points and the Leafs were second with 96.

Princeton was third with 77 points, Peoria Richwoods was fourth with 66 points and Metamora was fifth with 65 points.

Once again, several different Leafs had strong showings for Geneseo.

In the discus, Kory Klemmer was second with a throw of 155' 03".

In the high jump, Kiss was fifth with a leap of 5' 10".

- C. Russell was third in the long jump with a leap of 19' 05 3/4".
- J. Reschke continued his dominating ways in the triple jump, taking first place with a leap of 42' 09".

C. Russell was fourth with a jump of 41' 02".

As far as relays, the Leafs had several top finishes.

The Leafs won the 1600meter relay. The team of L. Reschke, (52.22), Steinkopf (52.27), C. Russell (50.65) and Trujillo (49.57) won the race and set a school record with a time of 3:24.85.

In the 440-meter relay, the team of Luke Steinkopf (11.82), S. Russell (10.34), Aaron Kuban (11.39) and L. Reschke (9.93) took second place with a time of 43.62.

Fluck was second in the 3200 with a time of 10:02.57 and Nathan Schlindwein was sixth with a time of 10:24.69.

Thompson was fifth in the 110-meter high hurdles with a time of 16.00.


In the 100-meter dash, Steinkopf was third with a time of 11.20 and Aaron Kuban was fifth with a time of 11.75.

Trujillo won the 800-meter run with a time of 1:58.81 and was second in the 1600 with a time of 4:35.04.

Another underclassman, Shaun Russell, took sixth in the 200 for Geneseo with a time of 23.49.
