

Distance duo eye strong state finish

At this point in the season, Alleman senior runner Zach Hird is not worried about personal bests.

"Times don't matter," Hird said. "You have to go for the win."

Hird expects to do just that this weekend.

Appearing in the Class 2A state meet at O'Brien Stadium for the second, and final, time, Hird knows the approach he needs to take for potential success to happen. Believing at least one state championship can be won, the result is all that matters.


"That is my main goal," said Hird, the Western Big 6 Conference and sectional 1600 and 3200 champion. "... I definitely want to win the (3200-meter run) and give my all in the (1600). I have very good chances to win both. I'll put my best effort forward."

No one is placing that pressure on his shoulders. Hird admits creating his "own goals to become the best," with one last chance to turn a dream into reality. The goal is obvious and something he is not hiding. A gold medal is what he wants to bring back to the Quad-Cities.

"A good goal," Hird said, "is one that isn't easy to achieve."

Not since 2002 has Alleman produced a state champion. That was when Hird's older brother, Nick, captured the Class A 3200 title. Next up is matching that accomplishment.

"That would be special," Hird said. "We would both share that."

Duplicating what his brother already has done requires a new mindset. Hird, seeded fifth in the 3200 and 28th in the 1600 out of the sectional meet, already has embraced it.

"It's an opportunity to show all the hard work I've put in," Hird said. "It should be a fun, exciting weekend."

Cook carries excitement:

A third-place finish in the Class 1A state cross country meet in November was parlayed into a solid track season for Annawan-Wethersfield junior Michael Cook. Entering the Class 1A state meet preliminaries on Thursday, he could score medals in the 800 and 1600 for the second consecutive spring.

The Wethersfield product could be the first athlete in program history with two individual medals in consecutive state meets.

"I'm feeling good," said Cook, seeded seventh in both races. "My times are continually dropping."

Battling back from tendinitis in his right foot, Cook hopes to build upon his third-place 1600 finish and fifth-place 800 showing as a sophomore. The first step was winning both races at the Farmington Sectional last Friday.

Cook hopes to improve his performances — he carries personal-best times of 1:58.2 (800) and 4:28 (1600) into state — during the final races of his season. Since the competition is deep, he knows that will have him peaking.

Does that mean there is the potential to reach the top of the podium on Saturday?

"The potential is there," Cook said. "It's going to depend on the race. ... It's wide open. I could think of four or five guys who could be on top of the podium."

Cook should be among that group.

STATE TRACK DAY 1

On Friday, May 30th, the Leafs participated in the preliminary round of the I.H.S.A. State Track Finals at Eastern Illinois University located in Charleston, Illinois. The Leafs had a contingent of 5 athletes competing in seven events. The Class AA competed in the morning session as competition began at 8:00 a.m. I have lobbied for years to make the meet a two-day final but meet administration refuses to change and forces all events (other than the 3200 Meter Run) to contest a preliminary round on Friday, with the Finals being contested on Saturday. The benefit of my suggestion would be improved performances and thus more scholarship money for the top athletes. Oh well, we were honored to be taking part.

Sophomore Will Daniels began competing in the High Jump at 8:00 a.m. None of the athletes were used to competing at this early time and the performances in Class 2A showed it across the board. Will did a great job in his first State Meet by clearing the opening height of six feet on his first attempt. He was unable to clear 6' 02" (narrow misses) but we thought that he had made the finals (they usually take the top 12 athletes to the finals.) They chose to only take 11 so he missed by one. Coach Deets and I met with meet management for an explanation and left understanding but disappointed.

Next up were the Leafs Senior throwers A.J. Marmion and Nick Verbeck who qualified for State in both the Shot Put and Discus. First up was the Shot Put and Nick got things rolling with a

series of throws that saw him improve on each throw (49' 11", 51' 02", 51' 08 1/2".) Each of his throws would have qualified him for the finals. Meanwhile, A.J. was struggling with staying in the ring as he fouled on his first two throws but managed to get his final preliminary toss in (49' 10 1/2") was good enough to qualify him for the finals.

