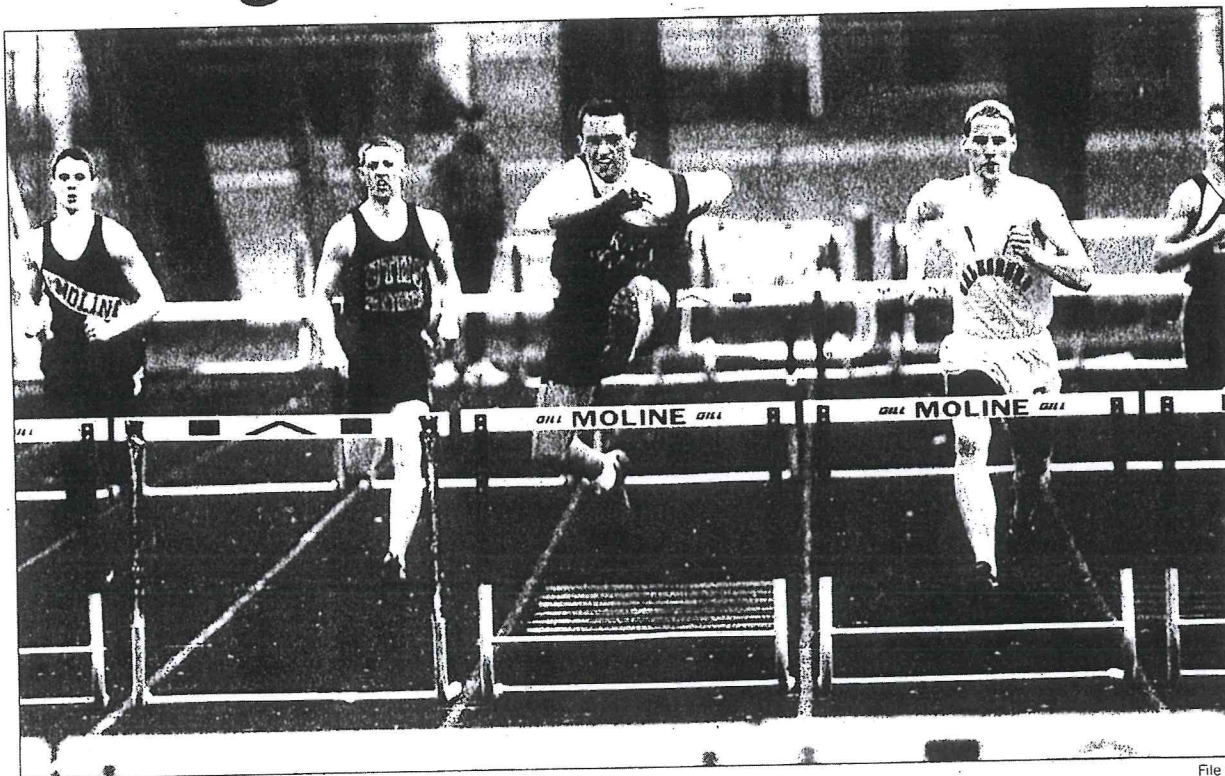


# No big hurdles for these two

## RI's Parer, Moline's Cook could battle in marquee event at Shipley track extravaganza

When Rock Island's Andy Parer and Moline's Aaron Cook raced a month ago at the Quad City Indoors Meet, the race was nearly too close to call.

Parer and Cook matched each other stride-for-stride in the 55-meter high hurdles at Augustana's Peppico Center, breaking the finish line at precisely the same instant.

Unable to determine a winner, race officials had to analyze the finish on the Fully Automated Timing (FAT) camera which replayed the finish in super slow motion. It was only after scrutinizing the tape for several minutes that a winner could be declared.

"I think officially we ran the exact same time, but I guess I was leaning a little more at the tape, so they gave me the win," said Cook.

### 37th annual Gene Shipley Invitational

The co-ed Shipley Invitational is one of the state's largest track meets, with nearly 600 competitors competing in 102 races. For the second straight year, the Shipley will include both girls and boys teams.

■ **Where:** Moline's Browning Field.

■ **When:** Field events begin at 10 a.m. Race organizers will have nine field events going at once. Running events start at 11 a.m. and finish at 4:35 p.m. All races will be finals. Fully Automated Timing (F.A.T.) will be used to determine the top times.

■ **Who'll be there:** There will be 13 girls and 13 boys teams from Illinois and Iowa. Among the QC boys' teams are: Moline, Rock Island, Alleman, United Township, Geneseo, Galesburg, Riverdale, Sherrard, Orion and Monmouth.

gan ran 3:21, just two seconds off the school record.

