LEAFS BEAT CHALLENGING WEATHER AND FIELD TO CLAIM NIB-12 GOLD

On Friday, May 13th, the Leafs traveled to Sterling High School to participate in the Northern Illinois Big 12 Track and Field Conference Championship. The field included teams from: DeKalb, Geneseo, LaSalle-Peru, Kaneland, Morris, Ottawa, Rochelle, Sterling, Sycamore, and Yorkville.

Sterling always runs a first class meet and Friday night was no exception. Unfortunately, they, and the competing schools had to not only battle each other but some pretty nasty weather conditions. The daytime high of 65° began to drop when the clouds started rolling in. By the time the meet started a light drizzle had turned into a steady rain. Luckily, the winds were mild at this point. As the rain continued to fall, the Pole Vault was suspended for approximately 45 minutes. When it resumed, the temperature was 60° and the rain actually stopped for about 20 minutes. Then it returned and continued for the rest of the meet. It really turned for the worse after the 300 Meter Intermediate Hurdles as the cold front finally arrived bringing with it STRONG 30 mph north winds with HEAVY RAIN. The temperature at the end of the meet was 48° with a windchill of 39°.

"On Paper" the meet looked like a three team battle between the Leafs and DeKalb and Mighty Kaneland. All three teams are LOADED. The Leafs came ready to battle and overcome both the competition and the weather. This team has been on a mission all season long and that mission is

the pursuit of excellence. The effort was complete as the team scored in ALL EIGHTEEN events. The field event crew got the momentum rolling early. Will Daniels won both the High Jump (6' 05") and the Triple Jump (43' 03 1/2") while also grabbing 2nd in the Long Jump (21' 01 1/2".) That's 28 point all by himself. Arthur Atwell battled a LOADED Pole Vault Field and the rain to win his 2nd STRAIGHT NIB-12 Pole Vault Crown. The throwers continued their impressive seasons and team contributions as Sam Thomas and Josh Mathis placed 2nd and 4th in the Shot Put after Josh placed 4th in the Discus where he was seeded for nothing. What a great start to the meet!

On the track, the Leafs continued to battle. First up was the 3200 Meter Relay that saw the Leafs run an impressive 8:04.77 with Nathan Soria dropping a Personal Best of 1:58. Next up was the 400 Meter Relay and the Leafs claimed 5th place for two more points in a stacked field. Nick Fox followed that by adding to our team score with a hard-fought point in the 3200 Meter Run

against an impressive field. What followed next was one of the key moments of the meet as Reed Vanderheyden and Andrew Pischke went 1-2 in the 110 Meter High Hurdles (as Arthur Atwell was winning the Pole Vault.) HUGE!!!!!! Quinn Singbush followed that up with a hard-fought 6th place point in the STACKED 100 Meter Dash. Up next was the 800 Meter Run with Nick "Nasty" Swartzendruber and Andrew "da Rookie" Benhart who grabbed 4th and 6th in the 800 Meter Run for another 5 key points. Up next came the 800 Meter Relay and our 4 X 200 Meter Relay team ran the 2nd fastest time in school history barely losing to State-Ranked, Kaneland adding another critical 8 team points to our team total. Junior Lucas Hofer added a solid 5th place finish in the 400 Meter Dash and two more team points while Reed Vanderheyden and Andrew Pischke followed that up by grabbing 1st and 4th in the 300 Meter Intermediate Hurdles (14 more team points) just as the winds started to kick up. In case you are wondering, that's 32 POINTS from Reed and Andrew in the two hurdle races ALONE! Then the skies opened up, the rain POURED and the wind HOWLED for the 1600 Meter Run and the rest of the meet. Two of the teams actually "packed it up" and "called it a night"....unbelievable. Next up was the 1600 Meter Run and Junior Nathan Soria ran one of the bravest races I've ever seen, barely getting kicked down in the last 50 meters, as he grabbed 2nd place and 8 more critical team points. HUGE points. Senior Captain Quinn Singbush ended any chance that the Leafs could be caught when he ROARED to 3rd place in the 200 Meter Dash. Finally, the 1600 Meter Relay team ended the evening with style as their teammates sprinted back and forth across the field carrying "da colors". Super-Soph, Reed Vanderheyden, finished his amazing night with a "hand-held" sub-50 second leg as he ran down the State Ranked Rochelle Hubs Team. It FAT'ed to 50.04c. WOW! To run that fast in that weather was simply JAW-DROPPING. What a night for Geneseo Athletics!