The next Leaf to compete was Junior distance man, David Chenoweth, who toed the line in the 1600 Meter Run. David got out nicely in very hot and humid conditions (he raced at 11:32 a.m.) as he rolled through the 400 in 65 seconds. After that he found the going a bit tough as he hit the 800 in 2:15 (70) and the 1200 in 3:29. In typical David fashion, he dug deep and kicked it hard the last 400 to come home in 4:36.87 with a 67 second lap. He was hoping for more but the bottom line is that he ran a solid time and the experience he gained by qualifying as an individual will pay huge dividends during his senior year.

Last up were the Leaf throwers who were back in action in the Discus. Nick Verbeck blasted his 2nd preliminary throw over 144 feet to nail down a spot in Saturday's Final. That left fellow senior A.J. Marmion, who was in the final flight (the best) to try and qualify for the finals. We tried to downplay any pressure that A.J. might have felt being the top seed for most of the season and out of the sectionals. Only A.J. knows how much pressure he felt but I can tell you that all of his supporters were near the "Stroke Level" when he fouled on his first two tosses. That left only one toss left with all the pressure in the world on him. We desperately wanted him to attempt a "Safety Throw" to qualify for the finals and live to fight another day. Giving it anything less than his best isn't in A.J.'s DNA and he ripped his final throw and it exploded out of the ring and almost hit the 170' (169' 05") but he was fighting to stay in the ring swinging his arms. I will never forget Coach Fergie putting his hands on his head and then going CRAZY along with the rest of us when the meet official said the magical word, "MARK". It appeared the State Title would be his and I have never seen A.J. smile as much or as big. Hugs abounded and it was a moment I will never forget. People will be talking about Nick and A.J. for MANY YEARS! The way they pushed each other every day was omnipotent. Way to go, Men!

LEAFS MAKE HISTORY

On Saturday, May 31st, the Leafs participated in the I.H.S.A. State Track & Field Finals. The Leafs had three athletes competing in 5 events. The weather was hot and humid and the competition was what you would expect at the State Meet (tremendous.)


Arthur Atwell got things going in the Pole Vault. It's hard to believe that this youngster (only a sophomore) had never even picked up a pole until 14 months ago. In that time he cleared 10' 00" his "rookie" year and then added a "jaw-dropping" 3' 06" to that height this season to set a new sophomore record of 13' 00" at the Sectional Meet. He handled his first State Meet experience amazingly well by making the finals on Friday and then clearing the opening height of 12' 06" to place 13th overall. Not bad for his 2nd year in the sport. Look for big things out of this youngster in the coming years.

While Arthur was vaulting, the Shot Put Finals were being contested. The preliminary throws (from Friday) carried over to Saturday. Senior Nick Verbeck was sitting in 6th place with a throw of 51' 08 1/2" while teammate A.J. Marmion (also a senior) was in 11th with both hoping to

improve. Nick did improve to 52' 00" but dropped one spot to 7th as several other throwers also improved on their preliminary tosses. While A.J. launched a bomb that was reported to be over 57', he wasn't able to stay in the ring and was unable to improve his place. Nick Verbeck became the first Geneseo athlete to earn All-State Honors in 3 different sports. He was a key part of the 2nd place 4-A football team earning 2nd team All-State Honors. He followed that up by helping the wrestling team place 2nd in the dual team State Finals while also placing 4th in the individual State finals. Oh, what a year he had.

On to the Discus Finals. A.J. Marmion had the best throw in the preliminaries with a bomb of 169' 05" He improved on that performance with a throw of 171' 02" that held up to win Geneseo's first State Championship in 64 YEARS (Don Hillmer won the High Jump in 1950!) He really unleashed an attempt of his goal of going over 180' on his last throw but was unable to stay in the ring. A.J. and Nick become the first tandem in school history to each earn All-State Honors. A.J. also becomes the first athlete in program history to earn All-State Honors in the same event more than once (he was All-State in 2012.) Great Job, Men! To say that you will leave HUGE shoes to fill is the biggest understatement of the season.