"Those guys are going to be exciting every time they run," said Rock Island coach Ed Lillis.

Wayland Ryan, who took third in the state 100 and 200, may only see limited action today because

state qualifier in the 100 and 300 hurdles. He dominated those two events in local meets last season.

"Last year he beat me bad every time we raced," said Cook.

At least early in the season, Cook, a junior, may be the area's most improved runner. He's grown three inches to stand 6-1 and gained 20 pounds since last year and already dropped half a second from his previous best times. He's run 14.7 for the 100 hurdles in practice.

"I actually didn't even recognize him," said Parer, who has run 14.2.

Cook started a dedicated lifting program in the offseason and worked on hurdle drills in his garage.

"I got a lot bigger, but I kept my flexibility," Cook said. "It's a lot easier for me to get over the hurdles height-wise and I also have more power to get through the race clean. It's such a difference."



# Leafs take third at Shipley Invitational

## Several Leafs record personal bests

With several Geneseo athletes recording personal bests, the Maple Leafs took third place at the always-tough Gene Shipley Invitational, held Saturday at Moline's Browning Field.

The Rock Island Rocks took first place at the Invite with 266.5 points, followed by Moline with 194 points, followed by the Leafs with 157.5 points.

Geneseo head track coach Mel Snook said he was pleased with his team's showing at the invite.

"Considering the conditions, we were all pleased with the efforts and especially the final results," Snook said.

"It was a real team effort for all the guys who competed," he added.

Snook added that of the 22 Geneseo athletes who entered the meet, 20 placed in one or more events.

Several Leafs had season-best performances en route to the third-place finish.

For starters, Kyle Fluck took second place in the 3200-meter run with a time of 10:07.65.

Three flights were held in each event.

Nathan Schlindwein took third in the B-flight 3200 with a time of 10:46.30 and Tony Lyttles was sixth in the C-flight with a time of 11:12.79.

For all three distance runners, the times were the best of the year.

Next, Justin Trujillo placed fourth in the 1600-meter run with a time of 4:48.46. In the B-flight, Fluck was second with a time of 4:48.07. Schlindwein was third in the C-flight with a time of 5:06.16.

In the 800, Trujillo was second in the A-flight with a time of 2:05.30.

In the 400, Curt Russell took fifth place with a time of 54.19. Aaron Kuban was second in the B-flight with a time of 55.38, while Jim Kiss was fourth in the C-flight with a time of 57.46.

In the 300-meter hurdles, Luke Thompson was eighth with a time of 45.79 and Andre Jackson was fifth in the B-flight with a time of 45.85. Caleb Diericx had his season best time in the 300 hurdles with a time of 47.69, good for fourth place in the C-flight.

Next, Jake Swanson was sixth in the B-flight 100-meter dash, finishing in 12.13. Luke Steinkopf was ninth in the A-flight with a time of 11.86. Kuban was second in the B-flight with a time of 12.10.

In the 200-meter dash, Steinkopf was eighth with a time of 24.47, Luke Reschke was third in the B-flight with a 24.49 and Shaun Russell was fifth in the C-flight with a 25.20.

As far as field events, Josh Reschke and Curt Russell had their best performances of the year in the triple jump.

Reschke was second in the A-flight with a leap of 42-07.75, while Russell won the B-flight with a 40-03.

In the high jump, L. Reschke was fourth in the A-flight (5-10), J. Reschke was second in the B-flight (5-8) and Kiss was first in the C-flight with a jump of 5-10.

In the discus, Kory Klemmer was third with a throw of 144-07. Chris Springer was second in the B-flight with a 124-11. Scott Mapes was third in the C-flight with a throw of 116-01.

Shane VerStraete placed fourth in the B-flight shot put with a throw of 43 feet even. Klemmer was eighth in the A-flight (43-03), while Matt Paulson was sixth in the C-flight with a throw of 39-03.

Alex Henry was fourth in the pole vault, clearing 10 feet. Eric Darwin was fifth in the B-flight (8') and S. Russell was third in the C-flight, clearing nine feet.

The team heads to Galesburg Thursday for a meet at 4:30 p.m. After that, the team is off until the Apr. 25 Rock Island Invite.

## Rocks throw down gauntlet in runaway Shipley victory

Rock Island thrower Marcus King was almost offhanded when he discussed his expectations for Saturday's Gene Shipley Invitational. Bundled in sweats and wiping his shot put with chalk, a focused King seemed immune to the frigid morning temperatures at Moline's Browning Field.

"We want to sweep all six discus and shot events and set meet records in each one those flights," shrugged King.

