Frosh-soph track team 1st in Mendota's Invitational

Geneseo frosh soph won just two events—but placed second in nine others—and the Leaflets won—the Mendota frosh-soph invitational meet run Monday afternoon in Mendota.

An outstanding second-place effort was sophomore Greg Himmelman's discus throw of 135 feet, 4 inches, which was beaten by a record effort by an athlete from Rock Falls.

Randy Russell, a freshman, long jumped 19 feet, 3 inches, but was beaten. And Dennis Robertson triple jumped 37 feet, 4 inches, and jost by less than one inch.
