

Geneseo sophs edged by Mendota Meteors

Rock Falls' strong corps of underclass sprinters managed to score often enough to fend off Geneseo as the Meteors won the Mendota frosh-soph Invitational boys track meet Monday night, April 24, in Mendota.

Rock Falls was buoyed by the appearance of its great sophomore sprinter Ted Nehr Korn, who probably is the best varsity sprinter in the NCIC. In a frosh-soph meet, he's really in a class of his own.

Rock Falls won seven events, Geneseo won six, and the Meteors edged Geneseo 72-67 for first place honors. Like the Princeton Invitational, held the next evening for varsity athletes, this meet involves the six schools in the Southwest Division of the NCIC conference.

Bryan Colbert won the 1500 meter run for Geneseo, getting credit for nipping Hubbard of Mendota at the tape. Both runners were timed in 4:28.6 for the metric mile.

Keith Kincaid won the 800 meter run by a half second over Cassidy of Rochelle.

Mike Stohl won the discus at 116 feet, 8 inches, about three feet beyond the competition.

Tom Hart cleared 5-8 in the high jump, and won on basis of fewer misses at lower heights.

The Leaflets also won the 3200 and 1600 meter relay events, and by wide margins both times.

Geneseo got a strong second from Scott Rink in the 200 meter dash. Rink ran :23.9, to winner Nehr Korn's clocking of :23.6.

Brad Fleming was second in the triple jump, and Kevin DeBlieck was runnerup in the 110-meter high hurdles. The Leaflets also got a second from the 400-meter relay team.