While the Varsity Squad was winning the NIB-12 Championship, their younger teammates were fighting hard in the F/S division. The team was without the service of any athlete that the coaching staff thought had a "chance" of scoring at the Varsity Level. I'm certain that several other teams did the same thing (especially, DeKalb & Kaneland.) Blake Duncan (3200 Meter Run), Ryver Griffin (Triple Jump), Colton Pischke (High Jump) each participated at the Varsity Level. Even though none of them was able to break into the scoring, we know we made the correct decision in putting our team in a position to score potential points. If you throw Blake, Ryver, and Colton into the F/S division in those events along the Leafs would have placed 3rd. Add in the Leafs Big Two Super-Soph's (Nick Swartzendruber and Reed Vanderheyden) and the Leafs would have won the F/S Division. That is an exciting FACT and our team will be VERY strong in 2017.

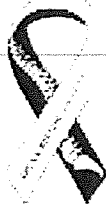
On to the meet. As mentioned above the team battled both the challenging environmental conditions in addition to Strong squads from DeKalb, Yorkville, Sycamore, Kaneland, and Ottawa. Our field eventers got the meet off to a strong start with Billy Cosgrave (4th in the High Jump); Kaden Rink (tied for 4th in the Triple Jump); and Alex McAvoy (3rd in the Discus.) Unfortunately, the F/S pole vault was canceled to the poor weather (too dangerous) where the Leafs were seeded to score 6 points. As it was, the Leafs scored 13 critical points in the field events with 5 of the competing 10 Leafs only Freshman. It should also be pointed out that we pulled Colton Pischke out of the Triple Jump as his knee was bothering him and we didn't want to take any chances of him causing further damage in the physically demanding triple jump. These men scored 20% of our team total points in only 5 events. Way to get the team off to a great start, Men!

On the track the team got things rolling in style as the All-Freshman team of Kaden Rink, Carson Cocquit, Andrew Rizzo, and Peter Rizzo grabbed 2nd place in the 3200 Meter Relay and destroyed our Freshman 3200 Meter Relay Record by a WHOPPING 13 SECONDS as they ran 8:43.98. Next up was the 3200 Meter Run where Freshman Kaleb Decker missed placing in the loaded field by only one place. This was a great race for Kaleb who ran a HUGE personal best. Up next was the 400 Meter Relay and they rolled to a solid 3rd place team finish grabbing 6 critical points for the team. Colton Pischke toed the line next (along with fellow Leaf Billy Cosgrave) and he exploded out of the blocks and never looked back winning the race in 16.23 which would have placed 3rd in the VARSITY RACE if you pull out Reed and Andrew. Amazing. Billy ran a solid race placing 11th. Next up was the 100 Meter Dash where the Leafs placed 1-2 in the 2nd of three heats and ended up placing 8th and 9th overall (Top 6 score.) Great Efforts, Men. The Rizzo twins doubled back in the 800 Meter Run and both ran strong races with Peter placing 5th to score 2 important team points while Andrew grabbed 8th place in the stacked field. Our 800 Meter Relay team placed 5th and added two more important team points to our teams total. Up next were Adam DeYoung and Carson Cocquit in the 400 Meter Dash and they raced to 3rd and 11th places to add 6 more critical team points to the Leafs total. Back on the track was the dynamic duo of Colton Pischke and Billy Cosgrave who raced to 1st and 5th places in the 300 Meter Intermediate Hurdles to add 12 more critical points to our team's total. As mentioned in the Varsity story (above) the rain really started to pour along with a STRONG North Wind (gusting to over 30 MPH) right before the F/S 1600 Meter Run (and lasted through the end of the meet) Simply put....it was NASTY! Blake Duncan and Kaden Rink fought hard in the loaded field and ended up placing 5th and 9th adding 2 more important team points to our team total. Two events to go and "Rookie" Landon Saucedo and Cameron Darin ROARED down the homestretch in the 200 Meter Dash in 6th and 9th places respectfully, to add another key point to our team total. Finally the 1600 Meter Relay had arrived and it's hard to describe just how challenging the conditions were. All four men ran their hearts out with Freshman Kaden Rink bringing us home in 3rd place. When the dust had settled the Leafs were a strong 4th overall. Well done, Men. We are proud of each of you. Leading the charge was our lone Gold Medalist Colton Pischke who won both the 110 Meter High Hurdles and 300 Meter Intermediate Hurdles. Almost every team at the Northern Illinois Big 12 Conference meet was huddled inside of Sterling Field House on May 13.

Well, except one.

The high winds and rainy conditions even forced a few teams to pack up and leave early.

However, the entire Geneseo boys' track stood soaked by the rain waving their team flag and cheering at the 50-yard line of the football field enclosed by the track.

As the meet came to a close with the 4x400-meter relay, the Maple Leafs knew this was a moment they wouldn't want to miss.

Running the anchor leg, Reed Vanderheyden ran down the Rochelle team in the final lap to give Geneseo's cheering section something else to celebrate.

