LEAFS 'MIX IT UP" WITH THE STATE'S BEST

On Saturday, March 25th, the Leafs traveled to the campus of Illinois Wesleyan in Bloomington, Illinois to compete in the Illinois Top Times Indoor Invitational. Competition was held in the beautiful Shirk Center with entries being based on the State Rankings for the 2017 Indoor Season. Coaches then had to either declare each athlete as competing or non-competing. The fields were limited and they simply went down the list of declared athletes to fill each event. Not all of the State-Ranked Athletes competed but the field was certainly highly elite, to say the least.

Competition for the Leafs began with the 60 Meter High Hurdle Prelims. There were four heats with the 8 runners headed to the finals. Heat winners and then the next 4 fastest times advanced. Reed Vanderheyden was up first in heat 3. Reed ran a solid race sprinting to a time of 8.50 which had him sitting in 7th place with one heat to go. Colton Pischke raced in the fourth and final heat and had the best reaction to "da gun" that I've ever seen from him. Unfortunately, things went south from there. He ended up with the 14th fastest time in the 24-man field and gained some additional "Big Meet" experience as he raced to a finishing time of 8.73. Reed Vanderheyden "survived" the final heat as no one ran faster. The heat winner advances so he was the last man in (that is a lot better than being the first man out!)

Up next came the 3200 Meter Relay. The fields were "loaded" in every event and this was no exception. "Nasty" (Nick Swartzendruber) took the baton first and blazed a 1:58.94cr that saw him hand off with the Leafs in 3rd place. Nick's time ties for 5th on the All-Time Junior Individual List (not bad considering it is still only MARCH.) Andrew "Benny" Benhart took "da stick" next and ran a solid race in "no man's land" splitting a solid 2:05.94cr. Nathan Soria was up next and also ran in "no man's land" for most of his race splitting a solid 2:05.04cr. Anchorman, Cayson Frerichs, saw some team movement as Metamora and Mohomet-Seymour joined the action up front with Cahokia while Thornridge fell back. Cayson cranked out a :57 first 400 (fastest on the team) and was sitting 4th until the final 100 when he saw Cahokia's anchorman tying up. He dug even deeper and caught him helping the Leafs grab 3rd place with an outstanding leg of 2:01.34cr.

Up next was "Vanderhurdle" who was racing in the finals of the 60 Meter High Hurdles for the THIRD STRAIGHT YEAR! Reed was seeded 7th on time but out-performed the seed sheets, as usual, by running a season best time of 8.48 that saw him grab the 6th place medal. We are "licking our chops" knowing that both Colton and Reed are far better at the longer hurdle races. Bring on the 110 Meter High Hurdles and the 300 Meter Intermediate Hurdles. Cross your fingers and maybe we can even dream of seeing "Big Pish" making a comeback before too long. While I'm at it, let's add "Big Hof" to that list (although not in the hurdles, he prays!)

We scratched Reed from the 400 Meter Dash to save him for the 1600 Meter Relay as his shins are a bit tender from the indoor season. So the Leafs lined up for the day's final event with Nick Swartzendruber leading off again. He continued his tremendous day by running an outstanding split of 51.94cr that saw him put the Leafs into the LEAD. Cayson Frerichs raced in the 2nd position and did a great job of hanging onto Cahokia's 2nd man. Cayson raced to a solid split of 53.24cr and the Leafs were a close 2nd. Nathan Soria took "da stick" 3rd and roared after the leader. Unfortunately, he felt something "pop" in his left hamstring and almost had to drop out of the race as he pulled up significantly. Somehow, he got back after it but was noticeably limping on his 2nd lap. Somehow, he still ran a 56.04cr split. Reed Vanderheyden grabbed the baton last and ROARED after the field. He ran everyone down but Cahokia and Thornridge with his highly spirited 52.54cr. Erie-Prophetstown's winning time of 3:30.59 in heat one just edged us by 5/100's of a second.

Now, as we move forward into the outdoor season let's pray for a speedy recovery for Nathan (Our Athletic Trainer thinks it's a mild strain.) He will probably be out for at least two weeks (if not longer.) I am confident that other men will step up. We (da coaches) are very proud of the efforts put for by the team today and all indoor season. We are also VERY excited about the upcoming outdoor season. Keep working hard, Men. Remember, we PEAK FOR CHAMPIONSHIP MEET SEASON!!!!!
