

Meter meet mastered by Maple Leaf men

Geneseo won six events and defended its team championship Tuesday, April 25, in the state's oldest all-metric prep track meet, the Princeton Invitational.

This is a prestige meet of sorts, because it involves the six

schools in the Southwest division of the NCIC conference—the same six which compete against each other in football in the fall.

"We didn't get season's best times in any event, but we were in command all the way," said Leaf Coach Bob Reads, whose squad scored 80 points to easily top the 64 rolled up by the hosting Princeton Tigers. Rock Falls was a distant third with 50 points.

Although there wasn't a season's best by Geneseo in any event, the Leafs were very close to peak times in several events on a windy, cool—but sunny—afternoon.

Dave "Red" Anderson won the 400-meter dash in :51.2 seconds. Converted to 440-yard time, that :51.2 would stay about the same.

The same holds true for Harry Roberts' winning clocking of :15.53 in the 110-meter high hurdles. Roberts nipped Hall's Bob Parnisari in the high, and Parnisari's leap at the tape nipped Roberts in the low.

Lance Hofer picked up a win in the triple jump for Geneseo, and Randy Russell took the long jump for the Maple Leafs.

The Leafs are beginning to work sophomores into their varsity relay teams, and a pair of Geneseo relay teams won in Tuesday's action.

Sophomore Scott Rink joined Jeff Chadd, "Red" Anderson and Dave Anderson to give the Leafs a win the 400 meter relay, while sophomore Brad Flanning linked with Dave Hillman, Dan Carton and Red Anderson as Geneseo won the 1,600-meter relay in a crisp 3:22.9 time, which is about the same as it would be for one mile.

Norm Singbush picked up a second place finish for the Leafs in the high jump, and Chris Stahl got a third in the shot put.

Derrick Skiles and Jeff DeNeve continued to provide punch in the pole vault, placing second and third, respectively.

Dave Anderson placed third in the both dash events for the Maple Leafs.
