Having gotten his lower body over the bar, Geneseo's Bruce Borkgren has let go of the pole and is concentrating on getting his arms over to complete a successful vault attempt during Tuesday's triangular meet against Dixon and Princeton. Bruce made it, clearing 12 feet, 6

inches, his best effort of the spring. It netted him second place to James of Dixon in this meet. Borkgren is one of the host of candidates vying for the pole vaulting positions on this year's Leaf varsity track team.

It was sunny, calm, (for a change,) and the temperature wasn't too bad.

Finally, a decent day for track and field. To some extent, though, the coaches felt their athletes didn't quite achieve some of the times they had been shooting for when Geneseo hosted Dixon and Princeton in a varsity triangular meet Tuesday afternoon, May 2.

The times and marks weren't bad though, especially for the Maple Leafs, who won 10 of the 17 events and rolled to an easy win. Geneseo scored 80½ points; Dixon had 44½, and Princeton totaled 44.

One season's best for Geneseo came in the 120-yard high hurdles, where Bruce Borkgren won in :15.4, with Barry Roberts second in :15.45.

In the 100, junior Dave M. Anderson clocked a solid :10.4, just a step ahead of senior Dave R. Anderson, who was second in :10.5.

Dave R. Anderson and Dan Carton were one-two in the 440, Anderson clocking :51.8.

Roberts continued to do well in the 330-yard low hurdles, winning this time in :40.7.

Dennis Robertson uncorked his best long jump of the spring, 20 feet, 3¼ inches, to beat Randy Russell, who was second at 19-11¼.

Chris Stohl took fourth in the shot put, but got a respectable distance of 47 feet.

Chadd swept the 220. Anderson ran :23.5; Chadd, looking stronger and faster, was at :23.6.

Dave M. Anderson triple jumped 40 feet, 9¼ inches, and beat McKlain of Princeton by a quarter inch.

Bruce Borkgren hit a personal best in the pole vault, 12-6, and took second.

Frosh-soph win 7 of 11 events; win triangular

Winning 11 of 17 events, Geneseo's frosh-soph track team buried Princeton and Dixon in a triangular meet Tuesday afternoon, May 2, in Geneseo.

The Leaflets totaled 94 points, to 47½ for Princeton and, and 36½ for Dixon.

Geneseo's Scott Rink stepped off a :10.5 time in the 100, his best of the spring, and a time believed to equal the school record for a frosh-soph meet. He also took the 220 in :23.9.

Dave Paxson of Geneseo won a dandy race to the tape with Koch of Princeton in the 440, Paxson getting the win on a lean. Both runners were timed in :55.8.

Jeff Renihan had plenty left on the last lap of the mile, and lowered his winning time under five minutes to 4:58.8.

Kevin DeBlieck won both hurdle races for Geneseo. Jay Penney nipped Brad Fleming in the long jump, and Fleming won the triple jump.

Geneseo was also successful in the two-mile, 440, and mile relay events.

The next-and last-meet for the frosh-soph team will be May 12 in Geneseo, when the Leaflets try to defend the school's frosh-soph title in the NCIC meet.