Marmion comes up clutch, nears state title

CHARLESTON — Through two throws on Friday morning, Geneseo senior A.J. Marmion scratched both discus attempts. The Class 2A state favorite was teetering on not even recording a distance.

"One of the most agonizing things I've been through," Marmion said.

Seconds later, he finally exhaled.

The final attempt produced a throw of 169-feet, 5-inches, easily making the top preliminary distance during the Class 2A state meet at O'Brien Stadium. Coming up clutch allows Marmion to enter today's finals exactly nine feet ahead of the competition.

"The biggest relief in my life, especially with what happened last year and how it felt," said Marmion, who did not reach the shot put or discus finals as a junior. "After scratching my first two throws, I was like, 'This can't be happening. I have to get this next one in no matter what.'"

With some anxious Geneseo fans watching to the right of the ring, Marmion dug deep and launched a throw that broke the tension. Since the preliminary results carry over into the finals, he is within reach of becoming the program's first state champ since 1950.

Based on that, the result certainly was worth the wait.

"Hopefully, I'll get some practice in and work on not scratching," Marmion said. "I'll see what I can do and see how far it can go."

Marmion, who threw 49-10½ to reach the shot put finals, knows the mechanics need to be altered.

"The first two (throws) felt good. I was just too far forward in the front, so I lost my balance and went out," Marmion said. "But that last one, I made sure I didn't get too close to the front of the ring."

Despite needing a last-minute charge, he remains confident.

"There's still more," Marmion said, "for sure."

History could be made for Geneseo in multiple ways today.

Senior Nick Verbeck ranks sixth in the shot put (51-8½) and 10th in the discus (144-10) entering the finals. Sophomore Arthur Atwell reached the pole vault finals after clearing the qualifying height of 13 feet.

The Maple Leafs never have had multiple individual medalists in the same state meet.

"It wasn't a great day, but enough to get to the finals and get another three throws," Verbeck said. "Getting to finals is the biggest thing. Once you get there, you get after it."

In his first state trip, Atwell cleared 12-6 and 13-0 in his first attempts. He is one of 13 finalists.

"They (started) higher than I have before," Atwell said. "I had to adjust quickly to that."

Hird reaches finals: Despite running with an injured left hip flexor, Alleman senior Zach Hird won his 1600-meter preliminary race. Hird earned a trip to the finals with the victory.

"I didn't want to lead — I wanted to run fast enough to qualify," said Hird, who thought about not running the race to rest his hip. "I was able to close fast enough

to get the win. Otherwise, I may not have qualified."

Despite it being a "sit-and-kick race" and running with kinesio tape on his hip, Hird ran a 4:25.42. It was the fifth-fastest preliminary time.

With the finals berth secured, Hird now focuses on the 3200. That race, which Hird is hopeful he can win, will go down today. The only question is how the hip flexor will respond from Friday's race.

"Hopefully it doesn't affect (today)," Hird said. "I really want to do well in that 3200."

AJ Marmion is a state champion.

"I was definitely tired of second place," said Marmion. "It was the best way to end my high school career for sure. I was happy when I got the throw in. I felt relief and the pressure was finally off."

The Geneseo senior launched a winning throw in the discus of 171-02 to become Geneseo track's first state champion in 64 years. (Don Hillmer won the high jump in 1950.)

"This is extremely thrilling," said head coach Don Fredericks. "I am extremely proud of AJ and happy for him and his family."

"I feel happiness for sure, but almost feel like I didn't fulfill my goals to the fullest," said Marmion. "I wanted to break 180, and my third throw would have broken the school record, but I barely stepped out."

Marmion also becomes the first athlete in program history to earn All-State honors in the same event more than once. He was All-State in the dis-

cus in 2012.

Marmion competed in the finals of the shot put where he took 11th with a throw of 49-10 1/2.

"In the shot put, he fouled on the first two attempts and barely got the third one in," said Fredericks. "Then he fouled in his first two attempts in the discus, but then uncorked one where he almost went out, which held up to win."

