# Rochelle tower topples in wind

Area track fans are hoping Friday will be sunny and warm when Geneseo hosts the annual NCIC boys track and field meet.

Geneseo hosted the meet last spring, and Rochelle was supposed to host it this year. But winds toppled a light tower in the Rochelle stadium, and conference officials decided to move the meet back to Geneseo.

About 500 athletes, representing frosh-soph and varsity track teams from the 12 conference schools, will compete.

Preliminaries will start at 2 p.m. on Friday.

The first final event will get under way at 6 p.m., with the last event, the varsity mile relay, set for a 9:30 p.m. start.

Admission fee for the evening session will be \$2 for adults, and \$1 for students.

Concessions will be available at the stadium.

Participating schools are Sterling, LaSalle-Peru, Dixon, Kewanee, Streator, Ottawa, Geneseo, Rochelle, Mendota, Princeton, Rock Falls, and Hall Township.

Sterling, fielding perhaps its greatest team ever under veteran Coach DuWayne Dietz, is expected to have little trouble retaining the varsity team championship it rolled to last year. The battle for freshman-sophomore honors should be much tighter, with Sterling, Rock Falls and Geneseo struggling for the crown won by Geneseo last spring.

The NCIC meet usually produces some of the better performances in the state, and this year should be no exception.

Sterling boasts the state's premier pole vaulter, Jim Pierce, who has 15-foot capabilities. Pierce bruised his hip when he slid off the pole and landed in the box at the Lockport Invitational Friday night, but he's expected to be at full

strength for Friday's meet.

Sterling's Walt Divers is a consistent performer in the long and triple jumps. He's a consistent 21-6 leaper in the long jump, making him one of the state's best. He gets beyond 44 feet in the triple jump, but he could be challenged there by his own teammate, versatile Doug McCoy, and by Geneseo's Dave M. Anderson.

Sterling co-captain Pat Cross appears to be the best distance runner, with a 9:18.4 best in the two-mile run, while performing consistently at the 4:20 level in the mile. Competition from Princeton's Steve Arch could produce some outstanding times in both races.

Rock Falls sophomore Ted Nehr Korn ran a :9.7 100-yard dash in last year's State Meet, although he's yet to match that this spring. He should be pushed in the 100 by the Sterling duo of Divers and Monte Eldert, both

much trouble doing it again. There could be an interesting battle for second place between Kewanee and Wethersfield, who rarely meet in an athletic competition.

The main emphasis, in this meet, is on individual accomplishment. The traditional track events are run (no hurdle shuttle relays), and all events are scored on the 6-4-3-2-1 basis.

The 440 should be a battle between three athletes who are usually at or near the 50-second mark, Sergio Sotelo of Sterling, John Matthews of Hall, and Dave R. Anderson of Geneseo.

Hall Township's Bob Paraisari should be strong in both hurdle events. He could find himself pushed in the high, however, by the Geneseo duo of Bruce Borkgren and Barry Roberts, and by Roberts in the low hurdle event.

# NCIC second place to Leafs in steady rain

Dark clouds were building in the west, but just east of Geneseo high school, athletes were busy preparing for the finals of the Friday night, May 12, NCIC boys track and field meet.

The air was heavy, and very humid.

"I sure hope it stays like this," said Geneseo senior Dave R. Anderson, who was hoping to challenge for the conference crown in the 440-yard dash, while also hoping to anchor Geneseo to a strong finish in the mile relay.

Told it was supposed to rain, Anderson said, "Well, I hope it waits until 9:40."

The meet was scheduled to be completed by then. The meet was completed by then. But, it started raining long before that.

A steady rain didn't kill competition, but it badly hurt times and distances and it chased away what promised to be a crowd of more than 1,000 fans.

A thunderstorm delayed the meet for about 45 minutes just before the varsity 100-yard dash. The meet had been running way ahead of schedule, though, thus when action was resumed, the original time schedule was followed.

Sterling won both the varsity and frosh-soph competition. The Golden Warriors weren't as dominant as last spring, when they beat Geneseo 90-38 to cop top honors. This time, Sterling scored 71 points, compared to 36½ by the second-place Maple Leafs. Sterling did pull a number of strong performers, though, hoping to keep them healthy for this Friday night's District meet in Moline.

