

Top performances aid Leaf boys in win over Alleman

Turning in their best performances of the season in several events, Geneseo's varsity track team won 13 of the 17 events and pinned a 97-43 defeat on Rock Island Alleman in a dual meet run Thursday, April 21, on the Geneseo track.

Senior Dennis Brooks was a double winner for the Leafs, claiming the discus with his best toss of the season, 146 feet, 8 inches, while also taking honors in the shot put with a toss of 47 feet, 1/2 inch. Geneseo swept both weight events, as Ed Ryan and Jeff DeNeve took second and third, respectively, in the discus, while Jeff Wachtel and Jerry Hartsock were second and third in the shot.

Senior Mark Nordstrom turned in one of the best half-mile times in the area all season, 1:59.3, as he won a dual with Garron Grigsby of Alleman.

The Leafs have been working with various combinations in the mile relay all season, and found a quartet who clicked quite well in this meet. Red Anderson, Pete Poulos, DeNeve and Dan Carton turned in Geneseo's best time, 3:37.1.

It was a day of diversified interests for DeNeve. In addition to this contribution in the discus and mile relay, he also won the pole vault with a leap of 11 feet.

The Leafs showed more wallop in the 440 than they have for some time. Pete Poulos won in a crisp :52.3, while Red Anderson was second in :53.1.

Doug Longman gave Geneseo another steady performance in the mile, winning in 4:37.5.

Geneseo continued to show power in the 120-yard high hurdles, as Gary Ong, Dennis Robertson and Larry Boyles swept the event for Geneseo. Ong's winning time was :15.8.

Leaf sophomores defeat Alleman

Geneseo failed in the two distance events, but won everything else as the Leaf sophomores defeated Alleman 119-22 in a meet run Thursday, April 21 in Geneseo.

It was an Alleman athlete, though, who turned in the most memorable run of this meet. And, it wasn't even a guy. Mary Doak won the two-mile run in 11:04.5, holding off a pretty good Geneseo runner, Bob Fitzgerald, to do it. Geneseo fans may not have been aware that they were watching perhaps one of the fastest two miles ever run by a girl in Illinois.

The all-time Illinois best for a girl is 10:54.5, which won the State Meet last year. The all-time national best for a girl is 10:41.9. Mary Doak runs with the Alleman boys because the school doesn't have a girls track team. Last year, she didn't get to compete in the State Meet for girls because Alleman officials failed to get her qualified in time. Hopefully, she'll get a chance this season.

Geneseo won 14 of the 16 events. Bruce Borkgren won both hurdle races, taking the 120-yard highs in :16.2, and the 330-yard lows in :45.0. Borkgren led a Leaflet sweep in the highs, as Lance Hofer and Kevin DeBleck came in second and third.

Geneseo swept four other events. Randy Farrell, Scott Rink and Bob Johnson swept the 220, Farrell winning in :25.0. Jay Siefker, Norm Singbush and Borkgren were one-two-three in the pole vault, Siefker clearing 10 feet, 6 inches.

Dave Jeffress cleared 5-8 in the high jump, and was trailed by Singbush and Tom Hart. And, in the triple jump, Lance Hofer won with a leap of 37 feet, 1/2 inch, while Brad Fleming and Singbush were second and third.

Chris Ford won the discus with a good throw, 125 feet, 7 inches, while Mike Stohl's fine effort of 42 feet, 5 1/4 inches won the shot put for Geneseo.