"He had the weight of a mountain on his shoulders just from himself and once he got that throw in he had the biggest smile I have seen from him. It was pretty amazing and a lot of fun."

In the prelims, Marmion placed seventh in the shot put with a throw of 49-10 1/2 and first in the discus at 169-5 to qualify for the finals in both events.

Fellow senior Nick Verbeck capped off his high school career with an All-State honor (his third of the year to become the first Geneseo athlete to earn All-State honors in three different sports) of his own in the shot put with a seventh-place finish on a toss of 52-0.

"Nick is just an amazing young man," said Fredericks. "He works so

hard in practice and always has a positive attitude. At a lot of the early meets, I let the kids go home once they are done if they want, but Nick would always stay. He is a total team kid. It is very unusual to see the type of team spirit he has. I am so happy for him to achieve All-State honors in three dif-

ferent sports. I think he will be considered one of the great athletes to go through our high school."

Verbeck also placed 11th in the discus with a throw of 146-08 in the finals.

In the prelims, Verbeck finished second in the shot put with a throw of 51-8 1/2 and first in the discus with a throw of 144-10 to qualify for the finals in both events.

Geneseo's throwing duo become the first tandem in school history to each earn All-State Honors.

Sophomore Arthur Atwell was Geneseo's third athlete to reach the finals where he placed 13th in the pole vault as he cleared 12-6. In the prelims, Atwell tied for first in his heat at 13-0 to qualify.

"You are never satisfied, and Arthur was disappointed he only got 12-6 on Saturday," said Fredericks. "But I reminded him he had only been vaulting for 14 months, and last year his best height was 10-0. It is unbelievable that he qualified for state and made it to the finals."

Sophomore Will Daniels took ninth in the prelims of the high jump with a final height of 6-0.

"Will cleared at the opening height, and almost cleared 6-2 to advance," said Fredericks. "He barely touched it and had two really good attempts. It was a great experience for him."

Junior David Chenoweth finished ninth in his heat of the 1600-meter run with a time of 4 minutes and 36.87 seconds.

"It was really hot for David's race, but I thought he got out nice, but definitely struggled for a couple laps," said Fredericks. "He fought back and fought hard and kicked down several athletes. He has been to two state finals now, which sets him up really well for his senior year."

"What a season. It was a season of firsts," said Fredericks. "For the first



time ever, we were sectional champs; first time ever to have an All Stater in the same event and first time ever to have two throwers earn All-State. Kudos to coach Tom Ferguson for all the time he put in with those guys.

Worth its wait in gold

Geneseo's Marmion wins 2A discus title to break drought

CHARLESTON — As he greeted a small gathering of supporters on Saturday afternoon, Geneseo senior thrower A.J. Marmion hardly displayed a smile.

"I wanted a lot bigger throw," Marmion said.

A state title provides a consolation prize.

Even after his throw of 171-feet, 5-inches gave him the Class 2A discus state title at O'Brien Stadium, Marmion still was thinking big. What he termed as a "big throw" on the last attempt of his prep career ended in a foul, but the championship already had been decided.

"It feels good either way," a stoic-looking Marmion said minutes after securing the title. "I wanted to go bigger. My goal was at least breaking 180 (feet), and I never did it. I didn't even break my (personal best). ... I still feel good about that."

There is a reason Marmion should have some good vibes considering the drought he broke. Prior to his title, the program last won one in 1950 with Don Hillmer in the high jump.

"It's been a long time coming," Marmion said. "Someone had to do it."

For both the program and Marmion, it was worth its wait in gold.

"He won't show it on the outside," Geneseo throwing coach Tom Ferguson said, "but the culmination of his work, efforts and abilities are summed up in a championship."

How it happened resembles Marmion's career.

Marmion earned a discus medal as a sophomore but failed to make it out of the preliminaries

as a junior. A year later, he entered the state meet with the top sectional throw and was the discus favorite. The up-and-down path continued into the preliminaries, where Marmion scratched on his first two attempts. On the third one, he threw 169-5.