Sterling beat Geneseo 65-55½ in the frosh-soph division.

Geneseo didn't win any events in the varsity meet, but the Maple Leaf sophomores won five, and went on a record-setting binge before the rains came.

Geneseo's frosh-soph two-mile relay team won in 8:28.8, setting NCIC and school records. The runners were Rick Clary, Jeff Renihan, Bryan DeNeve, and Keith Kincaid. Their run clipped about three seconds off the former NCIC mark.

Kevin DeBlieck fractured the Geneseo school record in the 330-yard low hurdles. The frosh-soph finals in that event were run during the afternoon, thus the reason many fans who saw the varsity race can't recall DeBlieck's run.

DeBlieck won the event in :40.72 seconds, nipping Wolf of Rock Falls for the NCIC championship. The former school record in the lows was :42.1, set last spring by Bruce Borkgren.

Geneseo's Brad Fleming uncorked his best triple jump of the season, 41 feet, 2 inches, and beat Jim McFadden of Rock Falls by 14 inches.

Scott Rink of the Leafs didn't win the 100-yard dash, but he did finish second and shattered a Geneseo school record.

Rink clocked :10.2, same time given to winner Tony Guzzardo of Sterling. The former Geneseo frosh-soph record was :10.5, held by Rink, Bill Neuleib, Dean Hungate, and Tom Nelson.

Dave Paxson of the Leaflets ran :55.2 in the 440-yard dash, and beat Cook of Princeton by three tenths of a second for the NCIC crown.

Geneseo won easily in the mile relay, as Fleming, Ron Farrell, Paxson and DeBlieck ran 3:45.1 and beat Sterling by a full four seconds.

In varsity action, Geneseo was second in three events.

The 440 relay team of Dave R. Anderson, Jeff Chadd, Randy Russell, and Dave M. Anderson ran :44.7, their best this spring, and were beaten only by a strong :43.4 by Sterling.

Barry Roberts nipped Sterling's Doug McCoy at the tape and took second in the 330-yard lows. Roberts was time in :41.5; winner Bob Parnisari of Hall ran :41.3. Parnisari, a fine hurdler, also took the 120-yard highs in :14.8, with Roberts getting third in :15.3.

Dave M. Anderson triple jumped 40-3½, good for second to Tom Pomije of LaSalle-Peru, the defending champion. Lance Hofer was third at 39-8½.

Norm Singbush-leaped 6 feet and was third in the high jump, and Geneseo's mile relay team placed third.

This wasn't to be "Red" Anderson's night to beat the school record in the 440-yard dash. He ran strong until the final turn, then faded badly and was even beaten by Terry Irwin of Rock Falls, a runner Anderson has defeated before. Anderson ran :52.9, and took fourth. Leaf Dan Carton, running in an earlier heat, won the heat in :53.0, and placed fifth overall.

Dave M. Anderson ran :10.4 and took fourth in the 100-yard dash, and Dennis Robertson got a fourth in the long jump at 20 feet, one-quarter inch. Randy Russell was fifth in the same event at 19-11½.

In frosh-soph action, Mike Stohl got a third in the discus, and Scott Lodico took fourth. Their distances: 121-9½ and 121-3, respectively.

DeBlick, in the chase for a 120-yard high hurdles crown, was nipped near the end, and wound up third in :16.1. Bryan

Colbert took third in the mile at 4:51.4, and Scott Rink was third in the 220 at :24.5. Geneseo's 440 relay team ran a crisp :46.0, but that got them third in this meet.

Fleming long jumped 18 feet, 4½ inches, and placed fourth.

Scott Rice got off a nice shot put throw of 44 feet, 1½ inches, and took home a fifth place medal.

Tom Hart cleared 5-6 and tied for fifth in the high jump, and Keith Kincaid ran 2:07.6, and was fifth in the 880-yard run.