If King and the Rocks hadn't nearly pulled off the feat, the senior's goals would have seemed absurdly lofty. But Rock Island took first place in five of the six shot and discus events in the A-B-C format meet and set three meet records in the process, laying the groundwork for a dominating Rocky performance.

The Rocks defended their Shipley Invitational title by scoring a team-high 266.5 points. Moline finished second in the 13-team meet with 194 points, Geneseo was third with 157.5 points and Bettendorf took fourth with 111 points.

"It worked out just as we were hoping," said Rock Island coach Ed Lillis. "The discus guys got us going. We set two meet records right off the bat. Then we got down to the track and it continued to be pretty good."

Rocky's weight crew threw down the gauntlet early when Eddie Williams and Zachary Johnson set meet records in the discus B- and C-flights, throwing 159-feet, 4-inches and 144-7, respectively. Williams later set the shot put B-flight record, with a toss of 159-4. King won the A-flight shot put, but finished fourth in the discus.

"We don't mean to sound too proud or boast, but we have high expectations of ourselves," said Williams. "There's a lot of talent on this team, but we feel like we have to prove ourselves every time we compete."

In all, Rock Island set five meet records. Terrell Williams jumped 20-1.5 to set a long-jump C-flight record and also ran 42.39 to set a 300 hurdles B-flight record.

Rocky also made clean sweeps of all three flights of the

100 and 400. Competing in his first track meet, Brandin Smith took first in the 400 C-flight.

Watching the high-powered Rocks work at full tilt, there were more than a few observers who commented that Rock Island seems to be a legitimate contender for the Class AA team title this spring.

"They're stacked in everything," said Moline hurdler Aaron Cook. "Right now, everybody else is playing for second. We'd like to beat them, but it's not very realistic."

Cook broke up a potential Rocky sweep of the 110 high hurdles, when he captured first place in the 110 A hurdles. Cook edged Davenport North's Kenon Christian and Rock Island's Andy Parer, winning in 14.92.

"Rocky doesn't need all those points," said Cook jokingly, who also took fourth in the A long jump, third in the A triple jump and third in the A 300 hurdles. "Why can't I steal a few?"

During the indoor season, Cook failed to finish first only once in the 55 hurdles, when he lost by .08 at the Top Times Invite in Champaign.

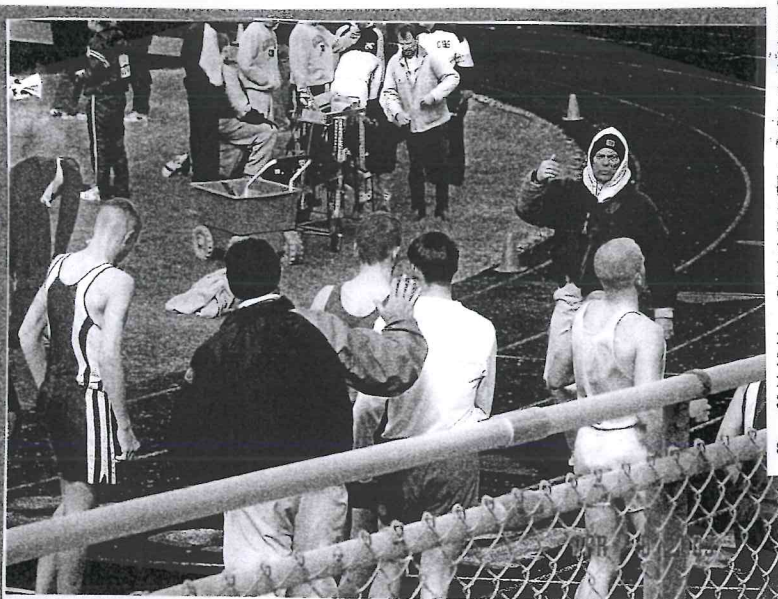
"I think last year at Shipley I finished second or third in the 110 hurdles," said Cook. "I was in awe of watching the guys in the A flight run. I couldn't believe it. Now I'm in their shoes. It's a really neat experience."

Moline's Erik Steffens finished third in the 3,200 and second in the 1600 to Alleman's Kile Krol.

Krol, who had a breakthrough season last fall when he finished 17th at the Class A state cross country meet, appears to be in good form early this spring. The senior won the 1,600 in 4:30, tying his previous best time.

"To hit my PR this early in the season is really great," said Krol, who also won the 800 B flight. "I didn't run as much as I would have liked over the winter, but I did do a lot of lifting. As soon as I get some more mileage, I hope my mile time drops even more."

Alleman's Matt Graff took first (2:02.23) in the 800 A flight.
