

Geneseo boys and girls win 33rd annual Kewanee relays

About the only problem Geneseo's varsity girls and boys track teams had Tuesday night in Kewanee was a decision.

Should the school's championship trophy ride home in the boys bus, or should it ride home in the girls bus? All decisions should be so difficult! After no argument at all, the spoils of victory came back with the girls.

The combined Leaf teams rolled to victory in the 33rd annual H. F. Brockman Relays, winning 14 of the 24 events to easily outdistance a five-school field. Geneseo totaled 178 1/2 points, while Kewanee was well back with 121.

It was the first time Geneseo has won an outright championship in this meet, formerly called the Kewanee Relays. The Leaf boys shared a crown with Rock Falls in 1975. The format was changed last year, with the scores of the girls and boys meets added to determine the overall champion.

Both squads rolled in their respective divisions. The boys outpointed second-place Princeton 96 1/2 to 59 1/2, while the girls had an 82-61 1/2 margin over the Kewanee girls. The boys, though, competed in 13 events, while the girls ran in 11 events.

There were 14 relays, worth 10 points each, and Geneseo athletes won nine of them. The boys won three; the girls won six, and set new meet records in all six, and new school records in four of those.

Both squads scored seven victories apiece. The only record to fall in the older boys division was a 41 foot, 9 1/2 inches triple jump by Geneseo's Dave Anderson, and he was backed by a second place finish by Gary Ong.

Another one-two Leaf finish came in the shot put, where Dennis Brooks threw 49 feet, 10 inches to top second-place Wayne Strader.

Frank Gardner cleared 5 feet, 11 inches to win the high jump, and Randy Russell long jumped 18 feet, 7 inches for a win.

The fleet relay unit of Strader, Pete Poulos, Red Anderson and Dave Anderson captured the 440 relay in :45.0,

and the 880 relay in 1:34.6, an excellent time on Kewanee's cinder track.

Geneseo's 480-yard low hurdle shuttle relay team led all the way, and blew the race open during Dennis Robertson's anchor run. Gary Ong led off, followed by Randy Farrell and Bruce Borkgren.

For the Leaf girls, the only individual winner was Jacquie Fields, who won the shot put with a toss of 33 feet, 10 inches.

All six Geneseo relay wins were meet records; this was only the second year for girls competition in this meet. Four of Geneseo's wins were in school record times, and it was also just the second time Geneseo girls have run these particular races.

One school mark came in the frosh-soph 440 relay, and it may stand for a while. Jacquie Carton, Lori Colo, Deanne DeFauw and Janice Jacobs clocked :52.36, which is just a bit slower than the varsity school record. It was a superb time on the Kewanee track. The school record had been :56.9, set last year by DeFauw, Kris Davis, Penny Kelsall and Michele Young.

In the mile medley, Vicki Fleming, Kris Davis, Nancy Swain and Mary Herold ran 4:32.4. The school mark had been 4:50.9, by Julie Luedtke, Fleming, Molly Neuleib, and Laurie Smith.

In the 440-yard low hurdle shuttle, the team of Penny Kelsall, Charee Hodgson, Brenda Hulet and Sherri Anderson stepped off the distance in 1:06.8. Last year, Gale Griffith, Lori Pettit, Michele Young and Kathy Moore had clocked 1:09.0. The new time AVERAGES out to :16.5 seconds per 110-yard leg. Before this season, only two girls in the school's history had

run the 110-yard lows in :16.5 or better.

A spirited third leg by Kelli Davis helped spark the mile relay team to victory in 4:19.1. Sherri Anderson led off, DeFauw was next, and Nancy Swain anchored.

The 880 relay team sizzled, turning in an excellent time of 1:51.6 on the cinders. The school record is 1:50.3. Runners this time were Colo, Kris Davis, Fleming and Jacobs.

The varsity 440 relay team of Carton, Anderson, Fleming and Jacobs woo in :52.1, another crisp time on the Kewanee track, and a time not far off the school record.
