Geneseo's freshman track team performed well recently in the Rock Island Ninth Grade Invitational. No team points were kept, although the Leaflets would have been at or near the top.

Dennis Robertson set a meet record with a triple jump of 38 feet, 10 1/2 inches. Norm Singbush was another winner, and tied the meet record with a high jump of 5 feet, 8 inches.

Chris Ford won the discus with a throw of 118 feet, and placed second in the shot put. Bruce Borkgren was second in the 120-yard high hurdles, and

Dave F. Anderson was second in the triple jump.

Getting third place finishes were Borkgren in the pole vault, Robertson in the long jump, and Robertson in the high hurdles.

Robertson was fourth in the high jump, and Randy Russell was fourth in the 330-yard low hurdles. Geneseo's 880-yard and mile relay teams placed fourth.

Schools competing included Franklin, Edison, Central and Washington junior high schools from Rock Island, John Deere, Coolidge, and Wilson junior highs from Moline, Galesburg, Muscatine, Alleman, East Moline, and Geneseo.
