Geneseo senior Sid Anderson has pulled away from " Dixon's anchor runner helping the Maple Leafs to a school record in the two-mile relay during the Geneseo Night Relays Tuesday night, May 25.

Anderson, a fine performer for Geneseo this year, teamed with Doug Longman, Jeff Fitzgerald and Dean Verplaetse for an 8:17.9 time, shaving off two seconds for a new school and meet record.

If Neal Rasmussen tells you he ate gunpowder prior to Tuesday's Geneseo Night Relays, he might not be pulling your leg.

Rasmussen almost went to the moon. He triple jumped 44 feet. 4 inches. That's even farther than Forrest Lowes jumped way back in 1893.

Sterling won the eight-team Night Relays with 82 points. Galeshurg beat Geneseo 66-64 to win a battle for second place. Dixon was fourth with 62 points. East Moline and Rock Island were not strong without their roll squadsocand finished wellback. As usual, the 39th Night Relays were for non-qualifiers to the State Meet.

Rasmussen's jump was a winner, of course. His former school record was 42 feet. 7 inches, set last Friday night at the district meet in Moline. Neal had another jump over 43 feet Tuesday night.

Oh, yeah. In case you didn't scour the Republic a couple works back Editor Jim Terry wrote a story about roffeed Lowes, who won two state

championships for Geneseo in 1893, including the triple jump with a 43-foot-plus leap. That mark never was included in the Geneseo record books, but now it doesn't have to be, anyway. Rasmussen is the best, this century and last.

Something else that was the Line was Geneseo's two-mile relay team. Doug Lima Taff

Fitzgerald, Dean Verplaetse and Sid Anderson ran 8:17.9, beating the meet and school record by two full seconds. Verplaetse gave Geneseo the lead, and Anderson pulled away from Dixon the last 330 yards. Geneseo improved all season in this event.

Gary Cathelyn was Geneseo's third winner, taking the high jump with a six-foot leap.

Freshman ——dw Russell long jumped 20 feet, 2 inches, to take second. Gary Ong was fourth in the high hurdles and ran his best time. :15.7, recorded in the preliminaries. Gary, a junior, reduced his time in this event 1.2 seconds this season.

Senior Dave Stevens continued to improve in his final meet. He took fourth in the 330-yard low hurdles with his best time ever, :40.5.

Geneseo got third place finishes from Tim Felske in the shot put, and from the mile medley and sprint medley relay teams. leams.