After finishing tied for the conference title last season, Geneseo earned sole possession of the conference crown for the first time in NIB 12 history and scored points in every event.

"It's hard to explain how bad the weather was," Geneseo track coach Don Fredericks said. "It was just pouring. Wind gusts were blowing 30-35 miles per hour and it was cold. They really inspired the 4x400 relay to take it to another level. After it was over, the celebration was pretty special."

The cheers from their teammates spurred the 4x400 relay of Nick Swartzendruber, Lucas Hofer, Nathan Soria and Vanderheyden to a first place time of 3:28.3.

Since the formation of the NIB 12 conference, Fredericks thinks this is the most wins in a conference track meet for Geneseo.

"I feel like we are nailing our peak at the right time," Fredericks said. "The conditions didn't allow for a lot of PRs, but we had those kind of efforts."

Geneseo's Vanderheyden raced to a new conference record in the 300 hurdles (38.4).

Vanderheyden added a win in the 110 hurdles (15.21), and the Leafs' Andrew Pischke was runner up in the event with a time of 15.24.

Will Daniels was a two-time conference champion taking titles in the triple jump (43'3.5") and the high jump (6'5").

Geneseo's Daniels added a second-place finish in the long jump (21'1.5").

The Leafs' Arthur Atwell was the pole vault

champion clearing 14'7".

A senior, Atwell became a two-time pole vaulting conference-title winner.

"I think if you look at the statistics, this is the best team we've ever had," Fredericks said.

Geneseo's 4x800 relay team of Swartzendruber, Andrew Benhart, Nathan Soria and Cayson Frerichs won the 4x800 relay in 8:04.7.

Soria was runner up in the 1600 run (4:32.6), and Quinn Singbush was third in the 200 dash (22.6).

Geneseo's Sam Thomas was runner-up in the shot put with a throw of 50'6", and Josh Mathis was fourth with a mark of 49'10".

Mathis added a fourth place toss in the discus (151'10").

Swartzendruber was fourth in the 800 dash (2:01.9), and Hofer was fifth in the 400 dash (52.0).

In the frosh/soph competition, Geneseo's Colton Pischke cruised to a victory in the 110 hurdles in 16.2.

Pischke added a win in the frosh/soph 300 hurdles with a time of 43.0.

Geneseo's next competition will be at the Class 2A Mendota Sectional on Friday, May 20.

"We've had a great season up until now," Fredericks said. "How is this season going to be remembered? It will be by how we do come championship season."

Geneseo boys claim conference track title

STERLING — Reed Vanderheyden successfully defended his Northern Illinois Big 12 title in the 110 hurdles Friday at Roscoe Eads Stadium.

Geneseo's super sophomore also set a conference record in winning the 300 hurdles.

However, Vanderheyden's favorite race of the night was his last, running the anchor leg on the Maple Leafs' victorious 4x400 relay team.

That's because the final event of the night put an exclamation point on a league title for the Geneseo boys' track and field team.

"We really put the hammer down," Vanderheyden said after Geneseo outpointed runner-up Maple Park Kane-

land, 139-114. Hosting Sterling was sixth with 33 points in the 10-team meet.

"I'm excited about the hurdles, but the whole team getting together, and putting in all of their effort, makes this team title even more special."

Will Daniels nearly swept the jumps for Geneseo, defending the high jump title, adding the triple crown and finishing second in the long jump.

Arthur Atwell (pole vault) and the 4x800 relay also reclaimed championships for the Maple Leafs.

"It really was a team win," Vanderheyden said, pointing to all of the points piled up with second through sixth place finishes in other events.

"When Quinn Singbush took third in the 200, (the second-to-last event of the night), that

clinched the win for us, but we still went out there for it in the 4x4.

"The last 100, I felt the wind and I went, 'Crud.' I was dead tired. I was cold and I wanted to go home, but I knew I needed to push through. What an adrenaline rush the last stretch. We really wanted this. We're really pumped."

Vanderheyden also was plenty excited after sweeping the hurdles. Teammate Andrew Pischke was the runner-up in the 110 hurdles and Geneseo's Colton Pischke also swept the hurdles in the freshman-sophomore competition.

"We're a great hurdle team," Vanderheyden said. "We push each other and make each other better."

Vanderheyden was no better than in the 300 hurdles, clock-

ing 38.40 in the rainy, cold and windy conditions to set the conference standard.

"It's pretty big," Vanderheyden said. "Because of the weather, I thought I ran a really good race."

"It wasn't my (personal record), but I did well under the conditions."

So did his team.

"This is what we've been doing all year — doing our best despite the conditions," Daniels said. "We've had a lot of cold meets this year, and we performed again as well as we could."

"You always have to be pretty surprised with winning a conference title. We have one of the toughest conferences in the state and this really prepares us for next week's sectional."