Varsity pole vault action was completed Monday, and Geneseo's Bruce Borkgren cleared 12 feet to tie for fourth in that event. Sterling scored a one-two sweep, with Jim Pierce winning at 13-6, same high cleared by teammate Monte Eldert.

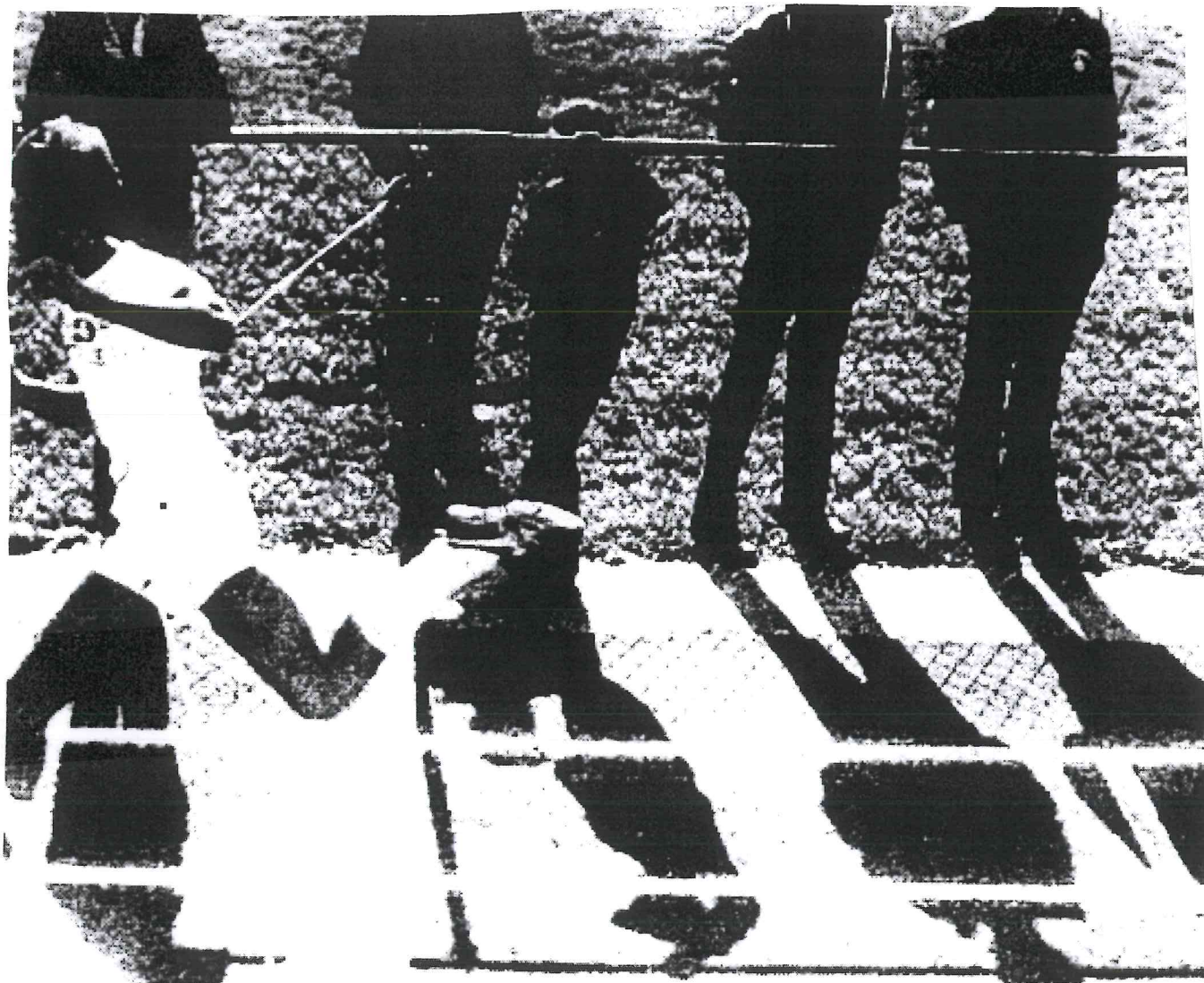
