Geneseo is the defending champ

It's just about time for the annual renewal of the Maple Leaf Classic. On Friday evening, April 27, seven boys teams will square-off. All events begin at 6 p.m. at the high school stadium under the lights. It is a "full blown" meet with competition in relays, individual running and field events.