Entering the finals, that was the top throw. Marmion never lost his grip on the event, evident by his first throw.

"The nerves were out," said Marmion, the second athlete in program history with medals in two state meets. "I was feeling good and confident."

Marmion won the title by nearly 11 feet. That brought out a reaction when the interview concluded.

"I'm completely and utterly excited," Marmion said. "Definitely worth all the work."

A six-decade drought ended with one remarkable moment.

"Great story and a great kid," Ferguson said. "It's always a roller-coaster. But when it gets down to it, he's got a passion for throwing and wants to do well. That's what makes today so awesome."

"He ends as a state champ. That's pretty cool."




Leafs' Verbeck gets 4th state medal

CHARLESTON —
Missing out on a second throwing state medal on Saturday afternoon had Geneseo senior Nick Verbeck slightly down.

A moment of reflection changed his mood.

By finishing seventh in the Class 2A shot put competition, Verbeck capped his senior year with a fourth state medal and third all-state finish. Remembering that allowed him to realize there should be no disappointment in what happened.

"To get a medal in all three seasons is pretty cool," said Verbeck, who took 11th in the discus. "Exciting."

Verbeck started his senior year by helping the Maple Leafs reach the Class 4A football state championship game, where they dropped a 16-8 contest to Rochester. A few weeks later, he earned all-state honorable mention from the Illinois High

School Football Coaches Association.

In the winter, he earned his first individual wrestling state medal by placing fourth in the Class 2A 285-pound bracket. The next weekend, Geneseo placed second in the Class 2A dual-team state tournament.

The finale came on Saturday, when Verbeck threw exactly 52 feet in a seventh-place performance. Combine his medal with teammate A.J. Marmion's discus state championship, the Maple Leafs had two individual medalists from the same state meet for the first time.

"My goal was being all-state," said Verbeck, who will play football at Truman State. "To be down here is a huge accomplishment. Being all-state in the shot put is pretty cool. Having that honor in three sports is a neat thing."

A three-sport all-state athlete in the same school year is a pretty solid accomplishment.

"Pretty crazy," Verbeck said. "To do that is special."

Injury too much for Hird:

Looking to win a Class 2A 3200-meter state title, Allemans senior Zach Hird fell short in that goal. A left hip flexor injury suffered recently was too much to overcome in the two-mile event.

Hird, who was unsure if it is a strain or tear, was unable to compete in the 1600 finals as well.

"My hip flexor didn't feel too good from the start," Hird said. "... I can barely walk. It's hard moving around."

The injury flared up during the third lap, when he was among the leaders of the pack. Despite showing obvious discomfort, he finished the race, placing 27th (10:37.96) in the 30-man field.

"Definitely not the (ending) I imagined. A tough way to end my high school career," Hird said. "I didn't want to quit. I didn't want to give in. I knew there was no way I was going to give up. I wanted to give it my all."



GENESEO — When the seeds were released, Geneseo senior thrower A.J. Marmion entered the Class 2A state meet with the top sectional discus throw. In simplest terms, he was the favorite. "I don't like attention per se," Marmion said.

Two throws into his state meet, there was more.

The favorite had scratched on his first two discus attempts, putting his title quest in serious jeopardy. Because he had the top seed, Marmion had the final preliminary

throw. One more scratch, the favorite would be going home.

"It was one of those things that I had to do," Marmion said, "or I would look terrible."

One toss changed the outcome.

Marmion unleashed a 169-foot, 5-inch throw on his final attempt last Friday at O'Brien Stadium, giving him the top preliminary mark by exactly 9 feet. A day later, the favorite left the Class 2A meet as the discus state champion.

"It was one of the most biggest reliefs of my life, if not the biggest," said Marmion, this week's Metro

Pacesetter for The Dispatch and The Rock Island Argus. "I'm really happy it worked out like it did. Definitely awesome."

Becoming the program's first state champion since 1950 seemed easy as his final scoring toss of 171-2 was nearly 11 feet better than the runner-up. In reality, it was a process that was grueling and provided plenty of nerves.


