# Leaf track looks to make mark at State

Five Geneseo athletes to compete in

State Championship meet in Charleston

Geneseo boys track will be very well represented this weekend at the State Championship meet in Charleston following a stellar fourth place showing as a team in the Rock Island Sectional.

The Leafs scored 55-1/2 points, missing third place by only two.

A total of five athletes will be competing in the State meet following their strong performances at the Sectional. Curt Russell won the Sectional high jump competition. Russell cleared the bar at 6' 6" to win the event.

Byron Stanley is also going to State in the high jump. Stanley grabbed the second spot when he cleared 6' 3".

Justin Trujillo is the other Geneseo athlete advancing to the State meet in an individual event. Trujillo won the 800m run with a very fast time of 1:57.04.

Trujillo and Curt Russell will join Shaun Russell and Luke Reschke on the 1600m relay team at State. The team won the event at the Sectional with a time of 3:23.56. They were two seconds faster than the second place group.

Though not advancing to Charleston, several other Geneseo athletes were very good last weekend at the Sectional.

Scott Mapes had a strong day in the discus throw. Mapes' fur-

thest throw landed 143' 7" away.

Reschke had a good day in the long jump as well. He finished 11th with a jump of 18' 10-1/2".

Shaun Russell finished sixth in the pole vault, clearing 12' 3".

The 3200m relay team consisting of Nate Silver, Dustin Brewer, Kyle Wayne and Blake Widick took sixth place. They finished with a time of 8:44.74.

The 400m relay team just missed advancing to the State meet, grabbing the third spot and missing the time qualifier by only one second. The team of Kevin Powell, Reschke, Shaun Russell and Curt Russell ran a 44.21. Shaun Russell ran his 100 meters in an amazing 10.27 seconds.

The 800m relay team of Powell, Reschke, Shaun Russell and Curt Russell was also third. They ran a 1:32.03.

Nathan Schlindwein was seventh in the 3200m run. He finished at 10:03.93. Christian Rowlands was 12th in the event at 10:52.

Geneseo's top hurdler, Josh Forbes, finished the 110m hurdles in third at the Sectional. Forbes ran a 15.03 and missed qualifying for state based on his time by only three tenths of a second.

Curt Russell and Stanley will begin their day in the high jump this morning with the first flight

scheduled for 9 a.m.

If they advance to the finals, they will jump on Saturday at II a.m.

Trujillo is set to run in the prelims of the 800m run at 10:35 this morning. If he makes

it to the finals, he will run on Saturday at 2 p.m.

The 1600m relay team will run their preliminary heat at 12:25 this afternoon. The final race for Shaun Russell, Curt Russell, Reschke and Trujillo

will be at 3:30 p.m. Saturday if they advance from day one.

This season the Geneseo boys track team finished second in the NCIC. They also placed third as a team at the competitive McCormick Invite.


However, the Rock Island High School senior still said farewell to Rocky's Public Schools Stadium in an awesome way Friday.

Davis won the 400, ran on the victorious 400 relay and qualified for state in two other relay events as the Rocks ran away with the AA boys sectional track title.

Rock Island rolled up 124 points to easily outdistance arch-rivals Moline (66.5) and United Township (57.5). Geneseo (55.5) was fourth in a meet delayed a hour by the threat of lightning.

"It's always a good day when you win," Davis said after his 1600 relay finished second to a fantastic meet-capping run by Geneseo's foursome of Justin Trujillo, Curt and Shaun Russell and Luke Reschke.

"It's all right that we didn't win that last race. We had a teammate hurt, and didn't run that race as fresh as we will next week. The important thing is that we're going to Charleston. That's four years now in the 4-by-4, now hopefully we can beat our best, a fourth-place finish."

Davis, who will skip the 400 next week to concentrate on the relays, led a Rocky contingent of 10 event qualifiers, including seven solo events.

Teammates Eddie Williams (shot put, discus) and Anthony Lloyd (triple and long jump) advanced in two events, win-

ning one each.

Waylond Ryan, K,C. Martin and Derrick Partman ran on the 400 and 800 relay with Davis, though neither Martin nor Ryan qualified in the solo sprints. Injured most of this season, Ryan won the 200 state title last spring, and finished second in the 100.

Zack Johnson (discus champ) and Brandon Jones (shot put runner-up) also qualified in solo events. Raphael Brown, Luke Vanlandegan and Darin Holmes teamed with Davis on the 1600 relay.

"Qualifying in two events is special on every other team but ours," said Lloyd, the triple jump champ. "We finished second at state last year, and showed we're in the running for a state team title again this year.'

Moline's Aaron Cook was a two-event sectional winner, sweeping the hurdles.

"This has been a goal of mine since I was freshman," said Cook, who had teammates Mike Verre (800) and Erik

Steffens (1600) also advance to state.

"And, I barely did it (winning the 300 intermediate hurdles by six-hundreths of a second), Conditioning played a big part in that, my little one month vacation away for my hamstring.

"I was tired, and I was behind (Dixon's Mike Wakeley) on the straightaway. But, I just gutted it out. I broke form there, and did a little gazelle leap to get over the last two hurdles — anything to win.'

United Township's Jon Hood also qualified with runner-up finishes in the 100 and 200. UT's Jordan Jennings (400) and the Panthers' 3200 relay team of Jennings, Pete Martinez, Kyle Cameron and Brian Getz also advanced.

DeVontae Brooks (long jump) was UT's only event winner, though.

"It's just indescribable to win an event at the sectional," said Brooks, who improved two feet over his best jump last year. "It's just a big payoff for all of my hard work."

Geneseo's Curt Russell (high jump) and Justin Trujillo (800) won solo events, as well as powering the Leafs to the 1600 relay win.

"I was already going in the high jump, but I wanted to get some other teammates down to state," Russell said after running a 48.7 third leg, when Geneseo went from third to first in the 1600 relay.

Geneseo's Byron Stanley also advanced in the high jump.
