

Princeton individuals win over Geneseo team effort

Geneseo got its best performance of the season from several boys, but the depth of the Leafs couldn't overcome Princeton's first place power in a triangular meet Tuesday afternoon in Princeton.

Princeton scored 80 points, Geneseo 68 points, and Dixon had 38. The Tigers won 11 of the 18 events. Geneseo won only four, and Dixon won three.

Frank Gardner went just beyond 20 feet to win the long jump. It was Gardner's first 20-foot jump this season.

Gary Ong and Neal Rasmussen placed first and second in the triple jump, with both athletes soaring a bit beyond 40 feet.

This was another of Princeton's all-metric meets, meaning all times and distances have to be converted in order to be evaluated in terms of feet and yards, etc.

Pete Poulos ran Geneseo's best quarter mile of the season, a converted :52.4, placing second in the 400-meter dash.

Geneseo's other best came in the high jump, where Gary Cathelyn leaped 6 feet for a second-place finish.

Geneseo swept the 110-meter high hurdles, with Paul Depauw taking first in :16.1 and Gary Ong second in :16.7. The times here are the same as they would be in the 120-yard race.

Dave R. Anderson of the Leafs was second in the 100-meter dash, won by Princeton's Dave Lowdermilk in the equivalent of :10.5 seconds.

Geneseo's 400-meter relay team avenged Princeton's win seven days earlier and won Tuesday with a converted time of :46.0.

Other second place finishes for the Leafs were by Depauw in the low hurdles, by Poulos in the 200-meter dash, and by Tim Felske in the shot put.

Frosh-soph win 11 of 18 to dominate triangular

Geneseo's frosh-soph track team won 11 of 18 events, including all four relays, in an easy triangular meet win over Dixon and Princeton Tuesday afternoon in Princeton.

Geneseo scored 91 points, compared with 55 for Dixon and 40 for Princeton.

Dave F. Anderson and Randy Russell both won a pair of events for the Leaflets, and both ran on two winning relay teams.

Anderson won the 100 and 200 meter dash events, and Russell took the 300 meter low hurdles and the long jump.

Bruce Borkgren won the 110-meter high hurdles for Geneseo, Dennis Robertson won the triple jump, and Ken Peal won the Pole vault.
