Geneseo athletes fail to make finals in state track

Geneseo High School athletes Mark Nordstrom and Dave Anderson failed to make the finals in last weekend's State Track and Field Meet in Charleston, but they turned in creditable performances nevertheless.

Senior Nordstrom, who passed up graduation exercises in order that he might participate in his first State Meet, was seventh in his heat of 12 runners, and posted a time of 1:59.7. There were three flights of 12 runners each in Friday's preliminaries in the Class AA competition.

Nordstrom's time was not his lastest of the season - he got to

state by running a school-record 1:58.0 at the District Meet in Moline the preceding Friday. Even so, it was one of the Geneseo senior's better times of the season. He led the race for a brief time.

Nordstrom would have had to run 1:56.5 in order to make the 12 runner finals on Saturday. In those finals, a time of 1:52.8 took fifth place; the stunning time of 1:50.05 won the state championship.

Sophomore Dave Anderson was third in his heat of the triple jump with a leap of 43 feet, 9 inches, which equaled his personal best this season. A number of athletes leaped in the 46-to-48-foot range, and the winning jump was 49 feet, 7 inches.

Geneseo's third qualifier, senior high jumper Frank Gardner, did not attend the State meet.

Several area athletes performed well, including Rock Falls' spectacular freshman sprinter, Ted Nehrkorn, who turned in a remarkable :9.7 clocking in the preliminaries of the 100-yard dash; the second fast time in the prelims. That's some two-tenths of a second faster than he had run two weeks earlier at the NCIC meet in Geneseo. Nehr-

korn took seventh place in the finals, but wasn't able to equal that :9.7 clocking again.

A new scoring system was employed this year, with points being awarded through eight places. First place was good for 10 points, second for 8, and so on down the line.

To show how strong the State Meet field was this year, one only need look at the point total of Sterling. The Black Hawk District champions, fielding one of the best teams Sterling has ever fielded, scored just one point at Charleston. That came on an eighth-place finish in the two-mile run by junior Pat Cross. Before this year, eighth-place would not even have counted.

East St. Louis Senior and Bloom tied for the state team championship in Class AA.

Dean McKillip, the outstanding Galesburg stillete who wowed Geneseo fans with a 61-foot-plus shot put effort at the Geneseo Invitational, won the state championship in that event, with a throw just beyond the 60-foot range.

Gail Olson, Sycamore's spectacular sophomore high jumper, captivated the audience with his national record-setting leap of 7 feet, 3% inches.
